

Les Bergeries

Overview

Stone walls warmed by the southern sun and barbecues drifting on the breeze set the tone at Les Bergeries, a beautifully restored traditional home in the heart of rural Gard. Set within a tiny hamlet and thoughtfully reimaged by an architect, this two-bedroom retreat pairs rustic authenticity with refined, contemporary living.

The interiors blend charm and comfort, with exposed stone, soft-toned furnishings and light streaming through French windows. A stylish kitchen with an American-style fridge and dining area opens directly onto the poolside terrace, while the light-filled living room, complete with fireplace and Wi-Fi, invites slow evenings and good conversation. Both bedrooms have their own bathrooms, one on each floor, making this an ideal base for couples or a small family seeking an authentic French escape.

Outside, the walled garden is simply delightful. The eight-metre pool glistens under the sun, edged by loungers for languid afternoons. A summer kitchen and barbecue area provide the perfect setting for al-fresco meals, while the Moroccan-style outdoor living space promises long evenings under the stars. A lower garden with a boules court completes the picture of relaxed living in southern France.

Les Bergeries is well placed for exploring one of southern France's most beguiling corners. Just over 13km away, Uzès enchants with its Renaissance façades, medieval towers and lively cafés. Lose yourself in its legendary Saturday market at Place aux Herbes, a feast of olives, cheeses and sun-ripened produce, or dine in one of its many acclaimed restaurants. The Roman heritage of Nîmes and the extraordinary aqueduct of Pont du Gard are both within easy reach for memorable day trips.

Whether savouring a quiet morning with coffee by the pool or exploring the cobbled charm of nearby hilltop towns, Les Bergeries offers an effortlessly elegant escape, where every detail speaks of care, comfort and charm.

Location & Local Information

In the heart of the little hamlet of Le Puget, just 1.5km from the slightly larger Belvézet, Les Bergeries offers a pretty escape amidst the glorious landscapes of the Gard, close to amenities in Saint-Quentin-La-Potérie (13km) and Uzès (13.5km), the latter considered to be one of the most beautiful towns in southern France.

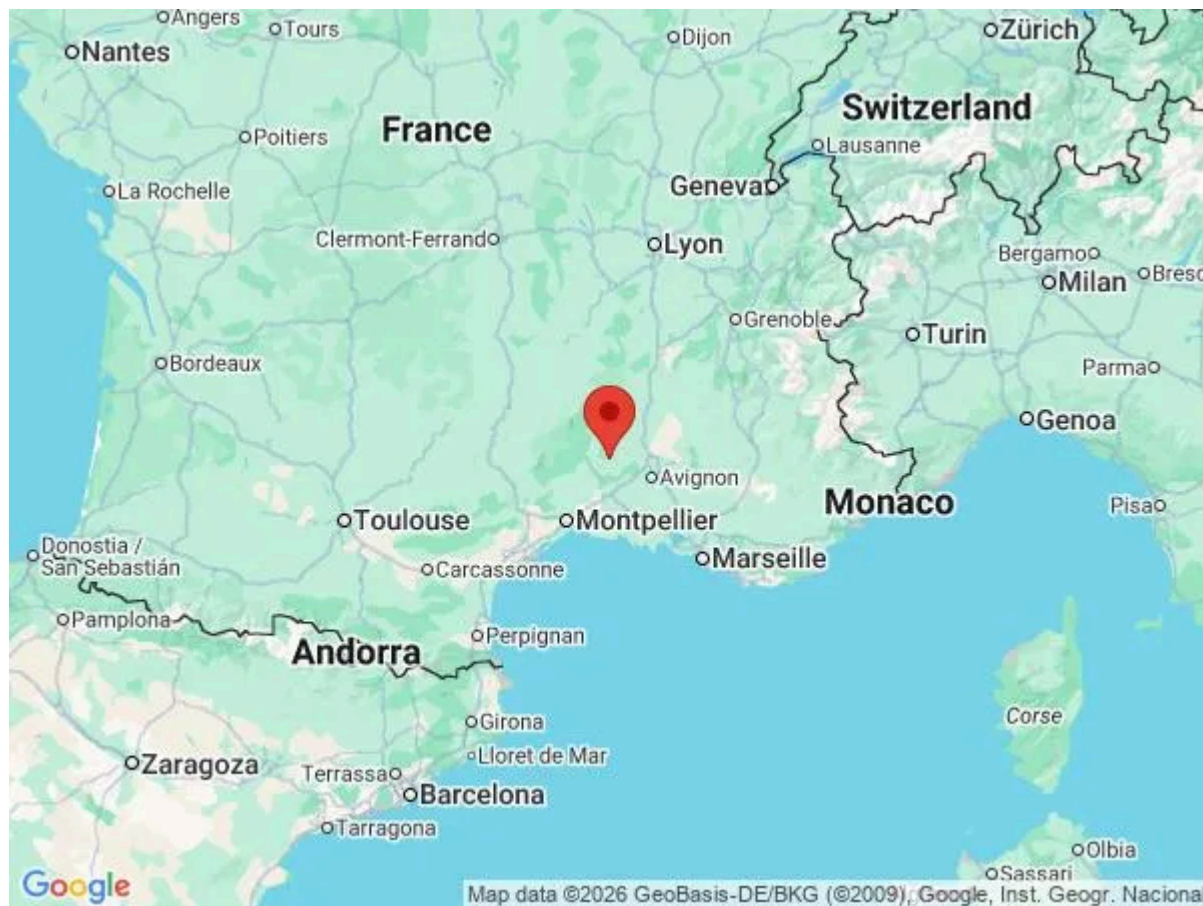
Indeed, the enchanting town of Uzès is a must-visit. A stroll through its cobbled streets reveals Renaissance mansions, medieval towers and leafy squares like the iconic Place aux Herbes. Time your visit with the legendary Saturday market and browse stalls brimming with regional delicacies: creamy goat cheeses from the Cévennes, seasonal fruits like figs and apricots, tapenade and honey from local hives. Don't miss the smaller Wednesday market for fresh produce and artisanal fare, or settle into one of Uzès' many restaurants, from Michelin-starred dining rooms to relaxed bistros.

Saint-Quentin-La-Potérie (13km) is renowned for its pottery heritage and artisan spirit. Wander through its narrow lanes, visit working studios, and shop for beautifully crafted ceramics.

For nature lovers, La Vallée de l'Eure on the outskirts of Uzès is a hidden gem - a tranquil river valley ideal for shaded walks and picnics, with remnants of the ancient Roman aqueduct system whispering stories of the past.

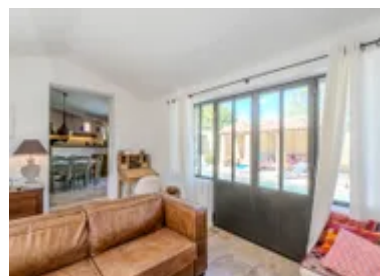
Further afield, Nîmes (38km) offers a heady mix of Roman grandeur and contemporary flair. Explore its remarkably preserved amphitheatre, browse chic boutiques or linger in stylish cafés that blend modern culture with southern elegance. And just 26km away lies the Pont du Gard, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of France's most extraordinary Roman monuments - a majestic aqueduct bridge set above the Gardon River.

Wine lovers are perfectly placed to enjoy tastings in the surrounding vineyards of the Coteaux du Languedoc AOP. The local whites and rosés are crisp, aromatic, and wonderfully food-friendly, ideal companions to a summer evening on the terrace at Les Bergeries.
