Overview

Framed by the craggy silhouette of Les Alpilles and bathed in the golden light of Provence, La Demi Lune is a private home of rare character and understated luxury. As you pass through its gates, time seems to soften. Cypress trees sway in the breeze, stone walls glow with warmth and the gentle scent of roses and herbs carries across the garden. This is not simply a holiday retreat; it is an invitation to savour life at a slower, more beautiful pace.

Crafted with the elegance of a traditional Provençal mas, La Demi Lune blends rustic materials with refined touches throughout its air-conditioned interiors. Exposed beams and stone floors anchor beautifully styled rooms, while bespoke furnishings and thoughtful decor create a restful atmosphere. Sleeping 10 adults, each of the five main bedrooms offers king-size doubles, plush bedding, TVs and stylish private bathrooms. In addition, a delightful dorm-style bedroom welcomes up to five additional children with its own relaxation space and small bathroom.

At the heart of the property, the generous living space opens onto the terrace and garden, light pouring in from the arched French windows. The fully equipped kitchen is ready for local market hauls (think ripe tomatoes, creamy goat's cheese and crusty bread) while the outdoor dining area and summer kitchen is ideal for leisurely al-fresco meals as the cicadas sing.

The gardens are a verdant triumph, carefully landscaped yet effortlessly wild. Discover olive trees, native grasses and lavender plants alongside the heated swimming pool, where stone surrounds and sun loungers invite you to while away the afternoon. For the more energetic, a tennis court and airconditioned gym await, or you may prefer the relaxing hammam. As you explore, listen out for braying donkeys and goats, weave through the labyrinth and climb the raised platform for glorious views of the gardens and distant Alpilles. A shaded pétanque court and several hidden corners for reading or repose complete the outdoor experience, all enclosed within a private, gated estate.

Pick fresh vegetables from the potager, collect eggs from the henhouse and make sure you try the estate's honey, jam and olive oil. A buffet breakfast is served each morning and daily maid service is included. Additional services can also be arranged such as cookery classes, pilates lessons and massages.

Set just 3km from the enchanting village of Eygalières, La Demi Lune is an ideal base for exploring Provence. The hilltop village, a short drive or bike ride away, is known for its high-end restaurants, Friday morning market and authentic Provençal spirit. From here, explore the storied landscapes of Les Alpilles, with Saint-Rémy-de-Provence, Les Baux and Avignon all within easy reach.

Location & Local Information

Set in stunning landscaped grounds, La Demi Lune enjoys an enviable location just a stone's throw from some of Provence's most enchanting destinations. Set just off the road connecting the charming villages of Eygalières and Mollégès, guests are perfectly placed to explore the beauty, culture and gastronomy of Les Alpilles region and beyond.

A short 3km drive brings you to the characterful streets of Eygalières, where stone houses, café terraces, high-end restaurants and the bustle of the Friday morning market embody the essence of Provençal life. It's a quintessential village loved by A-list celebrities who have been known to buy houses here to escape the French Riviera paparazzi.

In the other direction lies Mollégès (3km), a traditional village with local shops and cafés, while you can find a good range of supermarkets around a 10 to 15-minute drive away near Plan d'Orgon and Cavaillon, ideal for stocking up on regional produce and essentials.

Meanwhile, Saint-Rémy-de-Provence (11km) is a vibrant and historic town brimming with charm. Famed as the place where Vincent van Gogh created some of his most iconic works during his time at the nearby Saint-Paul-de-Mausole asylum, the town offers art lovers a deeply atmospheric experience. Wander its tree-lined boulevards and cobbled lanes, pausing at shaded squares or browsing boutiques and galleries. A highlight is the Wednesday morning market, a lively affair that fills the town with colourful stalls selling local produce, cheeses, textiles and crafts – a true feast for the senses.

Nature lovers will be drawn to the spectacular Alpilles landscapes, where rocky outcrops, pine forests and vineyard-strewn valleys invite walking, cycling and leisurely drives. Discover neighbouring hilltop villages like Les Baux-de-Provence (20km), one of France's most beautiful, where ancient castle ruins overlook sweeping vistas of olive groves. Whether hiking the GR6 trail, visiting olive oil mills or joining a wine tasting at a local vineyard, this region offers unforgettable experiences for all seasons.

Further afield, Avignon (25km) beckons with its Papal history and lively cultural scene, while the canals and antique markets of L'Isle-sur-la-Sorgue (24km) make for a delightful day trip. The famed hilltop village of Gordes (30km), with its honey-hued stone buildings and sweeping Luberon views, promises yet another taste of Provençal magic, or venture deeper into the Luberon to discover perched villages, orchards, vines and lavender-scented valleys.
