The swimming pool stretches for over 20 metres, appearing to spill into the distant green foothills of the Arrábida mountains. Set within an exclusive private estate, Casa Ambar lies just a short drive from the wine-producing village of Azeitão, also famed for its sheep's cheese, cakes and nearby Palácio da Bacalhôa. Only a little further afield, discover the Arrábida coastline with its stunning beaches and clear waters, while wonderful day trips like Sesimbra and Lisbon offer culinary discovery and cultural intrigue.

Location & Local Information

Surrounded by the beautiful landscapes of southern Portugal, Casa Ambar is located a short drive from the charming wine village of Azeitão and only 38km from Lisbon Airport. This is a fine setting for experiencing good wine, food and culture alongside one of Portugal's most beautiful coastlines.

Surrounded by vines, cork and olive trees, Azeitão (5km) is famed for its Muscatel wine, olives and creamy sheep's cheese, with traditional cakes adding a sweet touch to village life. Just outside the village, wine and art lovers will be drawn to nearby Palácio da Bacalhôa (7km), a stunning 15th-century estate renowned for its striking collection of azulejos (ceramic tiles) and contemporary art.

For lovers of the sea, the crystal-clear waters of the Arrábida coastline are within easy reach. Discover the famous bay of Portinho da Arrábida (14km), ideal for snorkelling, or simply soaking up the sun in a setting of unspoiled natural beauty. Praia da Figueirinha (17km) and Praia do Creiro (17km) offer further stretches of idyllic sand backed by the dramatic slopes of the Parque Natural da Arrábida, a protected area rich in flora, hiking trails and breathtaking views.

Sesimbra (12.5km) offers a deeper dive into the region's coastal charm and traditional fishing heritage. With its seafood restaurants, marina and Moorish castle, Sesimbra is a favourite for those looking to combine beach time with culture and cuisine. For urban energy, head to Setúbal (18km) – a bustling city known for its seafood market, riverside promenade and dolphinwatching boat tours.

For a change of pace, a day trip to Lisbon (32km) brings all the delights of the capital within easy reach – from the cobbled streets of Alfama to the grandeur of Belém.

Whether you're drawn by nature, gastronomy or history, Casa Ambar offers a beautiful and well-connected base from which to explore the very best of southern Portugal.
