

Le Mas De Campagne

Region: Dordogne **Sleeps:** 14

Overview

In the countryside surrounded by farmland, woodland and rotating sunflowers, Le Mas de Campagne reveals itself as an exceptional rural retreat in northern Dordogne, close to the Charente border.

This 12-acre estate brings together the comfort of two beautifully restored manor house-style residences thoughtfully designed for extended families or groups seeking refined style and space to gather and spend quality time together.

In the first house, guests will love the expansive open-plan living and kitchen area, where a central island, wood-burning stove and sofas set the tone for convivial evenings. Upstairs, there are three delightful en suite double bedrooms across the two upper floors, allowing this spacious house to sleep up to 6 guests.

Hosting another 6 guests, the second house exudes charm with its original beamed ceilings and warm, inviting interiors. A pretty kitchen and dining area creates a relaxed hub for light meals, while the comfortable living room offers a cosy spot to unwind. Three well-appointed double bedrooms are spread across the upper two floors, each offering privacy and character, alongside two attractive bathrooms.

Across both houses, traditional features blend seamlessly with modern conveniences, creating homely yet elegant spaces to retreat to at the end of each day. There is also a seventh bedroom in a charming self-contained studio annexe, meaning Le Mas de Campagne is suitable for up to 14 guests.

Outdoors, the estate opens into an oasis of pastoral charm. A heated swimming forms the centrepiece of the gardens, flanked by sun loungers for easy afternoons under the southern French sky. Terraces spill out from the houses, each offering a unique dining or lounging zone, from the atmospheric summer kitchen with its pizza oven, plancha and gas barbecue, to the long, shaded dining table that invites shared al-fresco meals. The games barn brings even more entertainment, with table tennis, darts and a home cinema for relaxed evenings or rainy-day fun.

Set just 1.7km from the little hamlet of Champagne-et-Fontaine, Le Mas de Campagne is ideally located for exploring this unspoilt corner of northern Dordogne. You will find a local restaurant within 2km, while Verteillac, a charming village with restaurants, cafés and a bakery, is just a 10-minute drive away.

The bustling Friday market in Ribérac also offers an authentic taste of regional life, and further afield, you can explore the medieval lanes of Aubeterre-sur-Dronne, paddle on the Dronne river or visit Angoulême for culture, shopping and festivals. Le Mas de Campagne is perfectly placed for discovering the everyday magic of southwest France.

Location & Local Information

Located in the open countryside on the Dordogne-Charente border, Le Mas de Campagne offers an idyllic escape surrounded by rolling fields, wooded lanes and quintessential French charm. This picturesque setting places you within easy reach of some of the region's most captivating towns and villages, all while enjoying complete privacy in nature's embrace. Whether you're seeking local flavour, outdoor adventures, or cultural exploration, this location puts it all within effortless reach.

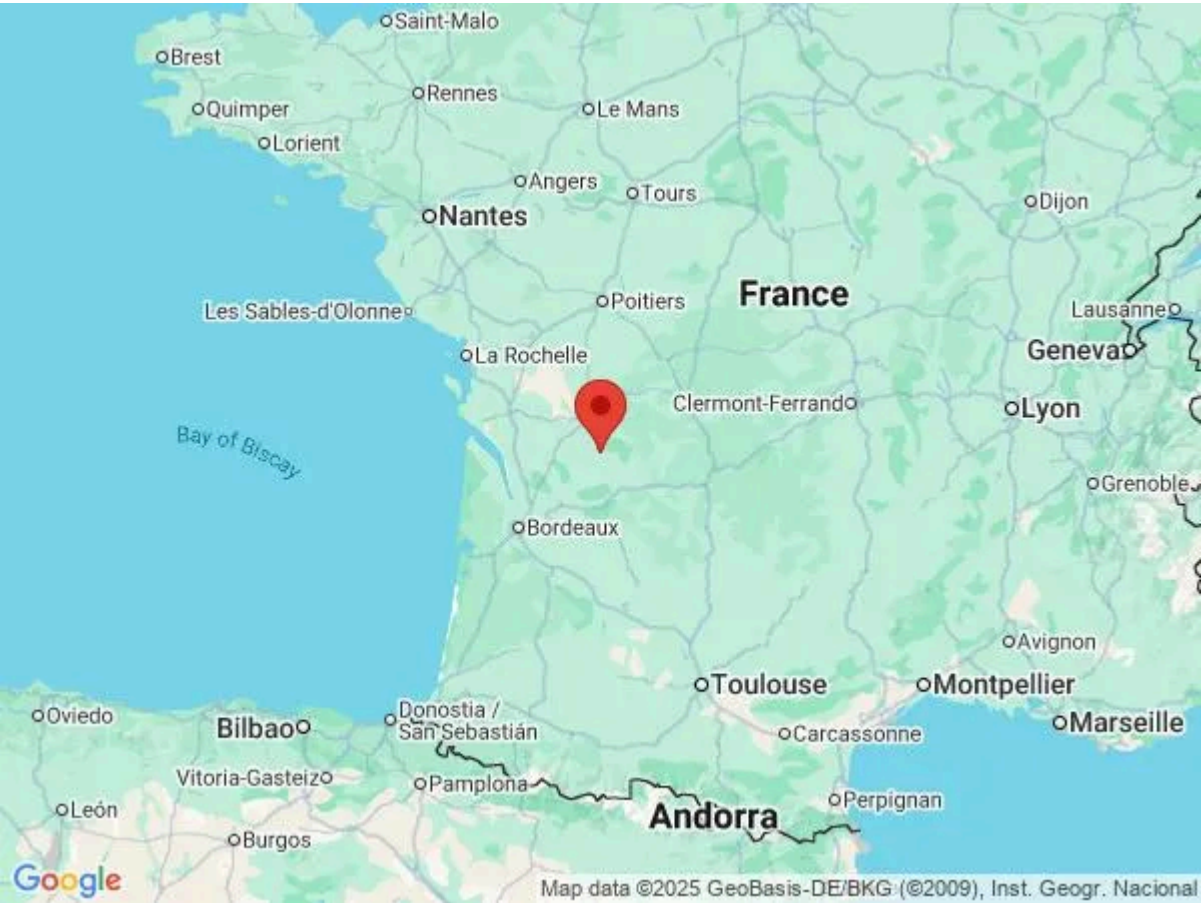
Just a short drive away (or 20-minute walk along a country road, no pavement) lies Champagne-et-Fontaine (1.7km), a little hamlet with a café/bar whilst there is a local restaurant around 2km by car. A little further, the village of Verteillac (10km) offers a taste of authentic rural life, boasting a bakery, butcher and grocery store as well as a small handful of restaurants.

The historic town of Ribérac (22km) is a must-visit, especially on Friday mornings when its celebrated market bursts into life. Stalls brim with regional delicacies, artisan goods and seasonal produce, making it a lively hub for locals and visitors alike. With its wide range of shops, cafés, restaurants and two large supermarkets, Ribérac has everything you might need during your stay.

For a day trip with a difference, head to Aubeterre-sur-Dronne (27km), one of France's 'Plus Beaux Villages'. This hilltop village is a delight to explore, with winding streets, galleries, good restaurants and the remarkable underground monolithic church. In summer, the little riverside beach becomes a popular spot for relaxing, swimming and canoeing on the Dronne.

Further afield, discover the riverside beauty of Brantôme en Périgord (35km), known as the 'Venice of the Périgord', or immerse yourself in the vibrant cultural scene of Angoulême (37km), home to world-renowned festivals, impressive ramparts, boutique shopping and expansive hypermarkets.

From rural charm to cultural discovery, Le Mas de Campagne is perfectly placed to experience the very best of southwest France.
