

Casa di Lucignano

Region: Tuscany Sleeps: 8

Overview

Down a winding country lane in the heart of Tuscany, Casa di Lucignano rises from a sea of olive trees and sunlit meadows. Step through the heavy wooden door and you're met with cool terracotta floors, hand-plastered walls, and centuries-old beams that echo the farmhouse's storied past. The interiors exude relaxed character, blending vintage furnishings with playful touches, bold fabrics, local ceramics, and a pair of roaring fireplaces for cooler evenings.

Two generous lounges offer calm corners for reading or conversation, while the farmhouse kitchen, complete with open hearth, tiled counters, and striped cotton curtains, flows into a light-filled dining room. Four ensuite bedrooms span two floors, each with views across the garden or rolling hills beyond. Upstairs, a covered loggia frames the valley in picture-perfect proportions.

Outside, a stone path leads past lavender and rosemary to the pool, perfectly placed for long afternoons in the sun. Wooden loungers, parasols, and canvas deck chairs invite you to laze and linger. A shaded dining terrace and pizza oven await al fresco meals beneath the stars.

Despite its peaceful setting, the villa sits just minutes from the walled village of Lucignano, making it a rare find, utterly private, yet wonderfully connected.

Location & Local Information


Casa di Lucignano enjoys a privileged position just under 5km from the medieval village of Lucignano. Known for its elliptical street plan and honey-coloured buildings, Lucignano offers an authentic slice of Tuscan life. Guests can meander through narrow lanes to discover artisan shops, gelaterias, family-owned trattorias, and a small supermarket for essentials. There's also a weekly market, perfect for picking up local cheeses, cured meats, and fresh produce.

The villa lies between Siena and Arezzo, two historic towns rich with culture, architecture, and celebrated cuisine. Further afield, Florence is just over an hour's drive, while the vineyards of Chianti and the sculpted landscapes of Val d'Orcia offer easy day trips.

Whether exploring hilltop towns or walking country trails straight from the villa, this is a place to savour the rhythm of rural Tuscany, slow, rich, and unforgettable.

- Please note home security devices may be installed at the villa, please enquire for further information.

Terms & Conditions

- **Security deposit:** €300 paid in cash to the owner upon arrival and refunded upon departure, subject to full inspection.
- **Arrival time:** 4.00 p.m. - 7.00 p.m. Check-in outside of the stated hours must be requested at the time of booking and is strictly subject to the owner's approval. Please note that, if approved, an additional fee may apply. Arrivals after 9pm are not possible.
- **Departure time:** 10.00 a.m. Any departure outside of this time will be subject to an extra cost.
