Overview

Tucked into the wooded hills of San Bartolo Natural Park, Casa Albavista offers a serene retreat with panoramic views sweeping across the city of Pesaro and out to the Adriatic Sea. Wander through the terracotta-tiled interiors, where antique furniture and curated artwork bring a gentle grandeur to every room. The sitting room is warm and characterful, framed by bookshelves and a carved stone fireplace, while the country-style kitchen is made for leisurely meals, crowned with exposed beams and vibrant touches.

Step through to the shaded veranda, where long tables invite al fresco feasts beneath climbing vines. The private pool glimmers nearby, edged with sun loungers and surrounded by fragrant Mediterranean shrubs. This peaceful garden, fully enclosed for privacy, is yours alone to enjoy.

Although the setting feels delightfully secluded, Pesaro's beaches, boutiques and historic centre are just minutes away. From morning swims to sunset aperitivi, Casa Albavista is a place where days unfold at your own pace.

Location & Local Information

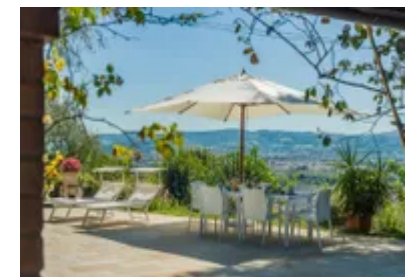
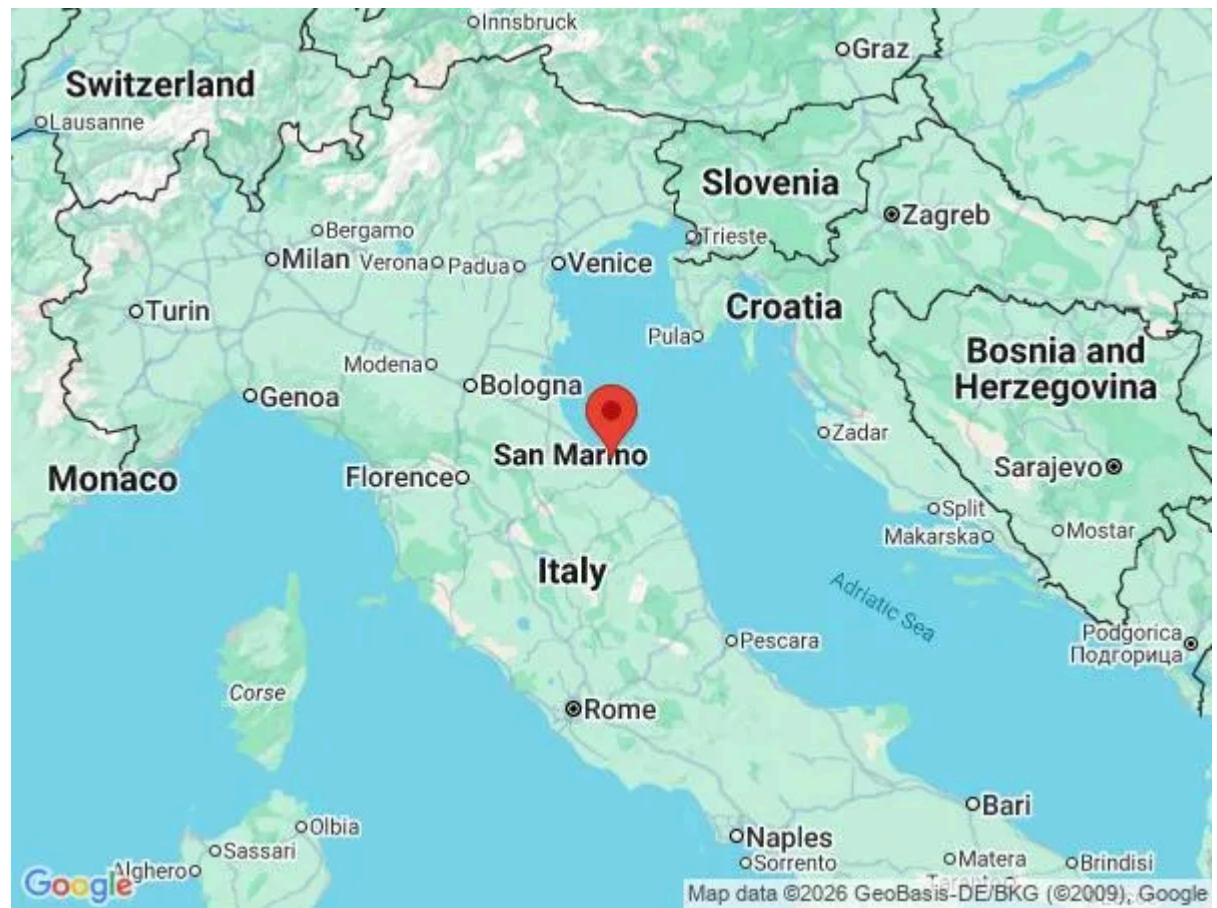
Casa Albavista sits just above the coastal town of Pesaro, tucked into the rolling green of San Bartolo Natural Park. Surrounded by pine and olive trees, the villa feels wonderfully private, yet the lively heart of town is only 1km away. There, you'll find sandy beaches, cafés, restaurants and cultural gems like the house of composer Rossini.

From here, you can explore the clifftop villages of Fiorenzuola di Focara and Gabicce Mare, or head inland to Gradara, a perfectly preserved medieval borgo. Nature lovers can follow scenic trails through the park, while those in search of seaside charm will enjoy the pebble beach at Baia Vallugola.

Pesaro itself hosts a range of vibrant events, from the world-renowned Rossini Opera Festival to cinema and antique fairs. With fresh produce markets and lively summer evenings, it's a destination full of life, history and local flavour.

Terms & Conditions

- **Security deposit:** €500 paid in cash to the owner upon arrival and refunded after departure, subject to full inspection.
- **Arrival time:** 4 p.m. and 7 p.m. Check-in outside this time may be subject to an extra cost. Please enquire for more details.
- **Departure time:** 11:00 a.m.
- **Energy costs included?:** Yes. However, extra cost for air-conditioning, based on consumption and payable locally.
- **Linen & towels included?:** Yes.
- **Pets welcome?:** Not allowed.
- **Other Ts and Cs:** Please note that published rates are only valid for the current year. Any bookings for subsequent years will be on request only and correct rates will be confirmed at the time of booking. Please note that your booking will only be confirmed once we have checked availability with the owner or their property manager.
- **Changeover day:** Saturday in high season. Flexible during other periods.
- **End of stay cleaning:** Extra €150, payable locally. Guests are required to leave the accommodation clean, tidy and in the same condition as on their arrival. Any extra cleaning, laundry, maintenance and/or rubbish disposal required will be charged against the security deposit.
- **Smoking Allowed?:** Outside only.
- **Minimum stay:** 7 nights.
- **Heating costs included?:** Extra €250 per week, payable locally.
- **Tax:** Italian Visitors Tax payable to Oliver's Travels at the time of balance payment (typically costs €1-€10 per adult per night - please enquire if exact amount is required).
