

# Maison Des Grands Vins

**Region:** Provence-Alpes **Sleeps:** 16

## Overview

Beyond the rows of vines that have ripened under Provençal sun since the 18th century, Maison des Grands Vins offers an exceptional retreat where heritage, comfort and contemporary style come together. Once part of a wine estate, this beautifully restored *mas* sits at the heart of a wine-growing landscape, still encircled by the domaine's vineyards. Even during the harvest, it's such a relaxing atmosphere here – listen out for the hum of cicadas or the clink of glasses raised under the pergola.

Inside, traditional character gives way to contemporary design. Reimagined with modern families in mind, the house offers eight bedrooms (six of them en-suite) and a layout that suits both intimate groups and multi-generational gatherings. The stylish lounge area is airy and sociable, with reversible air conditioning throughout the home ensuring year-round comfort.

In summer, life spills outside. A large shaded dining terrace invites long Provençal lunches prepared on the plancha, just steps from the heated salt-water swimming pool, ideal for cooling off after a morning exploring. Admire Cypresses and olive trees as you lounge beside the swimming pool and savour the beauty of this remarkable region.

Near the Dentelles de Montmirail and foothills of Mont Ventoux, the surrounding area is a delight for wine lovers and foodies alike. From your doorstep, a private vineyard path leads to the wine estate, where tastings and cheese pairings showcase the best of local whites, rosés and reds. The local village of Violès, just a 5-minute drive away, features an excellent boulangerie, while celebrated wine villages like Gigondas, Vacqueyras and Châteauneuf-du-Pape are easily reached. Dining ranges from village bistros to Michelin-starred experiences, with charming Séguret and Vaison-la-Romaine offering both culture, history and cuisine.

Whether gathering for a special holiday or simply seeking an immersive Provençal escape, Maison des Grands Vins offers a beautiful setting where glasses are full, meals are shared and the pace of life is dictated by the vines.

## Main House Interiors (420m2)

### Ground Floor

- Living area with two sofas, two armchairs and TV
- Dining area with table and 12 chairs
- Kitchen, well-equipped including induction hob (3 burners), microwave, Nespresso coffee maker, toaster, kettle, dishwasher, fridge and freezer
- Bedroom 1 (12m2) with queen-size double bed (160x200cm), drawers and wardrobe
- Separate WC
- Bedroom 2 (11m2) with double bed (140x200cm) and clothes rack
- Shower room (shared between above bedrooms) with walk-in shower and wash-basin



### First Floor

- Bedroom 3 (42m2) with sofa, two armchairs, wardrobe and mezzanine level with queen-size double bed (160x200cm). Private bathroom with whirlpool bath, wash basin and separate toilet
- Bedroom 4 (46m2) with armchair, drawers and mezzanine level with queen-size double bed (160x200cm). Private bathroom with whirlpool bath, wash basin and separate toilet
- Bedroom 5 (28m2) with queen-size double bed (160x200cm) and private shower room with walk-in shower, wash basin and separate toilet

*The two mezzanines are reached via open-tread stairs and feature railings and low ceilings.*



### First Floor Upper East-Wing

- Bedroom 6 (23m2) with queen-size double bed (160x200cm), wardrobe and private shower room with walk-in shower, wash basin and separate toilet
- Bedroom 7 (28m2) with queen-size double bed (160x200cm), wardrobe and private shower room with walk-in shower, wash basin and separate toilet

### Independent Studio Ground Floor Annexe (36m2)

- Living area with sofa and TV
- Open-plan kitchen with small table, two chairs, sink, induction hob, oven, microwave, washing machine and fridge. Door opens to discreet airing space
- Wardrobe with ironing board and iron
- Bedroom 8 (12m2) with queen-size double bed (160x200cm) and drawers
- Shower room with walk-in shower, wash basin and separate toilet

### Outside Grounds

- Heated salt-water swimming pool (6x12m, depth: 1.5m), heated via heat pump and features electric safety cover. Heated and open approximately mid May to early October

# Location & Local Information


Set among the vineyards of the Southern Rhône, Maisons des Grands Vins offers an immersive Provençal experience. Surrounded by sweeping views of vines and olive groves, close to a little canal, this beautiful location is perfect for wine-lovers, foodies and nature enthusiasts alike. Whether you're relaxing in the garden or heading out to explore nearby villages, the charm of Provence is never far away.

The setting feels secluded and relaxing, even during harvest time (as you are surrounded by a working vineyard), yet it is also well connected, only 450m from the main road leading to the picturesque village of Violès (2.3km) where you will find a very good bakery, bistro and pharmacy. Closer to home, you can walk to the wine château (who own the surrounding vines) for wine-tasting and even cheese pairing (book ahead).

When it comes to dining, you'll find everything from Michelin-starred restaurants in Gigondas (8km), Vaison-la-Romaine (18km) and Châteauneuf-du-Pape (18km), to authentic family-run spots with set menus from just €25 in charming settings like Séguret (11km), one of France's '*Plus Beaux Villages*'. Dozens of wineries in the surrounding villages – including Vacqueyras, Beaumes-de-Venise and Gigondas – welcome visitors for tastings and vineyard tours.

Outdoor enthusiasts will be in their element with scenic walks through the Dentelles de Montmirail and cycling routes weaving through the foothills of Mont Ventoux. E-bike hire is readily available, making even the more challenging routes accessible. The area's beauty and variety have made it a beloved destination for Tour de France fans and recreational cyclists alike.

For culture seekers, the region's rich history is just as alluring. Discover Roman ruins in Vaison-la-Romaine and Orange, stroll the artist-filled lanes of Séguret or plan day trips to the antique markets of L'Isle-sur-la-Sorgue or the historic city of Avignon.

- There is one bedroom in a self-contained annexe and seven bedrooms in the main part of the house.
- Two of the bedrooms in the main house feature beds on mezzanine levels via open-tread stairs (with railings and low ceilings upstairs) - please see the "Layout" tab for details.
- If you are hiring or travelling with an electric or hybrid vehicle, there is a Type 2 EV charging point – please request this at the time of booking. A weekly charge will apply (approximately €50 per week).
- Maison des Grands Vins is part of a larger estate, also home to the owner's house (as seen from the outside in some photos). The owners will not be present during your stay but please note you will not have access to their property.
