

Casa Pietra Blu

Overview

Above the glistening Gulf of Sagone, Casa Pietra Blu stands as a refined Corsican sanctuary, crafted from island stone and designed with effortless grace. Set within an exclusive estate, the villa captures a modern aesthetic while remaining deeply rooted in its surroundings. Pale, tactile interiors and clean-lined architecture set a serene tone, while pretty terraces and windows blur the boundary between indoors and out, inviting in sea breezes, golden light and the wild aromas of the maquis.

Thoughtfully arranged over two levels, Casa Pietra Blu is a space designed for shared moments. The ground floor opens into a spacious, open-plan living and dining area, anchored by a fireplace and a fully equipped contemporary kitchen. Step outside and you'll find a private terrace for al fresco meals and an infinity-edge pool that appears to spill into the sea beyond, perfect for long summer days and lingering twilight swims. Upstairs, two stylish suites come with their own bathrooms, while two additional twin/double rooms share a third, ideal for families or groups of friends.

To add to Casa Pietra Blu's distinctive features, a range of curated services can be arranged in advance, from breakfast and chef-cooked dinners to outdoor adventures like kayaking or quad biking. The estate's discreet concierge is on hand to help personalise your stay, whether it's a horse-riding, boat tours or even a helicopter flight over Corsica's rugged coastline.

From its hillside setting tumbling down to the sea, the villa is only 550m from the charming village of Cargèse. Known for its unique blend of Latin and Greek heritage, the village is home to twin churches, atmospheric cafés and a small collection of shops and restaurants. Below, the harbour bustles with local activity, and a series of beaches, including the beloved Plage du Péro, are just a short drive away.

Casa Pietra Blu invites you to slow down and savour Corsica's raw, natural beauty in ultimate comfort and style.

Location & Local Information

Tucked into the rugged splendour of Corsica's northwestern shoreline, Casa Pietra Blu enjoys a privileged position within an exclusive estate, just a short distance from the much-loved village of Cargèse. Arrive via Ajaccio Airport (50km), approximately an hour's drive away, or by ferry from mainland France or Italy into the historic city of Ajaccio (48km).

The road to Cargèse winds just 550 metres from the property (as is typical in Corsica, no pavement most of the way). With roots dating back to the 17th century, this hillside village blends Greek and Latin influences, evident in its twin churches facing each other. Meander through its leafy lanes to find characterful houses, a selection of restaurants and cafés, as well as small handful of useful shops including a boulangerie and a small supermarket.

Cargèse's charming harbour (1.5km) is the perfect spot to soak up the coastal ambience - watch local fishing boats come and go or embark on a boat trip to discover Corsica's rugged coastline.

A number of inviting beaches lie within easy reach. Family-friendly Plage du Péro (3km) offers glorious sands and calm waters, while the more tucked-away Plage de Menasina (2.5km) is prized for its crystal-clear sea and scenic surroundings. Another local favourite, Plage de Chiuni (8km), features expansive sandy shores ideal for a day by the sea.

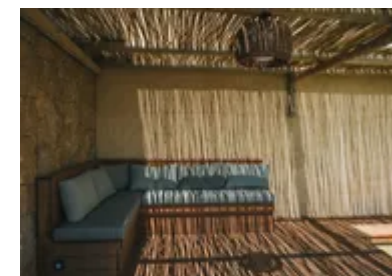
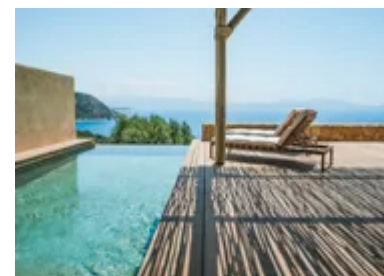
Active travellers will be well catered for, with the region offering excellent snorkelling, jet-skiing, sea-kayaking and other water sports. Inland, scenic hiking paths wind through the maquis-covered hills, while horse-riding and quad-biking provide exciting ways to explore Corsica's wild landscapes.

The wider region offers day trips too. Discover the Napoleonic heritage and vibrant culture of Ajaccio (48km), or follow the winding coastal road north to Piana (19km), home to the iconic Calanques – towering red granite cliffs that plunge into the Mediterranean. Continue on to Porto (31km), a charming seaside village that serves as a gateway to the UNESCO-listed Scandola Nature Reserve, known for its breathtaking views and Genoese tower.

Terms & Conditions

- **Security deposit:** €5,000 charged to client's credit card by Oliver's Travels as a pre-authorisation at least 2 weeks prior to arrival and refunded two weeks after departure, subject to full inspection.
- **Arrival time:** 5.00 p.m.
- **Departure time:** 10.00 a.m.
- **Energy costs included?:** Yes.
