Nearby, you'll find charming villages, ancient castles and golden beaches, perfect for exploring before returning to the comfort of this exceptional home.

Location & Local Information

Perched above the Menai Strait, Saltstone Hall offers an exceptional base from which to experience Anglesey and North Wales. Anglesey, the largest island in Wales, is a captivating blend of rugged coastline, ancient history and incredible natural beauty.

With Saltstone Hall's own private jetty, guests can step aboard a pre-arranged speed boat and glide across the water for unforgettable adventures. Private paddleboarding, kayaking, jet foiling, sailing, fishing and other activities can also be organised from the water's edge.

Only 2km from the Menai Bridge, all essentials are within easy reach, with supermarkets and other useful amenities located in the small town of Bangor (5km). Just a short drive in the other direction lies Beaumaris (5km), home to the impressive 13th-century castle, a pier perfect for crabbing and a collection of little shops, galleries and restaurants.

Among Anglesey's other treasures is Traeth Llanddwyn (22km), a sweeping Blue Flag beach backed by pine forest and framed by views of the Eryri (Snowdonia) mountains. Anglesey's charm lies in its diversity, offering everything from dramatic sea cliffs and quiet coves to bustling market towns and Iron Age heritage sites, all wrapped in a timeless atmosphere.

Within driving distance of Anglesey, Eryri (Snowdonia) National Park offers a dramatic contrast of towering peaks, glacial valleys and lakes. With its charming villages, such as Beddgelert (34km) and Betws-y-Coed (38km), hiking paths and scenic mountain railway, it's a must-visit destination for anyone staying in North Wales.

For another wonderful day trip, the walled town of Conwy (29km) is a must-see for castle lovers or experience the classic seaside charm of Llandudno (35km) with its old-fashioned pier and Great Orme Tramway.
