

Everdene Retreat

Overview

Flanked by meadows, woodland and the dramatic fells of the western Lake District, Everdene Retreat is a stunning escape unlike any other. Set within ten private acres bordered by the River Esk and Whillan Beck, this extraordinary home pairs rugged outdoor adventure with the warmth and style of a high-end hideaway.

Inside, rich Lakeland character meets Scandi-inspired design, from quirky handcrafted details to vast glass doors framing beautiful views. Every space has been carefully curated for comfort and joy, with room for up to 16 guests across the main house and its adjacent Coach House.

At the heart of the home, an expansive open-plan kitchen, lounge and dining space invites leisurely breakfasts and sociable evenings beside the double-sided log burner. Each of the eight ensuite bedrooms has its own personality, most with super king-size beds (some of which can be split as twins) and one with built-in bunk to delight both young and old. Families will appreciate the cinema room, library snug and Alpine-style boot room with heated warmers, while outdoors, two bubbling hot tubs and riverside picnic spots make the most of the surroundings.

Set in the heart of Eskdale, this is one of the Lake District's most untouched and dramatic valleys. Described by Alfred Wainwright as one of Lakeland's loveliest, the landscape stretches from the region's wildest peaks to the Irish Sea. Far removed from the tourist trail, it offers space to truly reconnect with nature with walking trails and cycling routes from the doorstep. The Ravenglass & Eskdale steam railway is just a stroll away, and a couple of local pubs within walking distance adds to the charm.

Whether wild swimming, hiking or enjoying yoga sessions overlooking the river, Everdene Retreat invites you to write your own adventure in an unforgettable setting.

Ground Floor

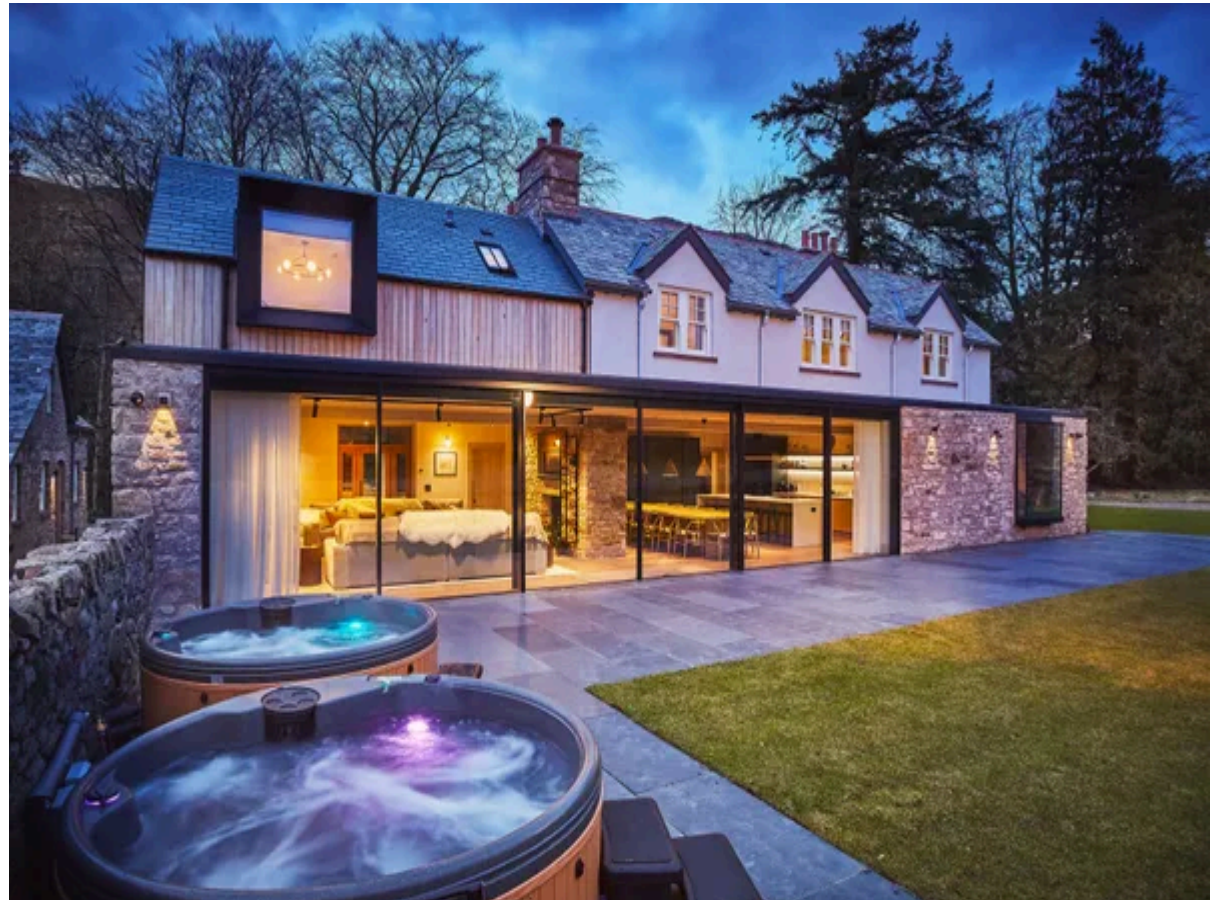

Location & Local Information

In the heart of Eskdale, one of the Lake District’s most unspoilt and dramatic valleys, Everdene Retreat offers a stunning base for guests who crave both adventure and natural beauty. Described by Alfred Wainwright as one of Lakeland’s loveliest valleys, Eskdale descends from the region’s highest mountains toward the Irish Sea, creating a breathtaking backdrop for your holiday, far away from the region’s bustling tourist routes.

Local charm is never far away, with two inviting pubs within walking distance, perfect for a hearty post-hike meal or a cosy evening drink. Two more traditional inns lie just a short cycle or drive away, making it easy to sample local fare throughout your stay. Eskdale Mill, a beautifully restored working watermill, offers a glimpse into the area’s heritage also just a leisurely stroll from the house.

For train enthusiasts young and old, the Ravenglass & Eskdale Railway is a must - this scenic steam railway within walking distance offers a delightful journey through the valley, connecting Eskdale to the coastal village of Ravenglass, home to a Steam Railway Museum and the Roman Bath House. Do check seasonal timetables and opening dates in advance.

From your doorstep, a network of trails beckons walkers of all abilities and this is a superb area for cycling (bike storage and washing facilities are on site). Cyclists and hikers alike will enjoy the scenic Eskdale Trail, a route known for its picturesque views and rewarding climbs. For the truly daring, a drive over Hardknott Pass, one of England’s steepest roads, leads you to the fascinating Hardknott Roman Fort, just 5km away.

Outdoor enthusiasts will be spoilt for choice - wild swimming, paddle boarding on tranquil tarns or kayaking on nearby lakes can all be arranged locally. Whether you’re in search of restful seclusion or high-energy adventure, Everdene Retreat offers the perfect blend of comfort and nature in one of the Lake District’s best-kept secrets.
