At the threshold of Portugal's celebrated Douro Valley, Casa Tamega is a riverside retreat that blends regional heritage with understated opulence. Inside, natural textures and hand-finished details set a relaxed yet refined tone across spacious living areas.

With room for up to 18 guests, Casa Tamega is perfectly equipped for families and groups alike. A trampoline, footvolley court, and river access with kayaking options keep things active, while cozy seating nooks, a wine honesty bar, and firepit moments invite pause.

Located near Amarante and within easy reach of Porto, the villa offers a prime base to explore both wine country and northern Portugal's vibrant cultural life. Casa Tamega is more than a place to stay - it's a place to settle in and soak up the spirit of the Douro.

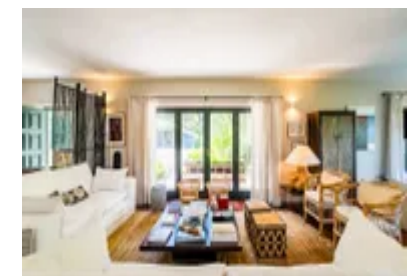
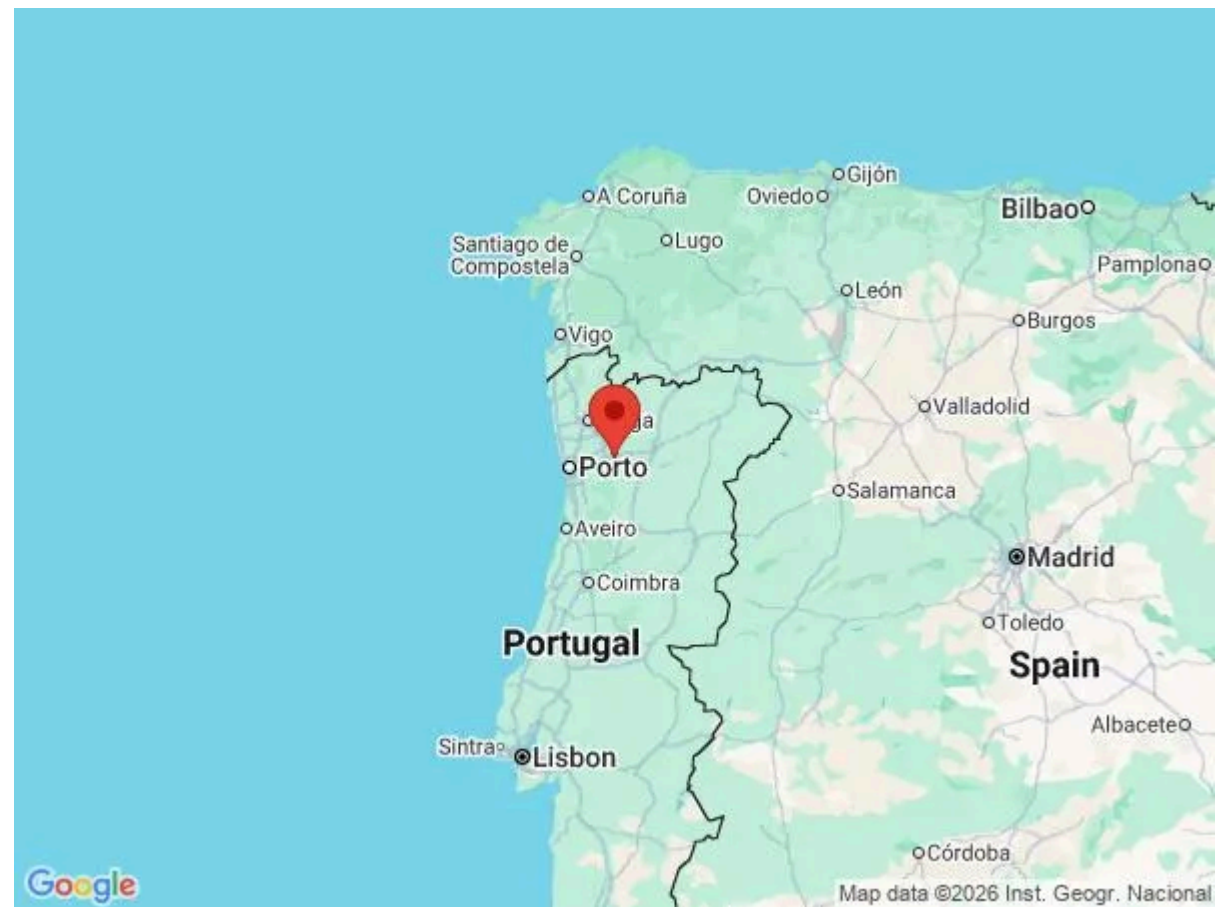
Location & Local Information

Casa Tamega enjoys a prime position above the banks of the Tamega River, just outside the historic town of Amarante and within easy reach of the Douro Valley's wine country. This location offers a rare balance - close enough to Porto for day trips, yet surrounded by nature, vineyards, and peaceful riverside scenery.

Guests can explore the architectural charm and riverside cafés of Amarante, sample wines at nearby quintas, or take scenic drives through rolling hills lined with vines and olive groves. The river itself invites kayaking, boating, and quiet walks along its edge, while local trails and traditional markets offer a deeper connection to the region's rhythm. Whether you're here for wine, culture, or the calm of the countryside, Casa Tamega's location offers an ideal gateway to northern Portugal's finest experiences.
