

Pierremorte

Region: Languedoc **Sleeps:** 12

Overview

A tree-lined driveway leads through the private grounds, where surrounding vineyards stretch out beneath the southern sun and a gentle river glides past ancient woodland. Pierremorte stands proudly at the heart of this natural landscape, a traditional country house brought to life through a sensitive renovation that honours its historic character while offering the comfort of modern living.

Step inside to discover a home of scale and substance, arranged across four floors with beamed ceilings, exposed stone walls and time-worn tiles underfoot. The interiors feel both generous and intimate, from the sweeping, double-height living space with open fireplace to quiet corners perfect for reading or conversation. The semi-professional kitchen opens onto a breakfast terrace, while the conservatory leads to the swimming pool. Each of the six bedrooms has its own distinct charm, with two elegant master suites providing indulgent space to retreat and relax.

Outside, the setting is nothing short of enchanting. Wander across the grass, admire the woodland and river, then gather for long lunches on the terrace or friendly games of boules. The private infinity pool stretches 13 metres, edged by loungers and raised patios in a characterful setting.

Pierremorte lies just five minutes by car from bustling Saint-Chinian, home to wine domaines, shops, a twice-weekly market and lively café terraces. The Mediterranean coast is just 40 minutes away for beach days, while the wild beauty of the Gorges d'Héric and medieval Carcassonne offer rich days out in every direction.

Pierremorte invites you to slow the pace and savour the rhythm of the Hérault countryside accompanied by good wine and wonderful nature.

House Interiors

Entrance Level

- Main entrance hall with door leading to pool and garden
- Small living room with sofas, fireplace and TV Amazon Firestick
- Mezzanine reading/lounge area with sofas and library (overlooking lower floor below)
- WC and hand basin
- Secondary kitchen intended for hosting a private chef



Lower Ground Floor

- Open-plan living-dining area with sofas, fireplace, TV with Amazon Firestick, Wi-Fi and dining table. Door opens to terrace, boules court and garden
- Open-plan semi-professional kitchen, well-equipped including central island, gas range and oven, fridge freezer and two dishwashers. Doors open to breakfast terrace
- Utility room with two fridge freezers, ice-maker and washing machine
- Conservatory with table and chairs, leading to pool area and garden
- Shower room with WC, shower and basin.



First Floor

- Study with desk and chairs
- Bedroom 1 with double bed, separate living area, TV Amazon Firestick and ensuite WC, walk-in shower and twin hand basins
- Separate bathroom with WC, bath/shower and hand basin
- Large studio with day beds and open-tread staircase
- Bedroom 2 with double bed and ensuite WC, shower and hand basin

Second Floor

- Bedroom 3 with double bed, living area and ensuite WC, bath/shower and hand basin
- Bedroom 4 with two single beds (or double)
- Bedroom 5 with single bed
- Separate shower room with WC, shower and hand basin
- Bedroom 6 with two single beds (or double) and ensuite WC, shower and hand basin

Outside Grounds

- Infinity swimming pool (13x4.5m) with steps

Location & Local Information

In the heart of the Languedoc countryside, Pierremorte enjoys a beautiful setting amongst the forest and vineyards, only a short drive from the characterful wine-producing town of Saint-Chinian. The house borders a pretty river – discover a waterfall and pools for swimming just five minutes away.


Despite this rural setting, you are not too remote as the house is located just off the road leading to Saint-Chinian (3km). This village is a vibrant local hub known for its award-winning wines and twice-weekly market bursting with fresh produce, cheeses and regional specialities. Saint-Chinian offers all essential amenities, including a supermarket (2km), shops, a bakery, pharmacy, bank and a tempting selection of café bars and restaurants. Oenophiles will find no shortage of caveaux and wine outlets to explore, each showcasing the rich and varied flavours of the Saint-Chinian appellation.

This stunning region is a haven for outdoor enthusiasts. Within a 40-minute drive, the dramatic Gorges d'Héric offers magnificent hiking trails through craggy limestone cliffs and emerald-green river pools, ideal for walking, wild swimming or simply soaking up the untouched natural beauty. Closer to home, the Orb river invites you to enjoy canoeing, rafting or a refreshing dip, while the golden Mediterranean sands of Valras-Plage are only 40 minutes away for a classic beach day.

You are also well based for visiting the fairy-tale city of Carcassonne (65km), famed for its UNESCO-listed medieval citadel, cobbled streets and vibrant cultural scene. Or head to Béziers (34km), a bustling southern town with flower markets, historic architecture and the Canal du Midi. For a quieter charm, the picturesque village of Olargues, officially one of the 'Plus Beaux Villages de France', is only 30 minutes away, offering stone bridges, winding alleys and breathtaking views.
