

# Borgo Pignano - Villa The Artists' House

## Overview

Beyond the gentle rustle of oak and beech leaves, The Artists' House is tucked deep within Borgo Pignano's ancient woodland, offering an evocative retreat where nature, privacy and creativity meet. Once a studio for painters and sculptors inspired by Tuscany's golden light, this elegant stone villa now welcomes guests with warm hospitality and quiet, timeless charm.

Step into the open-plan living area where soft natural tones, exposed beams and traditional terracotta floors reflect the rustic soul of the region. A wood-burning stove warms the adjoining studio space, the perfect nook for reading, sketching or slow afternoons of reflection. Downstairs, a serene bedroom with a Napoleonic sleigh bed opens to the garden, while the upstairs master suite enjoys its own private terrace overlooking the forest canopy.

Outside, a woodland lounge invites peaceful morning coffees and unhurried aperitivi, while a large, heated swimming pool is beautifully secluded, bordered by rosemary, lavender and wild greenery.

Fresh fruit, flowers and a bottle of estate wine await your arrival, with daily cleaning, turndown service and optional in-villa breakfast delivery adding to the experience. Guests can also explore the wider estate with a golf buggy and enjoy full access to the spa, sports courts, gourmet dining and concierge services.

The Artists' House is one of several villas nestled across Borgo Pignano's 750-acre estate, a place of organic farmland, heritage architecture and deep-rooted Tuscan traditions. Whether it's art, food, nature or solitude you seek, this villa offers a quiet, restorative space to embrace the best of countryside living.

A short drive brings you to the medieval streets of Volterra (15km) and the soaring towers of San Gimignano (19km), while Florence, Siena and the vineyards of Chianti are all within easy reach for day trips rich in culture, wine and beauty.

# Location & Local Information

Nestled within the wooded heart of Borgo Pignano’s spectacular 750-acre estate, The Artists’ House offers an idyllic hideaway surrounded by nature. Encircled by ancient oak and beech forest, this secluded stone villa provides a unique sense of peace and privacy, while remaining just a short walk or buggy ride from the estate’s many amenities.

Guests can explore the estate with ease using the golf buggy provided, making the most of Borgo Pignano’s Michelin-starred dining, spa, gym and beautifully maintained sports facilities including tennis, basketball and football courts. A nearby equestrian centre offers horseback adventures through the countryside, while the family pool, playground and children’s activities ensure all ages are well catered for.

Winding trails lead through aromatic herb gardens and olive groves, offering opportunities for walking, running and wildlife watching, keep your eyes peeled for deer, wild boar, owls and pheasants. The estate’s charming bottega sells homegrown produce and handmade goods, including estate-made honey, herbal teas, olive oil, wine and artisan toiletries crafted from lavender grown onsite.

Though its tranquil setting feels a world away, The Artists’ House is ideally located for discovering the best of Tuscany. Just 15km away lies the evocative hill town of Volterra, once an Etruscan stronghold, where cobbled lanes and alabaster workshops lead to historic landmarks like the Roman theatre and Palazzo dei Priori.

A little further, San Gimignano (19km) dazzles with its medieval towers, sweeping views and award-winning gelato. This UNESCO World Heritage site is an unmissable gem, rich in history and Tuscan charm.

Venture into the Chianti countryside and you’ll find some of Italy’s most iconic vineyards. Spend the day wine-tasting in picture-perfect villages like Castellina in Chianti (37km), known for its atmospheric cellars and rustic trattorias serving local specialities.

Cultural highlights lie within easy reach too. Siena (46km) enchants with its Gothic architecture, museums and the famous Piazza del Campo, while Florence (67km), the cradle of the Renaissance, offers an abundance of art, fashion and history along the banks of the Arno.

From woodland tranquillity to Tuscan treasures, The Artists’ House is perfectly placed for guests to enjoy the best of both worlds, seclusion and stillness, or cultural adventure at your fingertips.

- The second bedroom is open-plan with a sleigh bed and direct access to the garden, ideal for children or close friends.
- A golf buggy is provided to make accessing the estate's main facilities simple and enjoyable.
- The studio-style layout means shared living spaces are cosy and open.

- **Security deposit:** Credit card details are required on arrival for pre-authorisation.
- **Arrival time:** 4 p.m. Check-in outside this time may be subject to an extra cost. Please enquire for more details.
