

Pomme de Pin

Overview

Surrounded by towering pines, Pomme de Pin is a radiant sanctuary where nature and refinement coexist in perfect harmony. Set within a protected pine forest near Hyères and the Giens Peninsula, this 6-bedroom villa is a short walk away from the sandy curve of Plage des Pesquiers. Whether you begin the day with a swim in the Mediterranean or unwind on the shaded terrace as the scent of pine drifts through the air, every moment here is steeped in simple elegance and restorative calm.

Inside, Villa des Pesquiers is defined by its luminosity. Light pours into the open-plan living spaces through expansive windows, highlighting the clean lines, soft textures and natural palette that give the interiors their relaxed sophistication. Four of the six bedrooms are en suite, ideal for families or groups, each one thoughtfully styled for comfort and rest. We especially love the master bedroom with its beautiful upper terrace peeking through the pine trees towards the sea.

Step outside and the Mediterranean lifestyle unfolds in full. A generous terrace surrounds the swimming pool (that can be heated for a supplement), perfect for warm afternoons or evening aperitifs beneath the stars. On the other side of the villa, a pétanque court nestles under the pines, offering moments of play and relaxation.

The villa's privileged location near Hyères sets it apart. From your doorstep, nature trails and coastal walks wind past salt marshes where flamingos roam, while nearby beaches such as Plage de l'Almanarre and La Bergerie provide a choice of family-friendly coves and water sports hotspots.

Within easy reach, the historic heart of Hyères and charming Carqueiranne offer vibrant markets, marina views and a taste of Provençal life. For those drawn to discovery, boat trips from La Tour Fondue reveal the wild beauty of Porquerolles Island.

For those seeking a contemporary coastal escape, this villa promises the scent of pines, sea air and the luxury of time well spent.

Location & Local Information

Surrounded by pine trees and close to Hyères, Pomme de Pin offers a truly idyllic coastal escape. This beautiful corner of southern France is famed for its unspoilt natural beauty, where sea breezes mingle with the scent of resinous woodland and the turquoise waters of the Mediterranean beckon just moments from your door. From your villa, a footpath heads through the pines to Plage des Pesquiers, perfect for morning swims or afternoons under the sun.

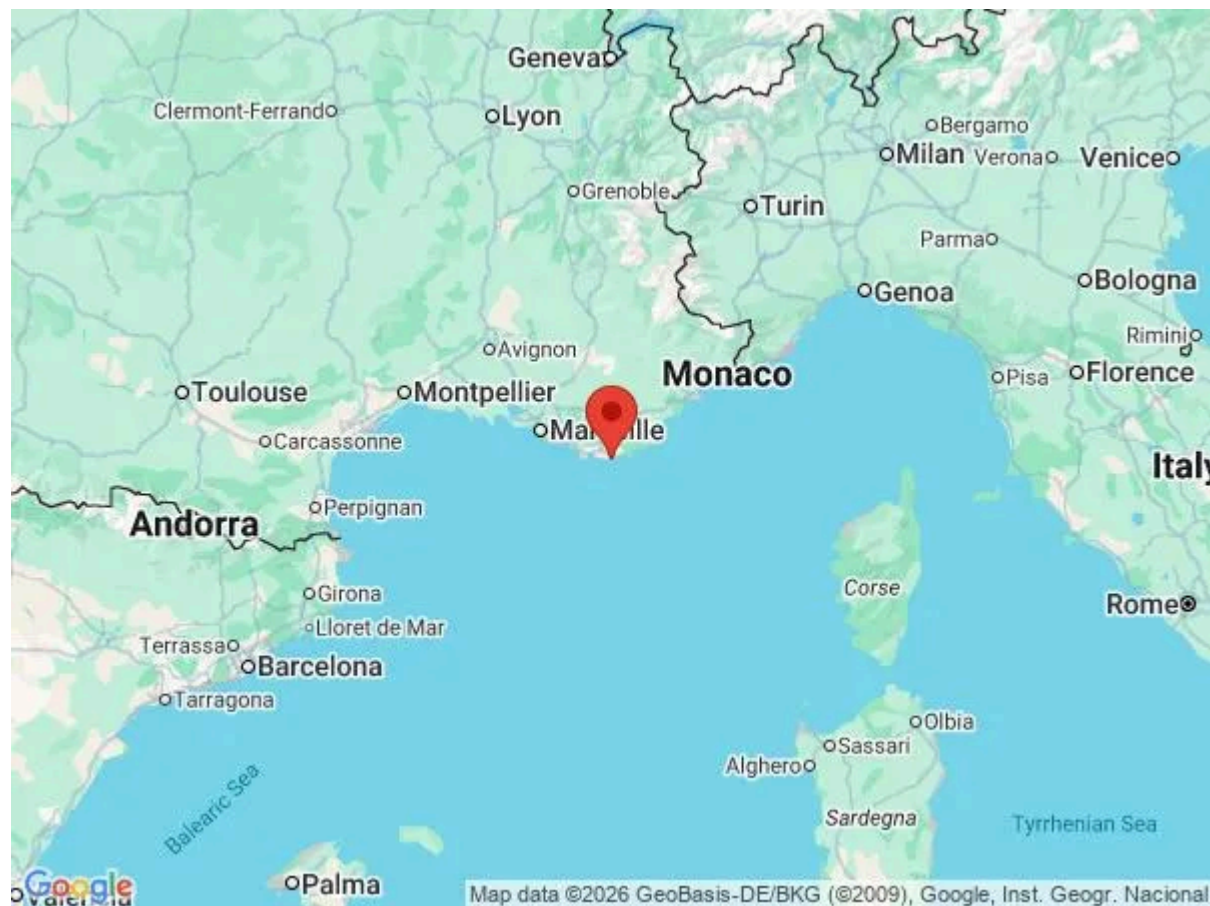
Not far from the villa lies Le Salin des Pesquiers, a protected salt marsh and nature reserve where flamingos often wade in shimmering pink pools. To the west, the expansive Plage de l'Almanarre stretches for five kilometres, offering excellent windsurfing and kitesurfing conditions as well as stunning sunsets over the bay. On the peninsula's eastern edge, a little further south, Plage La Bergerie promises soft sands and calm shallows ideal for family swims and watersports.

A short drive leads to La Tour Fondue (6km), the southernmost tip of the peninsula and departure point for boats to Porquerolles Island. This car-free gem is a must-visit, with its pristine beaches, eucalyptus groves and secluded coves – perfect for cycling or picnicking.

For a dose of French Riviera charm, the bustling centre of Hyères (6.5km) offers a vibrant mix of historic architecture, colourful markets and alfresco dining, while the seaside town of Carqueiranne (9km) is known for its pretty marina, market square and laid-back atmosphere.
