

Villa Bollicine

Overview

In this wonderful corner of northern Italy, Villa Bollicine offers an attractive setting for family and friends to reconnect in style. Set just 11km from the centre of Trieste, this spacious villa offers contemporary comforts and a sociable base for up to 12 guests. From poolside afternoons to long dinners by the barbecue, this is a home that invites togetherness.

Spread across two distinct yet connected spaces, the main villa hosts a ground-floor en suite double bedroom, an open-plan kitchen-diner and lounge with doors opening to the covered terrace. Upstairs, another living area with a large sofa and TV provides a quiet space to unwind alongside a double, twin and shared shower room.

The guest annexe, accessed from the rear, is a duplex retreat of its own. With a spiral staircase, lounge with sofa bed, kitchen corner and a double bedroom, it offers just the right amount of privacy for guests seeking a little independence.

Outside, the swimming pool glows in the evening light, perfect for cooling off after days exploring the coast. A sauna adds a touch of charm and indulgence, while the patio areas set the stage for lazy lunches or a sunset aperitivo. With air conditioning and Wi-Fi throughout, you can stay as connected (or unplugged, as you choose).

Villa Bollicine is located on the edge of the village of Prosecco, a name that evokes celebration (though today the sparkling wine is no longer produced in the area). From here, stroll to local restaurants and shops or follow the steep hillside path to the seafront and the romantic Miramare Castle.

Trieste is just a short drive away (or hop on the bus from Prosecco). This cultured, sea-facing city exudes old-world charm with grand squares, literary cafés and a striking blend of Central European and Mediterranean influences.

Whether you're day-tripping into Slovenia, exploring Trieste's cobbled streets or simply lingering poolside with a cool drink in hand, Villa Bollicine is your gateway to a joyful, flavour-filled adventure on Italy's northeastern coast.

Ground Floor

- Open-plan living-dining area and doors opening to terrace
- Open-plan kitchen, well-equipped including oven, toaster, kettle, blender and coffee maker
- Bedroom with queen-size double bed (160cm), garden access and air-conditioning
- En suite bathroom with walk-in shower, hand basin and WC

First Floor

- Living room with large sofa, TV and terrace
- Bedroom with queen-size double bed (160cm), sofa-bed, doors opening to upper terrace and air-conditioning
- Bedroom with two single beds (90cm each), doors opening to upper terrace and air-conditioning

Location & Local Information

Just outside the village Prosecco, Villa Bollicine offers a wonderful base from which to explore the vibrant region surrounding Trieste. Just a short stroll from the village centre (via local roads, no pavement), this attractive residential neighbourhood enjoys scenic walking and biking trails on your doorstep. The village itself gave its name to the famous sparkling wine, though today it's no longer known for its wine production. From here, you can descend on foot to the picturesque seafront and visit the majestic Miramare Castle – a 35-minute walk down, though be prepared for a longer climb back!

In just a brief drive or taxi/bus ride from Prosecco, you'll find yourself in the heart of Trieste (11 km), a historic port city full of faded grandeur and Habsburg-era elegance. Wander its grand piazzas, sip espresso in atmospheric cafés and take in sweeping views of the Adriatic. The city's maritime character blends beautifully with its Central European heritage, creating a culture-rich destination perfect for relaxed exploration.

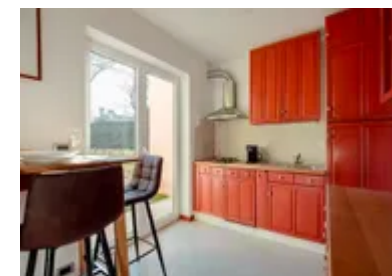
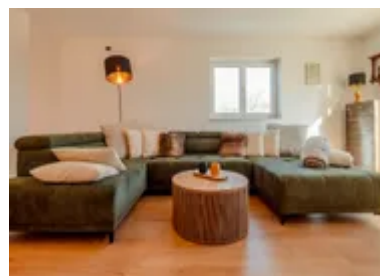
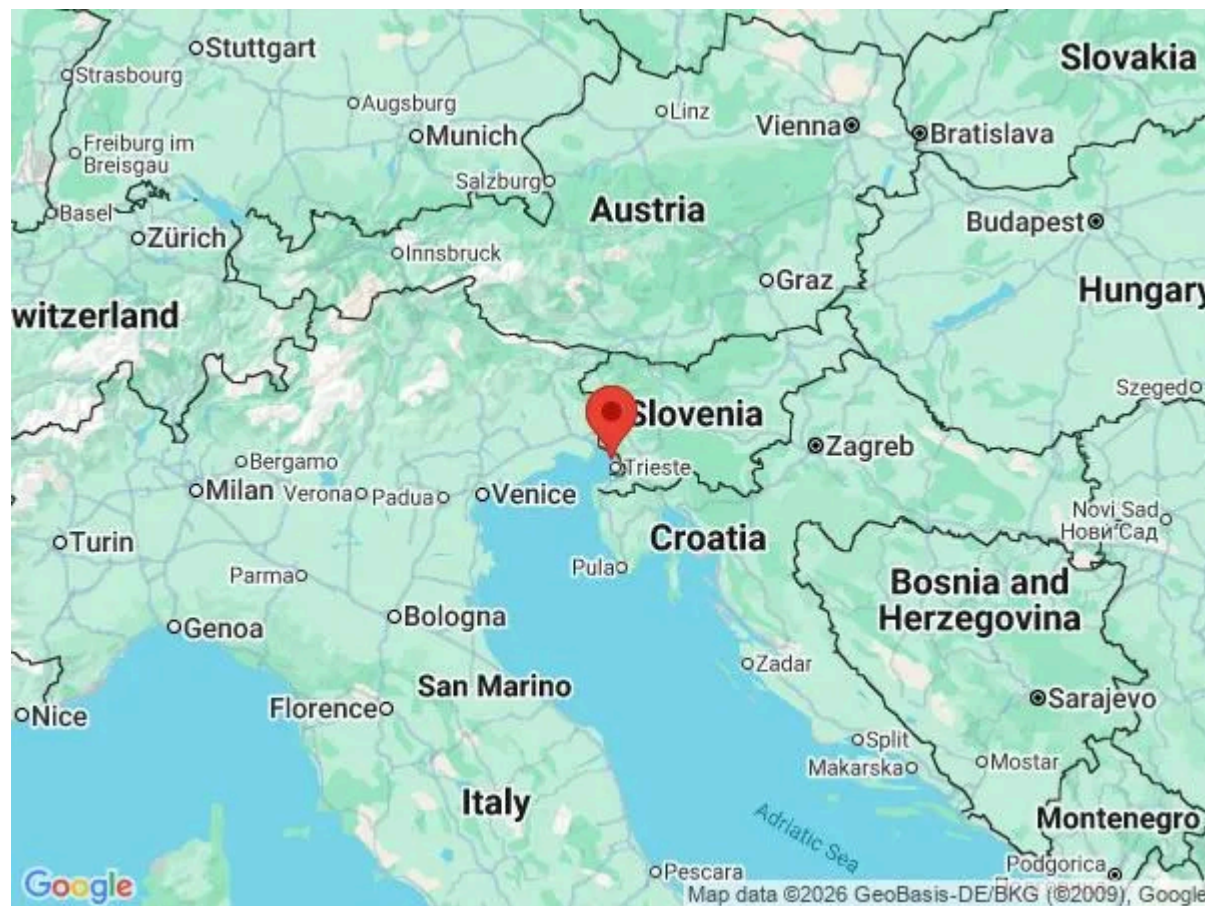
Don't miss the Old Town, where narrow cobbled lanes wind past medieval churches and Roman ruins. Climb up to Castello di San Giusto for panoramic vistas, then head down to the waterfront to enjoy the vibrant atmosphere. With cycling tours and sailing excursions available nearby, Trieste is not only for culture lovers but for active explorers too. Golf enthusiasts will also appreciate the Trieste Golf Club, just 15 minutes away.

Villa Bollicine is perfectly placed for unforgettable day trips into Slovenia. Visit the fairytale coastal town of Piran, delve into the awe-inspiring Postojna Cave and the dramatic clifftop Predjama Castle or venture into the UNESCO-listed Škocjan Caves, all within a 30 to 60-minute drive. Culture seekers will be drawn to the elegant capital Ljubljana (93 km), while nature lovers can revel in the alpine beauty of Lake Bled, just under two hours away.

Meanwhile, seasonal events add to the region's charm – in summer, join locals at lively sagra festivals with music, dancing, and traditional fare. In spring and autumn, experience the rustic delight of Osmiza, where farmers open their homes to offer homemade cheeses, meats, eggs and wine. Local cuisine reflects the area's rich cultural mix – expect Mediterranean seafood alongside hearty Slovenian-influenced dishes, making every meal a celebration of this unique corner of Europe.

What you should know...

- Villa Bollicine sleeps 8-12 guests across four bedrooms and two sofa-beds. One of the bedrooms and a sofa-bed is in a duplex guesthouse/annexe (with access via the back of the main villa) – please see the “Layout” tab for full details.
- Air-conditioning is featured in bedrooms only.
- There is a ground-floor bedroom in the main part of the villa, however guests do need to be able to manage a few steps across the property.
- You can walk to the local village (along local roads, no pavement), and there are buses/taxis from Prosecco to Trieste, however a car is still strongly recommended to be able to reach amenities and explore the region (and visit Slovenia for the day).
