

Le Six de Generille

Overview

Surrounded by far-reaching countryside, Le Six de Générille offers a charming slice of Dordogne life in a beautifully renovated abode. This traditional, detached home sits within a spacious garden, sharing its grounds with a neighbouring rental cottage and the owners' main residence. It's a place where the rhythm slows and long summer days are best enjoyed poolside or beneath the dappled shade of a terrace pergola.

Inside, the open-plan living space invites relaxed gatherings, with soft natural light streaming through pretty windows. The ground floor hosts a zip-and-link king-size bedroom with ensuite bathroom, while upstairs two king-size double rooms share a stylish family shower room, making the property ideal for families or couples travelling together. Each space is warm, unfussy and full of country character, while modern touches like Wi-Fi and a stylish kitchen ensure comfort and convenience throughout.

Outside, your very own terrace is perfect for morning coffees or grilled lunches in the dappled shade. Children can play on the lawn, challenge each other to a game of darts or badminton, or head straight for the heated 16-metre swimming pool, which is shared only when the neighbouring cottage (La Petite Maison Générille (<https://www.oliverstravels.com/france/south-west-france/aquitaine/la-petite-maison-generille/>)) is rented at the same time. A poolside shower and loungers complete the relaxed outdoor lifestyle.

Set in a little hamlet just 7km from the riverside town of Beynac-et-Cazenac, the location offers the best of both countryside charm and access. Explore the Dordogne by canoe, dine at wonderful restaurants and wander the ancient lanes of Domme and Sarlat-la-Canéda, each bursting with local charm and markets. Early risers might catch the unforgettable sight of hot air balloons drifting over the valley's morning mist.

For those seeking a gentle pace of life, days spent in the garden or exploring storied towns nearby, Le Six de Générille promises a laid-back Dordogne getaway with all the comforts of home.

Main Level (via exterior steps)

- Open-plan living area with sofa, TV and Wi-Fi internet. Doors open to terrace and garden
- Open-plan kitchen and dining area, well-equipped including oven and hob, dishwasher, fridge-freezer and microwave
- Bedroom 1 with king-size double bed (zip and link, can be split as twin) and en suite WC, bath/shower, twin hand basin and washing machine

First Floor (via open-tread stairs)

- Bedroom 2 with king-size double bed
- Separate bathroom with WC, shower and hand basin
- Bedroom 3 with king-size double bed

Outside Grounds

- Shared heated saltwater swimming pool (16x4m)
- Shared poolside area with loungers, deck chairs and shower
- Shaded terrace with seating and dining area
- Barbecue
- Shared large garden with badminton net and olive trees (leading out to open countryside and woodland)



Location & Local Information

In a little countryside hamlet in the Dordogne, Le Six de Générille offers an idyllic holiday home with easy access to some of the region's most enchanting sites. Just 3km away, guests will find a local *boulangerie*, a small grocer, a tabac and a traditional butcher – perfect for stocking up on essentials or picking up fresh pastries for breakfast.

Around 7km by car brings you to the picturesque riverside village of Beynac-et-Cazenac, where golden-stone houses climb steeply beneath the impressive silhouette of a medieval château. Explore its charming cobbled streets, enjoy a meal by the water's edge, or paddle along the river by canoe to admire the dramatic scenery from a new angle.

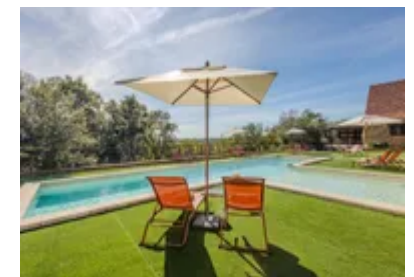
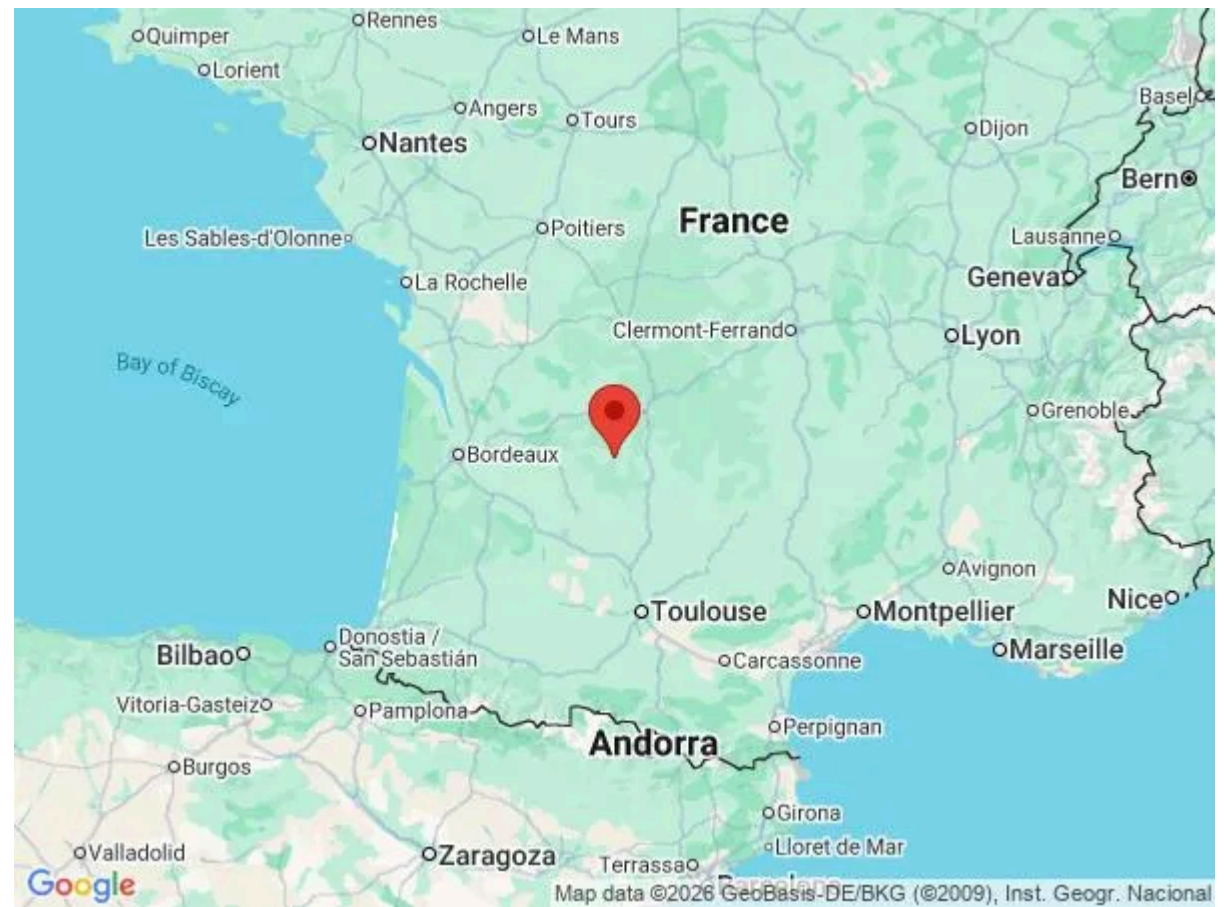
A little further afield lies Domme, a captivating bastide town perched high above the Dordogne valley, famed for its sweeping views and colourful hot-air balloons that drift across the sky. The village is well equipped with restaurants and amenities, while nearby La Roque-Gageac delights with its riverside promenade, striking cliff-hugging buildings and scenic boat trips.

No visit is complete without exploring Sarlat-la-Canéda, just 15km away. Famed for its beautifully preserved medieval architecture, lively markets and rich culinary scene, Sarlat's winding alleys and atmospheric squares make it a must-see highlight of the region.

For lovers of the outdoors, the surrounding Dordogne landscape is a playground of activity – from canoeing and hiking to cycling and village-hopping. With its fusion of unspoiled nature, rich heritage, and world-class gastronomy, Le Six de Générille is ideally placed for an unforgettable Dordogne experience.

- This detached house is set in a large garden alongside one another holiday rental (La Petite Maison Générille (<https://www.oliverstravels.com/france/south-west-france/aquitaine/la-petite-maison-generille/>)) and the owner's own residence – the swimming pool and lawn area are shared with the holiday rental next door
- There is also the option to book both houses together to sleep up to 10 guests - please see Le Mas Générille (<https://www.oliverstravels.com/france/south-west-france/aquitaine/le-mas-generille/>).
- It is not possible to book just Le Six de Générille in high season - during this time, both houses must be booked together.
