

Le Mas Generille

Region: Dordogne Sleeps: 10

Overview

Surrounded by rolling fields and woodland, Le Mas Générille offers a relaxed slice of Dordogne life in a setting that feels both timeless and restorative. Set within a generous garden, these two side-by-side detached dwellings offer the charm of traditional French architecture with the ease of modern living. Whether gathering as a larger group or seeking space to retreat, these thoughtfully renovated homes invite you to slow down and savour every moment.

The main house welcomes guests with light-filled interiors and an open-plan layout perfect for sociable living. Downstairs, a spacious en suite bedroom with a king-size zip-and-link bed offers privacy and convenience, while upstairs two further double bedrooms share a family shower room. Character is found in every detail, from soft neutral palettes to pretty windows, while the well-equipped kitchen and Wi-Fi throughout ensure everyday comfort.

Just across the garden, a 2-bedroom cottage provides a charming hideaway for up to four guests. Inside, exposed beams, a wood-burning stove and a spiral staircase create a space that feels both cosy and stylish. The shaded terraces outside both houses call for long lunches and sunset suppers, with birdsong and rustling leaves as your soundtrack.

The grounds are a natural extension of the home, where open lawns melt into wooded countryside and a 16-metre heated swimming pool invites lazy afternoons in the sun. Mornings might begin with coffee overlooking the garden. Evenings bring the scent of barbecue smoke as twilight settles over your surroundings.

Ideally located for exploring the Dordogne, Le Mas Générille is just ten minutes by car from the riverside beauty of Beynac-et-Cazenac. Here, honey-coloured buildings and café terraces line the water's edge, while nearby Domme offers spectacular views and a glimpse of hot-air balloons floating above the valley. The medieval heart of Sarlat-la-Canéda is close by too, with bustling markets, historic façades and gourmet delights around every corner.

For families, couples or small groups seeking a slower rhythm in the French countryside, Le Mas Générille is a place to reconnect, recharge and revel in the simple pleasures of rural life.

Main House Interiors (6 guests)

Main Level (via exterior steps)

- Open-plan living area with sofa, TV and Wi-Fi internet. Doors open to terrace and garden
- Open-plan kitchen and dining area, well-equipped including oven and hob, dishwasher, fridge-freezer and microwave
- Bedroom 1 with king-size double bed (zip and link, can be split as twin) and en suite WC, bath/shower, twin hand basin and washing machine

First Floor (via open-tread stairs)

- Bedroom 2 with king-size double bed
- Separate bathroom with WC, shower and hand basin
- Bedroom 3 with king-size double bed

Smaller Cottage Interiors (4 guests)

- Open-plan living and dining area (63m² including kitchen) with sofa, wood-burning stove, TV, dining table and Wi-Fi internet. Doors open to terrace and garden
- Open-plan kitchen with oven and hob, dishwasher and fridge freezer

First Floor (sloping ceilings, accessed via spiral open-tread staircase)

- Bedroom (19m²) with double bed

Location & Local Information

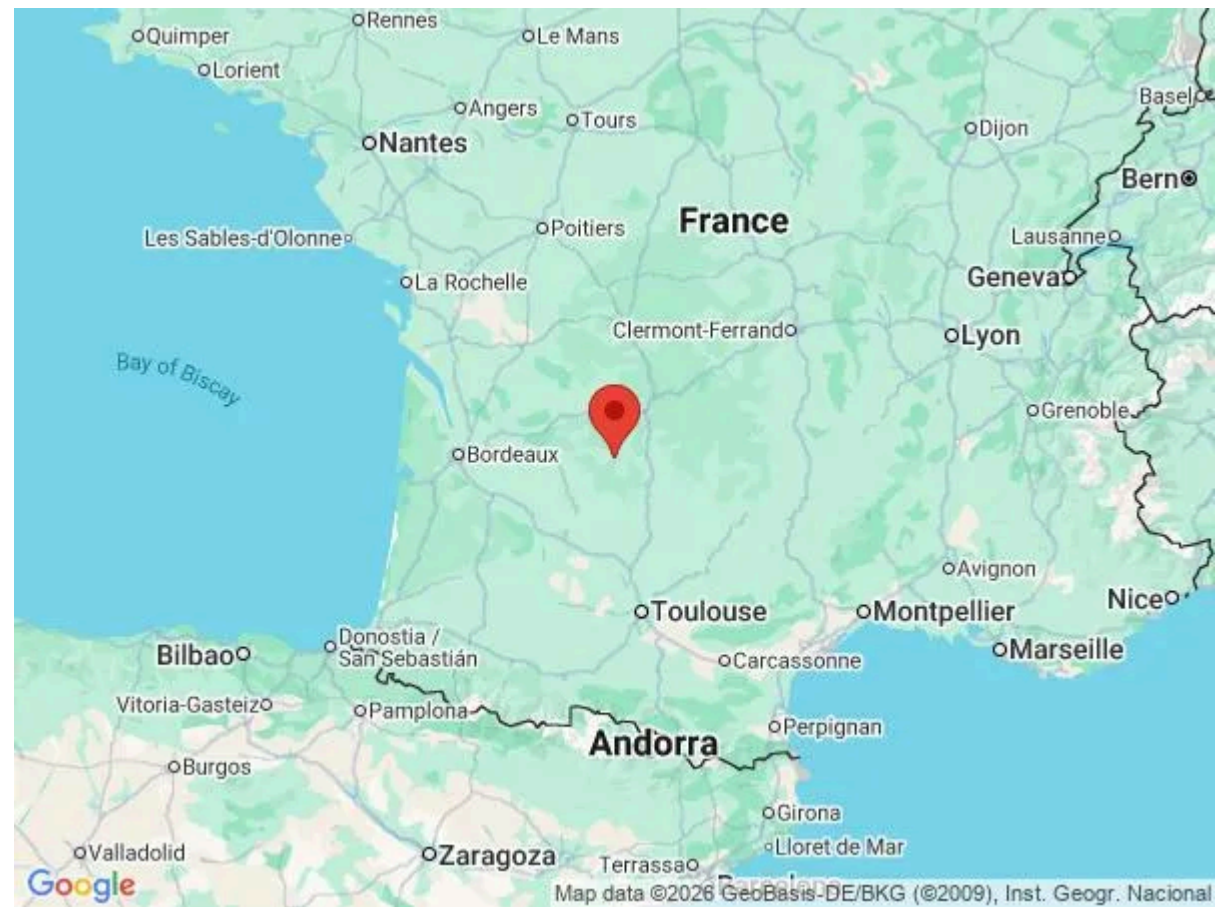
Located in a tiny hamlet amid the rolling hills of the Dordogne, Le Mas Générille is a charming countryside home offering effortless access to some of the region's most captivating treasures. This picturesque setting allows you to experience the authentic pace of rural French life, with essential amenities just 3km away including a boulangerie, a butcher, a grocer and a local tabac.

Within a 10-minute drive lies the enchanting riverside village of Beynac-et-Cazenac, where honey-hued houses climb towards a commanding medieval château. Meander through the narrow, cobbled lanes, dine at a restaurant terrace overlooking the Dordogne River or set off on a canoe to take in the valley's dramatic vistas from the water. It's the perfect blend of history, charm and scenic beauty.

Venture a little further and you'll discover Domme, a fortified hilltop village that rewards visitors with panoramic views over the valley below. The town is renowned for its bastide architecture and is a favourite launch point for the colourful hot-air balloons that float across the sky in summer. Nearby, La Roque-Gageac offers another magical setting with its cliff-top dwellings, riverside cafés and leisurely boat trips along the Dordogne.

Just 15km from the house, the medieval town of Sarlat-la-Canéda is a cultural gem. Its beautifully preserved stone buildings, bustling markets and rich gastronomic scene make it a must-visit. Whether you're browsing truffle stalls, sampling regional delicacies or soaking in the lively atmosphere of its squares, Sarlat is a feast for the senses.

Surrounded by charming villages and untouched countryside, Le Mas Générille is ideally positioned for days filled with outdoor adventures, from kayaking and cycling to hiking ancient trails or exploring local vineyards. Here, nature, culture and cuisine come together in perfect harmony, offering guests a truly memorable Dordogne escape.

What you should know...

- Le Mas Générille sleeps up to 10 guests across two separate dwellings - a 3-bedroom house and a separate 2-bedroom cottage. Please see the "Layout" tab for details.

- The hospitable owners live on site. Please note, the owners keep to themselves and do not use the pool or garden whilst there are guests.
- If staying with children, please take care on the stairs including the spiral open-tread staircase to the first-floor bedrooms in the smaller cottage.

- **Security deposit:** €1000 charged to client's credit card by Oliver's Travels as a pre-authorisation at least 2 weeks prior to arrival and refunded two weeks after departure, subject to full inspection.
- **Arrival time:** 4.00 p.m.
