

# Villa Alikon

## Overview

Surrounded by olive groves and cypress trees, Villa Alikon is a beautifully crafted Zakynthian retreat, built from honey-toned stone with wrought-iron balconies overlooking the Ionian Sea. Inside, exposed stone walls and timber beams evoke a rustic warmth, complemented by plush furnishings and carefully curated details. The open-plan living area is airy and inviting, seamlessly connecting to the terrace to welcome the sea breeze. Each of the three en-suite bedrooms offers a peaceful, private space for relaxation.

The villa's lower level features a spacious games room, complete with a bar, pool table, darts, foosball and more, an unexpected highlight ideal for family fun or evening entertainment. Above, the sunlit kitchen is fully equipped for relaxed cooking, with meals best enjoyed on the shaded terrace as the sun begins to set.

Outdoors, a private swimming pool forms the centrepiece of a generous terrace framed by palms and stone pathways. Sun loungers, parasols, and a built-in barbecue invite all-day enjoyment and leisurely evenings. Set in the quiet village of Tragaki, Villa Alikon offers a serene base from which to unwind. Nearby vineyards and winding lanes reflect the island's slower pace, while sandy beaches and the lively resort of Tsilivi are just a short drive away.

## Location & Local Information

Villa Alikon is nestled in the peaceful village of Tragaki, a serene enclave in the hills above Zakynthos' north-eastern coast. This part of the island is known for its traditional stone houses, lush groves of olives and citrus, and a slower pace of life that instantly invites you to unwind. Local tavernas serve homemade fare just minutes from the villa, while the nearby town of Tsilivi, less than ten minutes by car, offers a livelier atmosphere with shops, bakeries, bars and beachfront dining.

Amboula Beach, a quiet and gently sloping stretch of coastline, lies just 3km away and is perfect for paddling or a morning swim, while the more vibrant Tsilivi Beach is ideal for water sports and sunset cocktails. Families will enjoy the Tsilivi Water Park, a short drive away, or a boat trip from the port to explore hidden coves and the island's famous Blue Caves.

Zakynthos, or Zante as it's locally known, is steeped in Venetian and Byzantine history, which can be explored in the island capital, just 15 minutes away. Here you'll find bustling squares, museums, and charming alleyways offering a taste of local culture. For nature lovers, the surrounding hills offer scenic walks through vineyards and pine forest.
