Overview

Surrounded by citrus trees and olive groves, Villa Aquarelle I is a serene, single-level retreat in southern Kefalonia, where contemporary design meets exceptional accessibility. Spanning sixty-seven square metres, the villa features an airy, open-plan layout with natural textures, a soft neutral palette, and floor-to-ceiling sliding doors that flood the space with light.

Inside, guests will find a fully equipped kitchen, a sociable dining area, and two king-size bedrooms, each with its own en-suite bathroom. The interiors are calm and understated, with every detail designed for comfort and ease. The villa is entirely wheelchair-accessible, featuring wide entrances, a barrier-free layout, and a private pool with a hydraulic lift, ensuring independence without compromising on style.

Outdoors, a generous three-hundred-square-metre garden invites relaxation. Pomegranate and citrus trees provide dappled shade over the flat lawn, while parasols and loungers line the thirty-square-metre infinity pool. A built-in barbecue and shaded dining area are perfect for alfresco meals, and a hammock offers a peaceful spot for reading or stargazing.

Peacefully located yet within easy reach of Kefalonia's beaches and villages, Villa Aquarelle I offers a harmonious blend of privacy and connection, ideal for couples, families, or friends seeking a restorative escape.

Location & Local Information

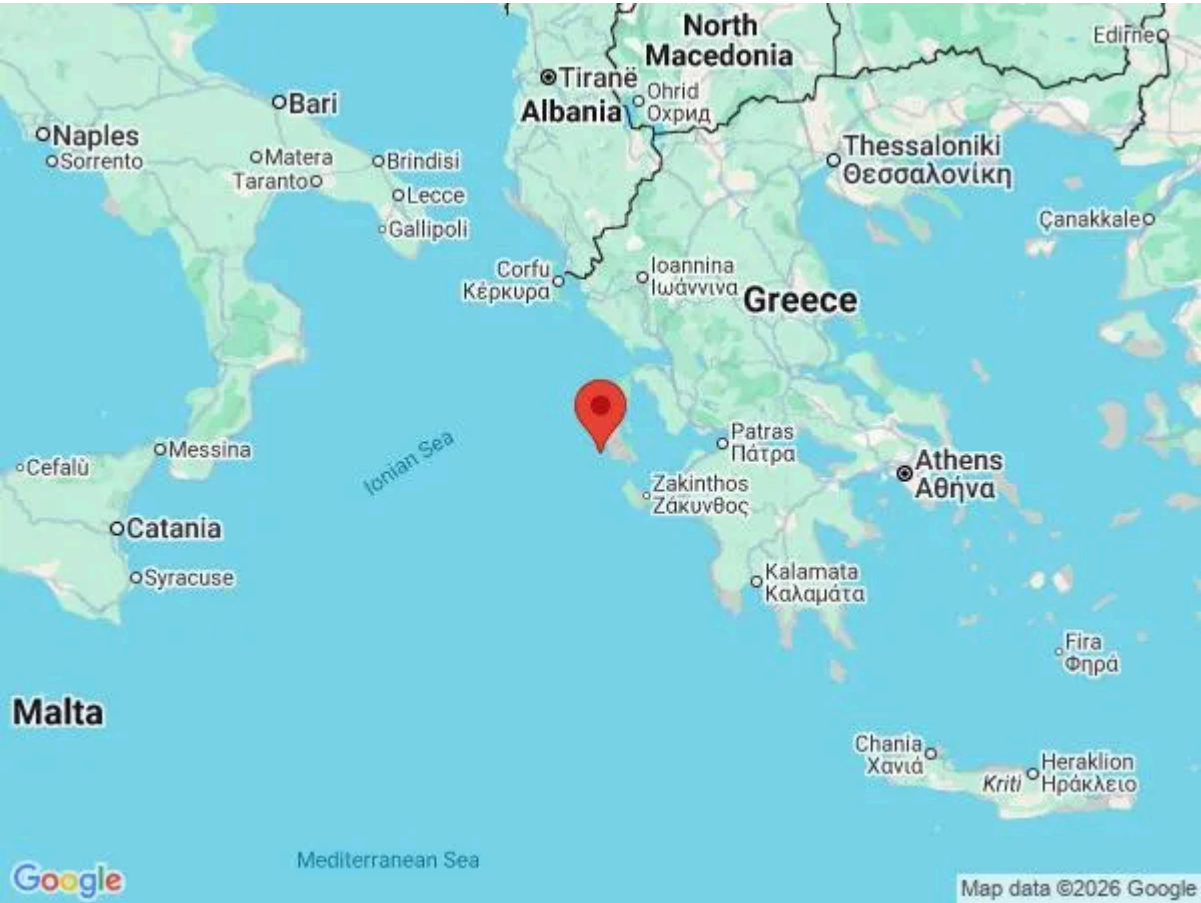
Kefalonia is a breathtaking Greek island known for its dramatic landscapes, where turquoise seas meet rugged cliffs and pine-covered mountains. Famous for its stunning beaches, such as Myrtos, colourful villages, and crystal-clear waters, it offers a quieter, more authentic feel than some of its neighbours. From underground lakes and hidden coves to warm hospitality and incredible local food, Kefalonia is the kind of place that effortlessly invites you to slow down and soak it all in.

Lixouri is the lively port town of Kefalonia’s Paliki peninsula, offering a relaxed yet vibrant atmosphere with numerous local shops, cafes, banks, and pharmacies, all set along a charming seafront. Just a 10–15-minute drive away, the complex is tucked into the peaceful area of Vrachinari, hidden within a wooded landscape of pine, olive, and cypress trees. The villas are surrounded by beautifully landscaped gardens filled with native Mediterranean plants and fragrant flowers, including pomegranate, orange, acacia, oleander, angelica, bougainvillea, and basil.

Nearby Kounopetra, literally meaning “moving rock”, is famous for its unique natural phenomenon: a large rock formation in the sea that is said to move continuously, adding a touch of legend and wonder to this tranquil corner of the island.
