With its shady plane trees, Mas Tout Jaune is a radiant 18th-century estate where timeless charm meets modern comfort. Set within 1.5 hectares of private grounds near Châteaurenard, this beautifully restored mas invites you to slow down, soak up the surroundings and savour the simple pleasures of Provençal living.


Sleeping up to 11 guests, this holiday abode is a harmonious blend of rustic character and contemporary flair across the main part of the house and a self-contained annexe. Original stone walls and exposed beams whisper of its history, while thoughtfully designed interiors offer modern conveniences including air-conditioning. A large, sociable kitchen flows into a cosy lounge, while a separate reading nook and children's room provide space for both conviviality and calm. The spa-style hot tub is an extra touch of decadence.

Outside, the pleasures of Provence unfold effortlessly. Sip your morning coffee beneath the dappled shade of ancient trees and cool off in the 10-metre pool, which features a flat motorised cover for warmth and safety. A trampoline and swing set make this an ideal retreat for families, while long summer days invite lazy barbecues and evening apéritifs accompanied by the sound of cicadas. Children will love collecting fresh eggs from the hens, admiring the resident horses and discovering the rhythms of French life.

Perfectly poised between the cultural landmarks of Avignon and the artistic soul of Saint-Rémy-de-Provence, Mas Tout Jaune offers a great base for exploring the region. From nearby Maillane, Eyragues and Châteaurenard to the olive-clad hills of Les Alpilles and the medieval beauty of Les Baux, this part of Provence brims with colour, flavour and history.

Location & Local Information

Mas Tout Jaune is located between the historic city of Avignon and the beloved town of Saint-Rémy-de-Provence, an ideal base for exploring this wonderful part of Provence and beyond.

Located on the road connecting Tarascon and Châteaurenard, just a few minutes' drive brings you to the charming villages of Graveson (3.5km), Maillane (5km) and Eyragues (5.5km), where you'll find a good range of amenities. Châteaurenard (4.5km), a larger town with a lively Provençal spirit, is also close by with its restaurants, shady squares and Sunday morning market.

Saint-Rémy-de-Provence (11.5km) is one of the region's most characterful towns, known for its elegant boulevards, Wednesday morning market and artistic heritage. Framed by plane trees and centuries-old architecture, the town has long inspired creatives, most famously Vincent van Gogh, who painted many of his masterpieces here. Today, visitors can stroll its cobbled streets lined with galleries, restaurants and inviting café terraces or explore the nearby Roman ruins of Glanum for a glimpse into its ancient past.

Nature lovers and art enthusiasts alike will be drawn to the spectacular landscapes of Les Alpilles, a regional park of limestone hills, olive groves and pine forests. Within half an hour, you can reach the picturesque village of Eygalières or the dramatic hilltop setting of Les Baux-de-Provence, both renowned for their scenery, galleries and gourmet cuisine.

A short drive north takes you to Avignon (12km), a UNESCO World Heritage site famed for its imposing Palais des Papes, medieval ramparts and annual theatre festival. Whether you're visiting for its culture, riverside cafés or bustling indoor market, Avignon's rich heritage and lively atmosphere make it a must-see.
