

# Villa Vue De Fayence

## Overview

Villa Vue de Fayence is a refined countryside retreat with far-reaching views from its master bedroom balcony. A long, gated driveway leads to this beautifully designed home, where 3,500 square metres of private grounds unfold into Provençal gardens, shaded seating areas and an inviting poolside terrace.

Inside, the villa exudes a sense of cosy elegance, with spacious open-plan interiors and gentle nods to traditional living. The ground floor flows effortlessly from a fully equipped kitchen to a bright dining and living area, where glass doors open onto the covered terrace, perfect for long summer lunches by the barbecue. Upstairs, the master bedroom enjoys a private balcony with panoramic views of the countryside, while two further double bedrooms and a large family bathroom offer flexible accommodation for families or friends.

Outside, the private 10-metre pool is framed by sun loungers and quiet corners to read, relax or sip something chilled. Overlooking the pool, a tree-shaded seating area comes to life at night with soft lighting, setting the tone for laid-back evenings under the stars.

From morning coffee to evening aperitifs, Villa Vue de Fayence is made for outdoor living, yet remains fully connected with Wi-Fi, UK TV and all the comforts of a high-quality home. With only a handful of distant neighbours, you'll feel at peace, yet just a 3km drive brings you to Fayence, a charming village where boulangeries, markets and restaurants spill onto cobbled streets.

The surrounding region offers even more to explore. The shimmering waters of Lac de Saint-Cassien are just 20 minutes away, perfect for kayaking or lakeside picnics. For a touch of Riviera glamour, Cannes and its golden beaches are within 40 minutes by car or spend the day by the coast in Saint-Raphaël and Fréjus.

Whether gathering for a summer escape or simply enjoying the slow rhythms of the Riviera hinterland, Villa Vue de Fayence invites you to experience the beautiful countryside and perched villages of the Pays de Fayence.


All essential amenities can be found in Fayence, including several boulangeries, small grocery shops and a generous selection of excellent restaurants. A hypermarket is conveniently located just a 10-minute drive away, making stocking up for your stay easy and stress-free. You'll also find a wealth of dining options and amenities in nearby villages such as Seillans, Bargemon, Callian and Montauroux, each offering their own unique charm and character.

Just 20 minutes from the villa, the stunning Lac de Saint-Cassien is a must-visit. Its clear waters are bordered by quiet beaches and picnic spots, creating an idyllic spot to unwind. The lake also offers plenty of summer fun for the adventurous – rent a kayak, canoe, or pedalo and spend the afternoon exploring its peaceful shores. It's a fantastic destination for families and couples alike.

For a taste of the Côte d'Azur glamour, Cannes (44km) is a wonderful day trip. Stroll along the iconic Croisette, browse high-end boutiques or relax on one of the city's famous sandy beaches. Alternatively, head south to the historic coastal towns of Fréjus and Saint-Raphaël, both around 40 minutes away, where glorious beaches, bustling harbours and lively markets offer a different flavour of Riviera life.
