

La Petite Forge

Region: Languedoc Sleeps: 6

Overview

At the end of a little lane in the heart of the Aude, La Petite Forge promises a stay steeped in warmth, comfort and charm. This traditional stone cottage captures the essence of rural French living, where sunny afternoons and meals shared al fresco set the rhythm of the day. A shared courtyard path leads to the front door, opening into interiors full of character, with thick old walls that naturally keep the house cool through the summer months.

Inside, the mood is unpretentious and relaxed. The open-plan ground floor flows easily between kitchen, dining and living area, creating a cosy social space for up to 6 guests. The kitchen, with its farmhouse feel, is well-equipped for simple home cooking, whether you're preparing breakfast for the terrace or a family-style meal at the table. While Wi-Fi is available, the slow pace and gentle atmosphere might tempt guests to unplug altogether. Upstairs, three double bedrooms await alongside two family bathrooms (one on the ground floor).

Morning coffee tastes best under the covered terrace. The private 10-metre pool is a highlight, with its waterfall feature and seating area ideal for lounging with a book. As the day winds down, the barbecue invites long evenings under the stars, with the scent of grilled vegetables and local meats in the air.

Set in the small village of Villarzel-du-Razès, La Petite Forge feels off the beaten track, yet it is just half an hour from the fortified city of Carcassonne and its airport. There is a good restaurant within walking distance, while the nearby town of Limoux, known for its sparkling white wine, offers a full range of shops and dining options.

For those looking to embrace the simple pleasures of countryside living, La Petite Forge offers a setting where the days unfold gently, filled with sunshine, flavour and time well spent.

Location & Local Information

Located at the end of a small impasse that opens out to scenic countryside, this characterful home in Villarzel-du-Razès is in the heart of southern France. Set in an authentic village, the house offers an authentic rural experience with a restaurant within walking distance.

Head north along the winding country roads and in just 20 minutes you'll reach the village of Arzens, where a bakery awaits with its tempting selection of fresh pastries. For a wider range of amenities, the lively town of Limoux (13.5km) is nearby, home to everything from supermarkets and shops to cafés and its well-known weekly market. As the birthplace of Blanquette de Limoux, the town is steeped in winemaking heritage, with numerous local producers offering tastings in scenic vineyard settings.

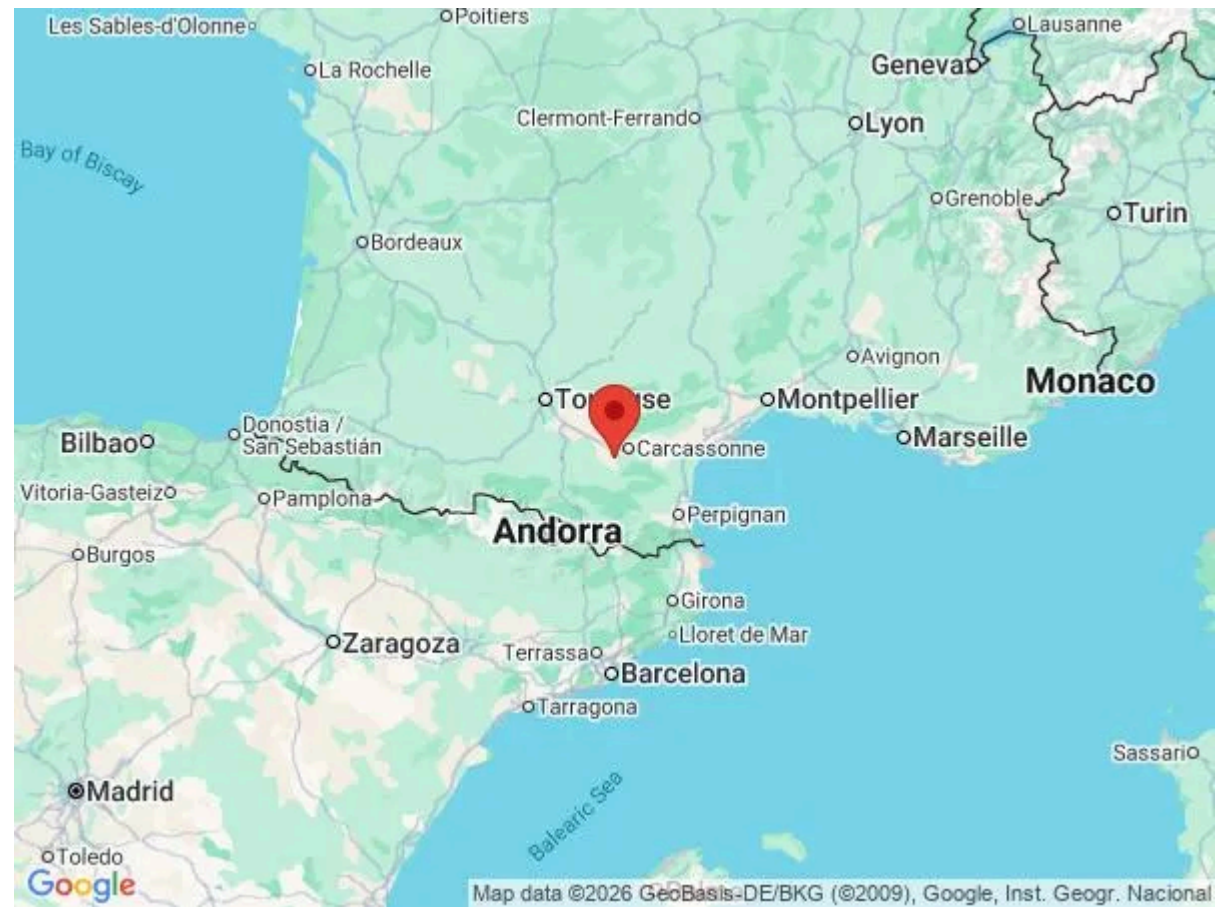
A 30-minute journey leads you to the spectacular fortified city of Carcassonne (20km), famed for its medieval ramparts, cobbled lanes and historic towers. Spend a day exploring this captivating citadel before relaxing by the tree-lined Canal du Midi, perfect for walking or cycling beside its tranquil waters and arched stone bridges.

For a change of scene, the picturesque town of Mirepoix (35km) is well worth a visit. Known for its medieval arcaded square and vibrant weekly market, it's a delightful place to unwind, browse local crafts and soak up the historic atmosphere. Don't miss the colourful Monday market, a regional favourite.

The wider area is also a haven for wine enthusiasts, with a wealth of nearby *domaines* offering tastings of regional reds, whites and sparkling wines - all within easy reach of the property.

- A car is essential in this remote part of France – there is car parking for two to three cars.
