Private parking adds a welcome convenience in this sought-after region.

Perched in the hills above Sorrento, Villa La Veduta enjoys a privileged position overlooking the Bay of Naples, with far-reaching views stretching towards Mount Vesuvius. The setting offers a peaceful retreat from the bustle of town, while still being within easy reach of Sorrento's vibrant centre.


Sorrento is known for its charming historic streets, lined with artisan boutiques, gelaterias and traditional trattorias serving local specialities such as fresh seafood, handmade pasta and limoncello crafted from the region's fragrant lemons. The Marina Grande provides a picturesque waterfront setting for relaxed lunches by the sea, while beach clubs and bathing platforms offer access to the clear Mediterranean waters during the summer months.

The villa's location makes it an excellent base for exploring the wider region. The Amalfi Coast's iconic towns, including Positano and Amalfi, can be reached by car or boat, offering dramatic coastal scenery and colourful architecture. Ferries connect Sorrento to the island of Capri, perfect for a day trip to explore hidden coves and elegant piazzas. For history enthusiasts, Pompeii and Herculaneum are within comfortable driving distance.

Villa La Veduta combines scenic tranquility with convenient access to some of southern Italy's most celebrated destinations.

- The bunk bed room in Villa La Veduta is only suitable for children due to the layout and the size of the beds.
- Please note that terraces and balconies have railings with large gaps, young children should be supervised at all times.
- A gardener will be present every morning to keep the garden in great shape, they will also collect fresh produce for all guests to enjoy.
