

Maison Nounou

Region: Provence-Alpes Sleeps: 4

Overview

Amid the gentle rhythms of Provençal farmland, Maison Nounou offers a rustic abode rich in character and charm. Part of a calm agricultural domaine just outside Arles, this welcoming home brings together traditional craftsmanship and laid-back comfort, with terracotta tiles, original wood beams and a delightfully relaxed atmosphere throughout.

The heart of the house is its expansive open-plan living and dining space, where a wood-burning stove and library invite slow mornings and cosy evenings. Double doors lead to a vast covered terrace, where long lunches turn into sunset aperitifs accompanied by good local wine. A few steps away, the rugged garden awaits where the pool glistens beneath Provençal skies and the barbecue sets the tone for sociable, alfresco evenings.

Back inside, a separate snug with a fireplace and sofa-beds offers a flexible corner for quiet reading, while the open-plan kitchen is well-equipped for relaxed holiday cooking. Meanwhile, both bedrooms are full of warmth and charm, with soft lighting, textured fabrics and handpicked details. A ground-floor double is served by a traditional bathroom, while upstairs, a pretty bedroom with desk and in-room bathtub is reached by a striking open-sided staircase.

Surrounded by open fields, Maison Nounou enjoys an authentic setting in the Camargue region. Just 8km away lies the storied city of Arles, where Roman ruins, open-air cafés and contemporary art create a vibrant cultural mosaic. Days out might take you to the wild wetlands of the Camargue, the seaside charm of Saintes-Maries-de-la-Mer or the rocky beauty of Les Alpilles and Les Baux-de-Provence. With Nîmes also within easy reach, the region's history and natural drama unfold all around you.

For those in search of a slow-paced escape with a sense of place and soul, Maison Nounou is a charming Provençal retreat.



Location & Local Information

On a restful agricultural estate just outside Arles, Maison Nounou offers an authentic setting close to the natural splendour of the Camargue. Surrounded by open farmland, where dogs roam freely and the rhythms of rural life unfold, this location invites guests to unwind and embrace the authenticity of southern France whilst remaining within easy reach of some of Provence's most captivating destinations.

Just 8km away, the UNESCO-listed city of Arles enchants with its rich Roman heritage, contemporary art scene and vibrant Provençal markets. Stroll through ancient amphitheatres, admire the legacy of Van Gogh or linger at a sunny café in Place du Forum.


For a taste of wild beauty, head south through vast plains and shimmering marshes to explore the Camargue, home to flamingos, white horses and salt lagoons. Continue to the iconic pilgrimage town of Saintes-Maries-de-la-Mer (32km), where sandy beaches meet the Mediterranean Sea.

To the north-east, a scenic drive brings you to the limestone peaks of Les Alpilles, a dramatic backdrop for one of the region's most breathtaking villages, Les Baux-de-Provence. Spend the morning wandering its cobbled lanes and exploring hilltop ruins before enjoying lunch in nearby Maussane-les-Alpilles or Paradou, both known for their relaxed atmosphere and superb regional cuisine. These charming spots are just 30–35 minutes away by car, making for a perfect day out.

Those with a love of history shouldn't miss Nîmes (36km), where Roman architecture rivals that of Arles. The majestic amphitheatre, Maison Carrée, and beautifully preserved temples speak to the city's ancient past, while stylish boutiques and bustling squares reflect its vibrant present.
