

Villa Marmara

Overview

Set among the olive-covered hillsides of southern Spartia, Villa Marmara offers a tranquil escape for couples or solo travellers seeking comfort, character, and calm. This two-storey maisonette blends understated style with thoughtful design, ideal for a peaceful retreat.

The upper level houses a serene master bedroom with an en-suite bathroom and separate dressing area, opening to views of the surrounding olive groves, rustic rooftops, and the Ionian Sea beyond. Natural textures and soft, earthy tones continue throughout the open-plan living area below, where a modern kitchenette and inviting seating create a relaxed, homely space.

Double doors lead to a private terrace with a saltwater pool edged in stone and framed by greenery. The outdoor area is perfectly suited for sunbathing, slow breakfasts or alfresco dinners as cicadas hum in the background. Rustic loungers sit beneath parasols, while the patio overlooks a Mediterranean garden rich with lavender, herbs, and native shrubs.

Tucked into the hillside of the Spartia peninsula, the villa offers both seclusion and convenience, just a short drive from sandy beaches, traditional tavernas and the village square. It's a place to pause, unwind and embrace the gentler pace of island life.



Location & Local Information

Set within the gentle southern slopes of the Spartia peninsula, Villa Marmara enjoys a setting that feels distinctly Kefalonian, authentic, rustic, and surrounded by nature. Spartia itself is a quiet village, perched on a hillside that gradually descends to the sea, known for its relaxed pace, family-run tavernas, and traditional homes scattered among olive groves.

The villa is just a short drive from Spartia Beach, a shallow, sandy cove with calm waters ideal for swimming. The nearby coastline reveals a variety of beaches, some easily accessible, others hidden down winding tracks, perfect for those seeking seclusion. Boat rentals are available locally, offering the chance to explore remote coves or enjoy a day trip to the iconic Myrtos Beach further north.



In the village square, you'll find a minimarket, a couple of traditional tavernas serving fresh seafood and Kefalonian pies, and the warm hospitality for which the island is known. For wider amenities, Argostoli, the island's capital, is only a twenty-minute drive away.

The surrounding countryside is ideal for walkers, with olive groves, citrus orchards, and wildflower-lined paths. Mount Ainos National Park is within reach, offering forest trails and, occasionally, sightings of wild horses. Wine lovers can visit nearby vineyards to sample local Robola wines.

This southern region is also rich in history, with Venetian ruins, hillside chapels, and historic churches dotted throughout the landscape, a place where time slows, and nature leads.
