

Villa Cala Reale

Overview

Just a short stroll from one of Sardinia's most iconic beaches, Cala Reale enjoys beautiful sea views from its swimming pool and teak terraces. Here, contemporary ease meets coastal beauty in a villa that feels rooted in its surroundings. From the moment you arrive, the azure expanse of La Pelosa and the untamed sweep of Asinara National Park unfold before you - an ever-changing canvas of colour and light.

This is not a showpiece but a true owner's home, eclectically designed to blend comfort with authenticity. Inside, four inviting bedrooms (three en-suite, one with an adjacent private shower room) provide private spaces to unwind. The living area, with its parquet floors and arched sea-facing windows, overlooks an internal patio dotted with succulents, reflecting the home's gentle relationship with nature. A compact yet practical kitchenette complements the main indoor space, ideal for your morning coffee.

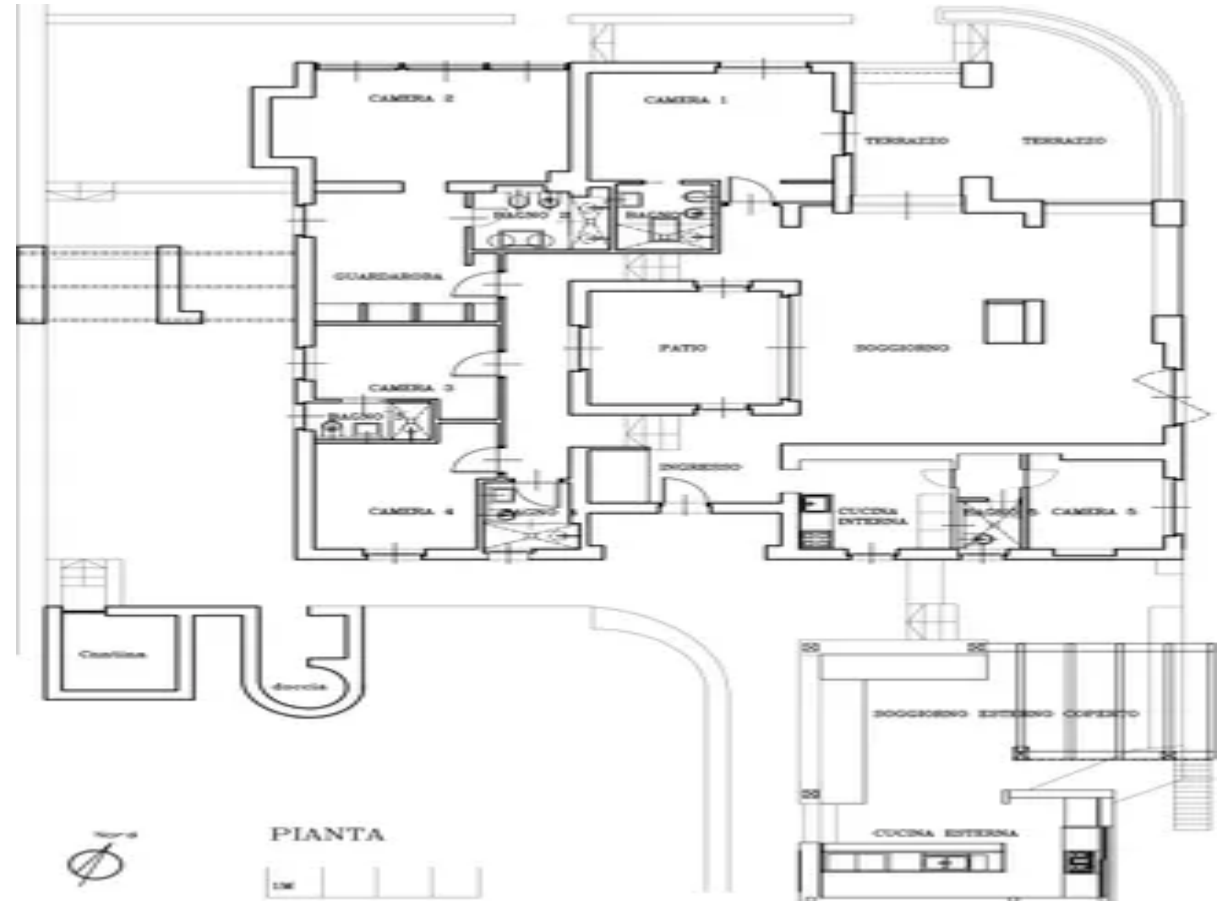
Step outside and the Mediterranean lifestyle unfurls in full. Teak terraces cradle reading corners, open-air lounges and a juniper-topped fully-equipped kitchen. A shaded dining area, swimming pool and sun terrace elevate simple moments into sensory pleasures. The garden, laced with fragrant native plants, feels like an oasis just steps from the shimmering coastline.

Only 250m from Spiaggia La Pelosa, this villa enjoys one of Sardinia's most sought-after locations (you'll need to reserve ahead to book your place on this incredible beach). A short drive away, the village of Stintino charms with its harbour, seafood trattorias and authentic coastal rhythm. From here, boat excursions cross to Asinara's untouched trails and wild coves - an adventurer's dream and a diver's paradise.

Villa Cala Reale offers a front-row seat to Sardinia's most iconic shoreline, showcasing simplicity and effortless elegance at once.

Location & Local Information

Perched in an extraordinary coastal setting, Villa Cala Reale boasts stunning views across the turquoise waters of La Pelosa Beach and the sweeping Gulf of Asinara. With just the coastal road separating the villa from the coast, this detached villa enjoys one of the most coveted locations in the region, with the powder-soft sands and crystalline waters of La Pelosa just 250m down the road.

Indeed, La Pelosa is one of the most beautiful beaches on Sardinia – visitors come from afar to visit in the summer months. Do note that a maximum number of visitors are permitted on the beach from mid-May to mid-October and access is by advance reservation only (please see the beach's official website for the most up to date information on how and when to reserve). There are many other idyllic spots along this coastline from Le Saline (9.5km) and Tonnare (8km) to the wild cliffs of Capo Falcone where some bays can only be accessed by boat.

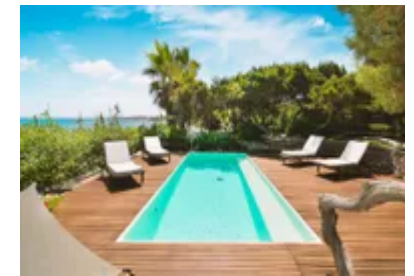
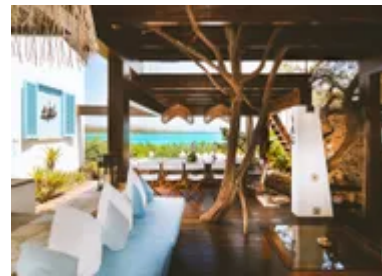
The nearby village of Stintino (3.5km) exudes traditional Sardinian charm, with its pretty harbour, inviting trattorias and relaxed atmosphere. Here, guests can explore local shops, sample fresh seafood or simply enjoy a gelato by the sea. Village specialities include octopus in garlic sauce, lobster and potato soup and spaghetti with urchins and sardines.

Culture seekers will appreciate the Tonnara delle Saline museum (8km), which offers fascinating insights into the area's maritime heritage and the historic tuna fishing traditions that shaped Stintino and the surrounding islands.

Nature lovers and explorers will be drawn to the wild beauty of Asinara National Park. Accessible by boat from Stintino, this unspoilt island offers hiking trails, wild donkey sightings and serene beaches, all set within a protected natural reserve that feels a world away from the everyday. Cala Grande is a haven for scuba diving and snorkelling, revealing vibrant underwater landscapes teeming with marine life. The clarity of the water and richness of the seabed make this one of Sardinia's most exciting spots for aquatic adventures.

- Just 250m away, La Pelosa is one of the most beautiful beaches on Sardinia - a maximum number of visitors are permitted on the beach from mid-May to mid-September and access is by advance reservation only with a small per person fee (usually max 4 guests per booking). Please see the beach's official website for the most up to date information on how and when to reserve.
- Opening dates/times of restaurants and lidos across this part of Sardinia can vary depending on the time of year with many only open in the high season.
- If staying with younger guests, please note that the garden's raised terrace, reached via a ladder-style staircase, is not suitable for children.
- The quiet and non-intrusive housekeeper lives on site, they will be very happy to help.
- Car hire is essential to be able to reach amenities and explore the area.

Terms & Conditions

- **Security deposit:** €2000 charged to client's credit card as a pre-authorisation at least 2 weeks prior to arrival and refunded two weeks after departure, subject to full inspection.
- **Arrival time:** 5.00 p.m. Check-in outside this time may be subject to an extra cost. Please enquire for more details.
