

Villa Batsi

Region: Andros Sleeps: 12

Overview

Positioned above the sea on Andros' south west coast, Villa Batsi enjoys a setting shaped by light, space and uninterrupted views. Sheltered from the island's northern winds, the villa feels calm and composed, with the Aegean stretching out ahead and the sound of the water never far away. Clean architectural lines and natural materials give the villa a quiet confidence, designed to let the landscape take centre stage.

Stepping inside, the heart of the villa reveals itself as a generous open-plan living space that brings together lounge, dining and kitchen areas. Floor to ceiling openings frame the sea beyond, drawing the outdoors into everyday life. The kitchen is fully equipped and designed for ease, whether preparing simple breakfasts or shared evening meals, while the dining area sits naturally beside it, positioned to make the most of the view. The living space is relaxed and uncluttered, ideal for gathering together throughout the day.

Accommodation is arranged to offer both comfort and privacy. Five bedroom suites sit within the main villa, each with its own ensuite bathroom and a calm, pared-back aesthetic. Two feature king-size beds, two have queen-size beds and one offers twin beds, making the layout flexible for families or groups. An independent master suite completes the accommodation, offering an added sense of seclusion with its own ensuite bathroom.

Outside, the villa opens onto a series of terraces designed for slow days under the sun. The 40 square metre infinity lap pool runs towards the horizon, its edge meeting the sea beyond. Sun loungers, shaded lounge areas and an outdoor shower encourage long hours spent outdoors, while the shaded dining space and barbecue kitchenette provide an easy setting for meals as the light softens. With private parking, laundry facilities and thoughtful spaces throughout, Villa Batsi offers a refined seaside retreat built around comfort, privacy and the view.

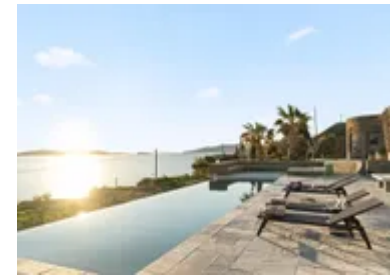
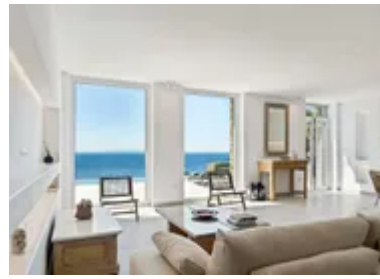

Location & Local Information

Villa Batsi is set on the south west coast of Andros, an area prized for its gentle climate and protection from the strong meltemi winds that can affect other parts of the island in summer. This privileged position allows guests to enjoy warm, calm days by the sea, making outdoor living a natural part of daily life.

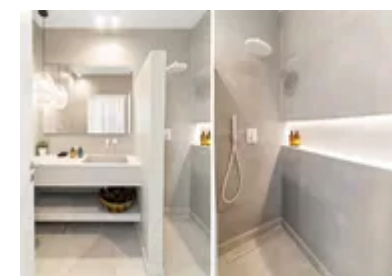
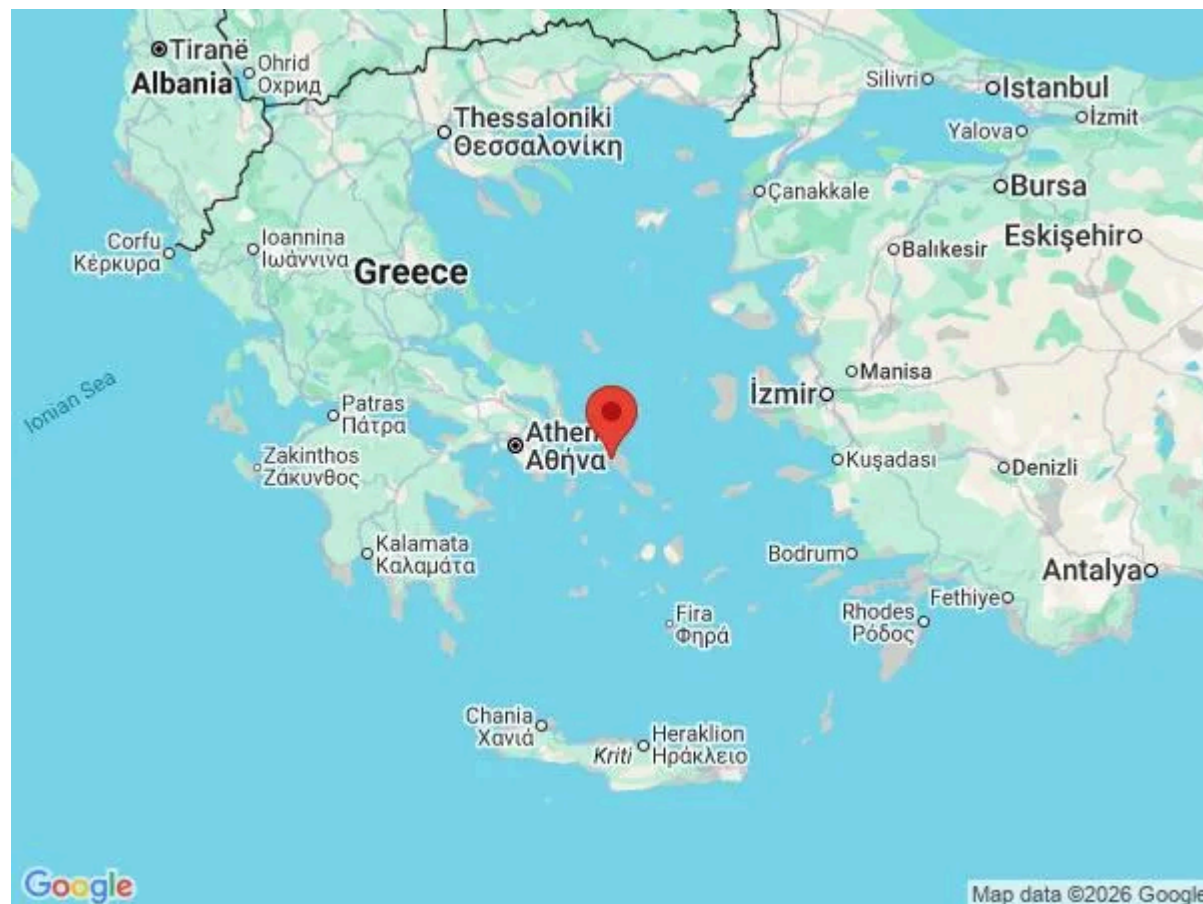
The nearby coastal area is characterised by clear waters, rocky inlets and inviting swimming spots, ideal for those who prefer a quieter seaside experience. Beaches along this stretch of coast tend to feel relaxed and unhurried, with a handful of traditional tavernas offering fresh seafood and local dishes close to the water's edge. A short journey brings you to Batsi village, one of Andros' most popular seaside towns. Here, a small harbour is lined with cafés, bakeries and restaurants, creating a lively yet approachable atmosphere. The beach at Batsi is well organised and family friendly, while evening strolls along the promenade offer a glimpse into the island's easygoing social life.

Andros is known for its distinctive character within the Cyclades, shaped by maritime history, neoclassical architecture and an unusually green landscape. Inland villages, stone bridges and historic monasteries reveal a deeper side of the island, while well-marked walking trails connect coast and countryside. These routes pass through terraced hillsides, freshwater springs and valleys, reflecting Andros' long agricultural tradition. Cultural highlights are never far away, with museums, galleries and historic mansions dotted across the island, particularly around Andros Chora. Villa Batsi's location offers a well-balanced base, combining peaceful seafront living with easy access to villages, beaches and the cultural heart of the island.

Reaching Andros is simple and part of the adventure, with all access exclusively via ferry adding to its authentic island charm. From Athens, ferries depart regularly from the port of Rafina and take between 1–2 hours, making it a convenient option for travellers arriving in the capital. For those island hopping and exploring other Cyclades islands, Andros is well connected, with ferry routes from Tinos taking around 1 to 1.5 hours and from Mykonos approximately 1.5 to 2.5 hours. If you're travelling in from further afield, the nearest airports are Athens and Mykonos, both of which offer easy onward ferry connections to the island.
