Overview

Behind a fragrant veil of jasmine and wisteria, Mas Lavandula invites you into a world of authentic Provençal charm and understated elegance. Set in the characterful village of Lagnes, this beautifully restored house offers a courtyard garden with swimming pool, graceful interiors and modern comforts for a truly memorable escape with family or friends.

Step through the gates and you'll find an idyllic haven beneath the dappled shade of a centuries-old plane tree. The courtyard unfolds into a series of inviting outdoor spaces, from the al fresco dining area to the shaded lounge and glistening 13-metre swimming pool (that can be heated for a supplement). Long afternoons stretch into golden evenings here, whether you're reclining on a sunbed, sharing a bottle of local rosé or preparing dinner on the barbecue and plancha.

Inside, the air-conditioned house flows effortlessly between tradition and comfort. Exposed stone, soft tones and artwork set a soothing backdrop for the spacious living-dining area and superbly equipped open-plan kitchen. A Lacanche range, American fridge-freezer, dual dishwashers and every thoughtful touch ensure you have all you need for relaxed entertaining. An upstairs lounge provides a quiet corner to retreat with a book or connect with loved ones. Meanwhile, each of the four double bedrooms offers a sense of calm, with queen or king-size beds and stylish en-suites.

Perfectly positioned in the village of Lagnes, a short stroll from the bakery and a couple of restaurants, Mas Lavandula places you within easy reach of Provence's most treasured destinations. The antiques town of L'Isle-sur-la-Sorgue is just minutes away, as are the dramatic springs of Fontaine-de-Vaucluse. Spend days wandering the hilltop villages of the Luberon such as Gordes, Ménerbes and beyond, or enjoy leisurely cycles through the region's iconic landscapes.

Whether spending slow mornings in the courtyard or setting out to explore Provence's historic beauty, Mas Lavandula offers an experience shaped by comfort, elegance and character.

Location & Local Information

In the characterful village of Lagnes, Mas Lavandula offers the perfect escape close to some of Provence's most wonderful villages and towns.

The house is located in the village centre, just a short stroll from a couple of restaurants and a simple bakery for fresh bread and morning croissants. For a broader selection, nearby Coustellet and L'Isle-sur-la-Sorgue offer well-stocked supermarkets, with Coustellet's Sunday morning food market a must for gourmet local produce.

For outdoor enthusiasts, adventure is never far. Just a 5-minute drive away, you can enjoy canoeing along the crystal-clear waters of the Sorgue River or spend the afternoon at Passerelles des Cîmes, a tree-top adventure park that's fun for young and old. A 5km drive takes you to Fontaine-de-Vaucluse, home to one of France's most powerful natural springs and scenic riverside cafés, also a popular area for hiking.

The picturesque town of L'Isle-sur-la-Sorgue (6.5km), often dubbed the "Venice of Provence," is renowned for its canals, antique shops, vibrant art scene and Sunday morning brocante. Spend a leisurely afternoon enjoying a riverside meal as the water wheels gently turn nearby.

Venture a little further to explore the postcard-perfect Luberon villages of Gordes and Ménerbes, both within a 20-minute drive. The surrounding landscape is a patchwork of cherry orchards, vineyards, woodland and lavender fields, ideal for walking, cycling or simply soaking up the region's beauty. For a dose of culture and history, a day trip to the Papal city of Avignon (29km) completes the experience.
