

# Le Domaine Galoustal

## Overview

Close to one of Provence's most sought-after villages, Le Domaine Galoustal is a beautiful south-facing house with glorious views of its one-hectare garden and distant hills of Les Alpilles.

Lovingly restored with immense care and style, this elegant stone *mas* combines the authenticity of its heritage with the comfort and polish of modern living. The house bathes in light and its garden terraces offering idyllic corners for leisurely breakfasts, long lunches or evenings under the stars.

Inside, 350 square metres of thoughtfully designed space awaits. The grand salon, with its vast fireplace and high ceilings, exudes sumptuous style, while the traditional kitchen is a true cook's delight with professional appliances and direct access to the garden. Seven bedrooms, including two master doubles, are spread over two floors, most with ensuite bathrooms and dressed in fine linens. Upstairs, a cosy TV and chill-out lounge offers the perfect escape for a quiet read or film night.

Outdoors, the experience is just as enticing. Set within one hectare of olive-planted land, the estate offers three terraces, a pétanque court and a glorious 15-metre swimming pool (that can be heated for a supplement). The adjacent pool house is more than just a shaded spot; it is a social hub, with a summer kitchen, bar, dining space and a lounge area to savour Provençal afternoons at their unhurried best.

Le Domaine Galoustal lies just 2.5km from the heart of Eygalières, one of the region's most coveted villages. Wander its cobbled lanes and discover café terraces, acclaimed restaurants and its renowned weekly market bursting with seasonal produce and artisanal delights. For a Michelin-starred dining experience, Maison Haché is just moments away.

Nearby Saint-Rémy-de-Provence offers further cultural pleasures with its leafy squares, galleries and Roman ruins. From here, the landscapes that once inspired Van Gogh continue to captivate.

Whether gathering with family or reconnecting with friends, Le Domaine Galoustal offers a wonderful blend of space, style and Provençal beauty.



# Location & Local Information

In the Bouches-du-Rhône countryside of Provence, Le Domaine Galoustal offers a great location just a short drive from the picture-perfect village of Eygalières, just over half an hour south of Avignon.

This is a typically rural setting surrounded by farmland and country lanes with close access to roads linking you to Saint-Rémy-de-Provence, Orgon and Cavaillon where you will find a range of good-sized supermarkets and other amenities.

Meanwhile, the local village of Eygalières (2.5km) is one of the most sought-after in the region, known for its pretty stone houses, cobbled lanes and chic yet understated atmosphere. Its weekly market is a delight for gourmands, brimming with local produce, artisan cheeses and wines, and there is a good choice of restaurants in the village including the Michelin starred Maison Haché.

You are also well located for spending time in Saint-Rémy-de-Provence (10km), a characterful town that inspired Van Gogh and still enchants visitors today with its leafy boulevards, boutique shops, galleries and markets.

Nature lovers will be captivated by the landscapes of Les Alpilles, ideal for hiking, cycling or simply scenic drives through olive groves, forest and limestone hills. Traditional villages like Maussane-les-Alpilles (18km) and Les Baux-de-Provence (19km) offer medieval charm and beautiful scenery.

For another full-day adventure, drive around 45 minutes east to the Luberon region, where iconic perched villages such as Gordes and Ménerbes showcase the region's natural beauty and artistic heritage.

Avignon (29km), with its Papal Palace and festival spirit, offers a rich cultural outing, while the antique markets and waterways of L'Isle-sur-la-Sorgue (25km) are a treasure trove for vintage lovers. For those willing to explore further, Aix-en-Provence is just over an hour's drive - a vibrant university city filled with fountains, elegant squares and Cézanne's legacy.
