

Domaine Lazarus

Region: Aquitaine Sleeps: 17

Overview

North of Bordeaux, Domaine Lazarus rises from three hectares of private grounds as a historic sanctuary in the heart of the Médoc. With its classical 19th-century form reimagined in modern tones, this elegant residence unfolds across three levels, offering a refined setting for family gatherings, wine holidays with friends or atmospheric French weddings.

Hosting up to 17 guests, spacious living areas create room to gather and unwind. Two separate lounges invite both quiet conversation and movie nights, one equipped with a Smart TV and Sonos soundbar. The open-plan kitchen, centred around a large island, is designed for convivial cooking, flowing into a generous dining space that opens to the outdoors. Eight double en suite bedrooms, one with an extra single bed, ensure every guest enjoys both comfort and privacy, while a hammam on the lower ground floor adds a tranquil spa-like dimension.

Outside, the estate offers space and seclusion, with an 18-metre swimming pool, children's play area (with zipline!) and wonderful terraces made for long lunches and afternoons in the sun. North-facing at the entrance and south-facing at the estuary, the *domaine* is bathed in natural light and framed by wide, open views.

Domaine Lazarus is perfectly placed for exploring the famed wine country of Margaux, just a 10-minute drive away. Neighbouring Grand Cru Classé estates such as Château Giscours, Château Ferrière and Château Kirwan offer immersive tasting experiences, vineyard strolls or even cycling tours through the vines. The region's seasonal events and festivals, quiet villages and scenic estuary crossings add further colour to your stay.

Tailor-made activities can be arranged to elevate the experience: craft your own blend in a private wine workshop, take to the skies in a hot air balloon or enjoy a gourmet picnic among the vines. For unforgettable moments, a professional photo shoot can be arranged to capture the magic.

Whether celebrating a special occasion or retreating in refined seclusion, Domaine Lazarus offers a stay that is deeply rooted in the pleasures of southwest France.

Location & Local Information

Set on the banks of the Gironde estuary, Domaine Lazarus is a captivating escape in a fine location for visiting the prestigious vineyards and beautiful landscapes of the Médoc. Just 5km from the village of Margaux, this private estate sits at the gateway to world-renowned Grand Cru Classé châteaux and the rolling vine-laced countryside of southwest France. With its refined setting and proximity to Bordeaux's famed terroirs, it's an exceptional base for wine lovers and culture seekers alike.

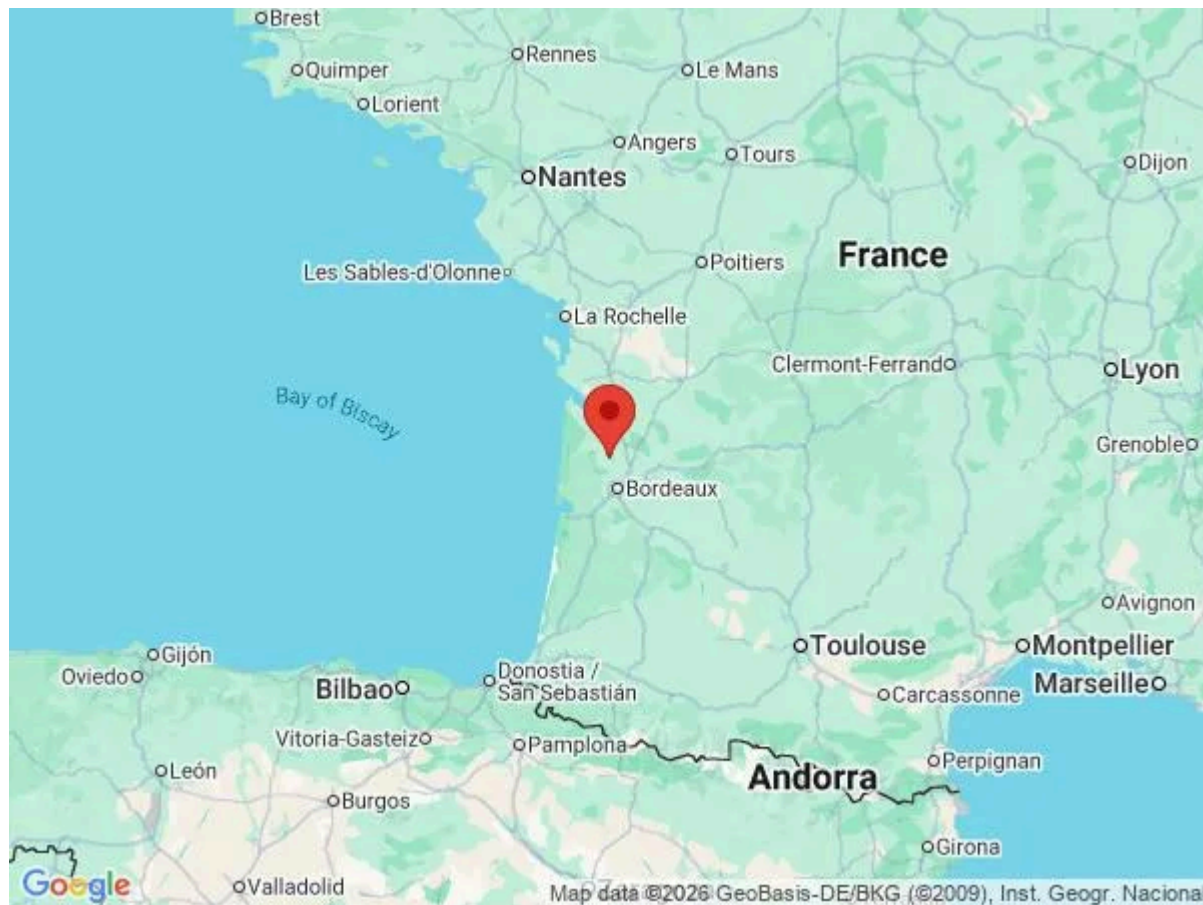
In terms of practicalities, there is a small grocery shop in the local village just a 5-minute drive away, a bakery (closed Mondays) just a little further in Margaux and a good sized supermarket in less than 10 minutes by car. Meanwhile, a variety of restaurants from local bistros to high-end establishments can be found across nearby villages, wineries and towns.

From Margaux, visitors can explore celebrated wineries such as Château Ferrière and Château Giscours or enjoy a round of golf at Golf de Margaux (3.5km), also home to a celebrated restaurant. The nearby Port de Macau (10km) and the charming wine village of Bages (20km) offer an authentic taste of local life, while the vibrant riverside town of Pauillac (31km) reveals the deeper soul of the Médoc, framed by fishing huts, marina views and countless wine estates.

You could time your stay with one of the region's iconic events, from En Primeur tastings (April) and joyful open-cellar festivals throughout summer to the lively Marathon du Médoc (September).

For a change of pace, take the scenic ferry from Lamarque to the historic Citadel of Blaye (16km), a Vauban masterpiece overlooking the estuary. Alternatively, head west and spend a day by the water at Lac d'Hourtin-Carcans (45km) and Étang de Lacanau (50km). These pine-fringed lakes and nearby Atlantic beaches are perfect for sailing, surfing or cycling through the vast forest and sand dune landscapes.

Domaine Lazarus also places you within easy reach of Bordeaux (32km), a city of grand architecture, gourmet dining and immersive wine experiences such as La Cité du Vin.
