

Villa Benedetta

Region: Sicily **Sleeps:** 6

Overview

A short stroll from the soft sands of Santa Maria del Focallo, Villa Benedetta rises with clean architectural lines and uninterrupted views across the Mediterranean. The first impression is one of light and openness. Sunlight glides across pale stone terraces, the scent of sea air drifting through carefully framed outdoor spaces that feel designed for long, unhurried days.

Stepping inside, the ground floor unfolds as a bright, contemporary living space where floor to ceiling glass draws the outside in. The lounge is calm and understated, arranged for relaxed evenings after the beach, while the glass walled kitchen adds a sculptural edge, fully equipped for everything from simple breakfasts to elaborate Sicilian feasts. A sleek bathroom on this level adds everyday practicality without interrupting the flow of the space.

Upstairs, three elegant double bedrooms offer privacy and comfort in equal measure, each with its own ensuite bathroom. The master bedroom opens onto a generous veranda where a heated outdoor hot tub sits alongside a shaded seating area. It is an inviting spot for early morning coffee or a final glass of wine as the horizon softens at dusk. The remaining bedrooms enjoy private balconies, all facing the sea, ensuring every morning begins with open skies and salt air.

Below, the villa reveals a private gym and a fully equipped laundry room, thoughtful additions that allow longer stays to feel effortless. Outdoors, the garden wraps around the villa with clipped greenery and generous terraces. The saltwater swimming pool stretches out invitingly, bordered by sun loungers and umbrellas, while a covered poolside area with a bar, barbecue and additional bathroom creates a natural hub for outdoor dining and evening gatherings.

Perfectly placed for both relaxation and discovery, Villa Benedetta offers a refined base from which to experience Sicily's southeastern coast, where beach days, cultural excursions and slow evenings blend seamlessly together.

Location & Local Information

Villa Benedetta sits within Santa Maria del Focallo, a laid back stretch of coastline known for its long sandy beaches, clear waters and relaxed rhythm of life. The beach lies just a few minutes away on foot, making it easy to slip into a daily routine of morning swims, barefoot walks along the shore and afternoons spent under the Sicilian sun.

The surrounding area retains an authentic feel, with small cafés, local bakeries and seasonal lidos scattered along the coast. Nearby Pozzallo offers a livelier atmosphere with restaurants, gelaterias and a working port, while Ispica provides a more traditional Sicilian town experience, where historic streets, markets and local eateries reveal everyday life away from the shoreline.

This corner of Sicily is celebrated for its Baroque heritage, and Villa Benedetta is well placed for exploring some of the island's most striking historic towns. Modica, Ragusa Ibla and Scicli showcase dramatic architecture carved into hillsides, while Noto is renowned for its harmonious streets and golden stone buildings. Each destination offers a blend of culture, cuisine and craftsmanship that defines the region.

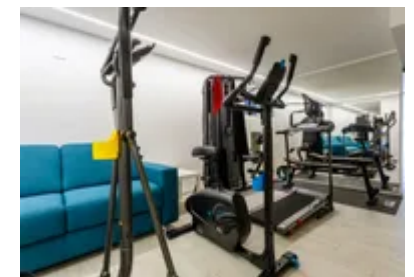
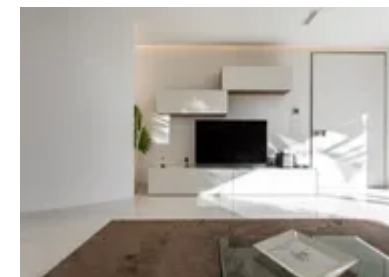
The coastline itself varies from sandy bays to rocky coves, with Punta Cirica and San Lorenzo offering different beach experiences within easy reach. Further afield, Marzamemi's old tuna fishery and harbourfront restaurants provide a charming setting for an evening out, while Portopalo di Capo Passero marks Sicily's southernmost point, where two seas meet.

Food lovers will appreciate the surrounding countryside, known for its tomatoes, almonds and wines, while day trips to Siracusa, Catania or even Taormina allow for deeper exploration of the island's layered history. Well connected yet pleasantly unhurried, the location offers a balanced mix of coastal ease and cultural richness.
