

Villa Salistra

Region: Sardinia **Sleeps:** 8

Overview

Set within a quiet residential enclave in Castiadas, Villa Salistra is a refined coastal retreat just 500 metres from the sea, where Sardinian tradition is expressed through light-filled interiors, tactile materials and carefully chosen details. Approached via a private entrance, the villa immediately feels calm and well considered, framed by a neatly kept garden that draws the outdoors into everyday living.

The villa is arranged over two levels, beginning on the ground floor where shared spaces unfold with ease. The living room is warm and welcoming, anchored by a fireplace that adds atmosphere during cooler evenings and complemented by a double sofa bed for flexible sleeping arrangements. Nearby, the dining area flows naturally into the fully equipped kitchen, designed for both practicality and sociable cooking. This level also includes a shower room, a laundry space and a useful storage cavity, keeping the house uncluttered and comfortable for longer stays.

Upstairs, the sleeping area offers three bedrooms arranged for families and small groups. The principal double bedroom enjoys its own en-suite shower room, while a second double bedroom and a single room share a further shower room. The single room can be adapted into a double with a pull-out bed, adding versatility. Each bedroom has a window or small balcony overlooking the private garden, with soft sea views appearing on the horizon through the greenery.

Outside, the villa is surrounded by a carefully maintained garden where a swimming pool provides a soothing focal point. A small solarium with sun loungers and parasol sits nearby, along with an outdoor hot-water shower and a barbecue area. The large covered portico extends the living space outdoors, furnished with a dining table and lounge seating for long meals and relaxed evenings. Thoughtful touches, from mosquito nets to coordinated fabrics, complete a home that feels cohesive, comfortable and deeply connected to its setting.

Location & Local Information

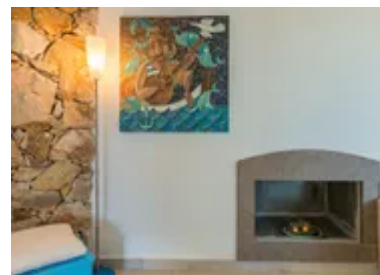
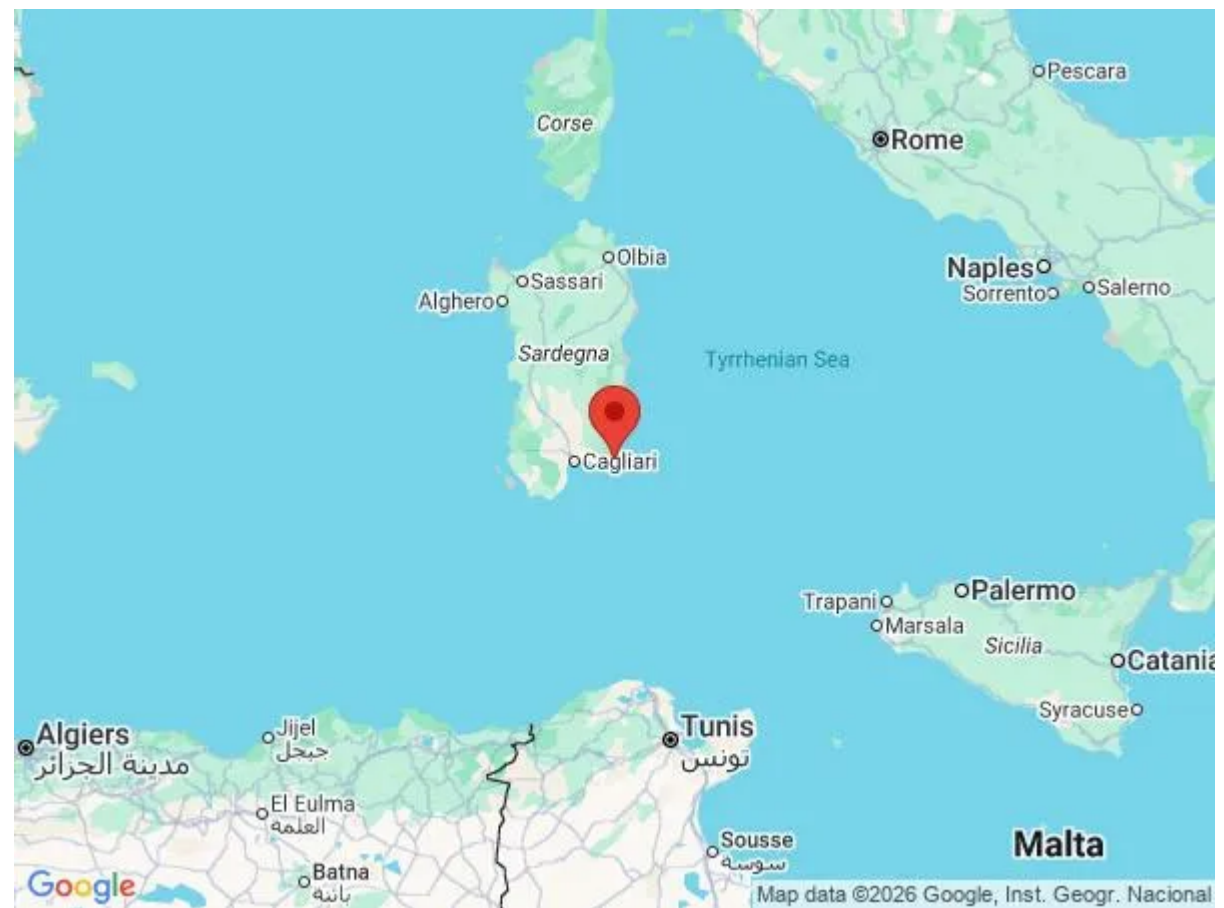
Villa Salistra is located in Castiadas, a gently developed area on Sardinia's south-eastern coast prized for its clear waters, open landscapes and relaxed atmosphere. This part of the island offers a quieter alternative to more crowded destinations, where beaches remain open and natural, framed by Mediterranean vegetation and low rolling hills.

Just a short walk from the villa, the coastline invites spontaneous swims and leisurely strolls by the sea. Beaches in this area are known for their pale sand, shallow waters and excellent swimming conditions, making them appealing for all ages. The surrounding sea benefits from protection within the wider Capo Carbonara Marine Area, helping preserve water clarity and marine life.

Castiadas itself has a strong rural heritage, once shaped by farming communities and agricultural estates. This history still influences the landscape today, lending the area an authentic feel that sits comfortably alongside its modern villas. Nearby villages provide everyday amenities, including food shops, bakeries and local restaurants where Sardinian cooking takes centre stage.

A little further afield, the coastline reveals a succession of beaches, each with its own character, while inland routes lead through countryside dotted with olive trees and Mediterranean scrub. Whether exploring by foot, enjoying the sea or sampling local flavours, the area encourages a slower pace that suits relaxed coastal living.

Villa Salistra's location offers a balance of privacy, proximity to the sea and easy access to the highlights of south-east Sardinia, making it a rewarding base for both short breaks and longer stays.

- **Security deposit:** €1500 charged to client's credit card by the owner upon arrival and refunded two weeks after departure, subject to full inspection.
