

Villa Kamarina

Overview

Set in the peaceful countryside of southeastern Sicily, Villa Kamarina offers a relaxed retreat within easy reach of the coast and the region's celebrated baroque towns. Surrounded by open landscapes and Mediterranean greenery, this welcoming villa blends traditional character with modern comforts, making it well suited to families or groups of friends seeking space, privacy, and a slower pace of life.

The villa accommodates up to eight guests across four comfortable bedrooms. The main house features three double bedrooms, each with its own ensuite bathroom, alongside a bright living room with fireplace and Smart TV, creating a cosy space to unwind after a day exploring the island. A fully equipped kitchen opens directly onto a shaded pergola, allowing meals to flow easily between indoor and outdoor living. Just beside the main house, a separate annex provides an additional double bedroom with its own bathroom, offering extra privacy for guests who may prefer a little independence.

Outside, the generous garden creates a tranquil setting for long days under the Sicilian sun. At its heart is a panoramic swimming pool surrounded by a solarium terrace and loungers, perfect for cooling off while enjoying views across the surrounding countryside. There is also a shaded outdoor lounge area with bar counter, as well as a barbecue and traditional stone oven for relaxed alfresco dining.

Villa Kamarina enjoys a peaceful yet convenient position between Ragusa and Marina di Ragusa, placing sandy beaches, lively seaside restaurants, and the region's UNESCO-listed baroque towns all within easy driving distance.

Location & Local Information

Villa Kamarina enjoys a peaceful setting in the countryside of southeastern Sicily, ideally positioned between the historic town of Ragusa and the lively seaside resort of Marina di Ragusa. This area of the island is known for its warm climate, traditional farming landscapes and remarkable baroque architecture, with several UNESCO World Heritage towns scattered across the region.

Just a short drive away, Marina di Ragusa offers long sandy beaches and a vibrant promenade lined with cafés, gelaterias and seafood restaurants. During the summer months the marina comes alive with evening markets, beach clubs and waterfront dining, making it a popular gathering spot for both locals and visitors. The beaches here are among the most loved in southern Sicily thanks to their soft sand and clear, shallow waters.

Inland, the historic centres of Ragusa Ibla, Modica and Scicli showcase the region's distinctive Sicilian baroque style, with honey-coloured stone buildings, grand churches and winding cobbled streets. These towns are wonderful places to spend an afternoon exploring artisan shops, sampling local chocolate or enjoying a leisurely Sicilian lunch in a traditional trattoria.

For those wishing to explore further, the Vendicari Nature Reserve and the coastal villages of the Val di Noto offer beautiful scenery, nature trails and quiet beaches. Whether you are seeking cultural discoveries, coastal relaxation or authentic Sicilian cuisine, Villa Kamarina places you within easy reach of the very best of this captivating corner of the island.
