Villa Mulinello is a characterful Sicilian retreat set within peaceful countryside just outside Modica, where traditional architecture and modern comforts come together in a relaxed, welcoming setting. Thoughtfully restored, the villa retains its authentic charm with stone walls, warm textures and simple, elegant interiors that feel both homely and refined. The living spaces are bright and sociable, designed for easy holiday living, while the bedrooms offer a calm and comfortable place to unwind after a day exploring the island.

Outside, the villa truly comes into its own. Surrounded by open views of the rolling landscape, the generous terrace invites long, leisurely days in the sun. A private heated swimming pool takes centre stage, ideal for cooling off in the warmer months or enjoying quieter swims in the shoulder seasons. There is ample space for outdoor dining, whether it is a laid-back lunch or an evening meal as the sun sets over the countryside.

Villa Mulinello offers a sense of seclusion while still being within easy reach of Modica's historic centre, known for its baroque architecture and renowned chocolate-making tradition. It is a wonderful base for discovering the rich culture, flavours and coastline of southern Sicily.

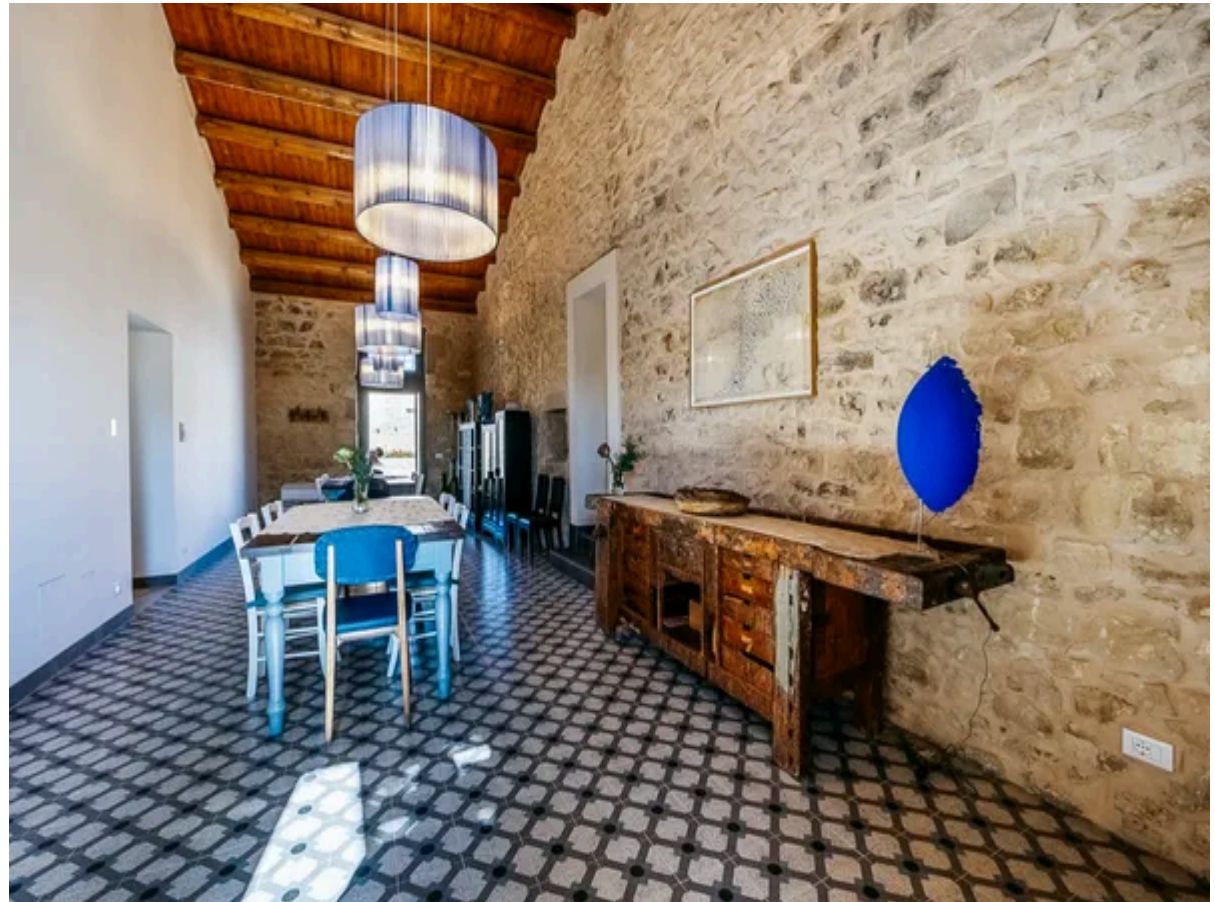

Location & Local Information

Villa Mulinello is set in the rolling countryside just outside Modica, in the south-east of Sicily, an area celebrated for its baroque towns, rich culinary heritage and easy access to the coast. The villa enjoys a peaceful rural setting, offering a sense of escape while remaining close to local amenities and cultural highlights.

Modica itself is a short drive away and is renowned for its striking architecture and historic centre, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The town is also famous for its traditional chocolate, with artisan shops and cafés lining its atmospheric streets. Nearby, the towns of Ragusa and Scicli offer further opportunities to explore Sicily's baroque beauty, with elegant piazzas, churches and restaurants showcasing the region's flavours.

For days by the sea, the southern coastline can be reached within a short drive, where sandy beaches and clear waters provide a relaxed contrast to the countryside setting. Guests can also enjoy local trattorias, wineries and markets scattered throughout the area, making Villa Mulinello an excellent base for experiencing the authentic charm of south-eastern Sicily.

What you should know...

- As the villa is spread across a main house and three separate annexes, this may not suit groups wanting all bedrooms under one roof or families with younger children
- The mezzanine sleeping areas in the annexes may be better suited to children or agile adults
- the outdoor areas are spacious and open, so younger children should be supervised. Additionally, the courtyard retains its original stone paving, which is uneven in places and may require care underfoot
- The style blends traditional and modern elements rather than being fully contemporary
- A car is recommended to fully explore the surrounding towns, beaches and countryside

- **Security deposit:** €1500 charged to client's credit card as a pre-authorisation at least 2 weeks prior to arrival and refunded two weeks after departure, subject to full inspection.
- **Arrival time:** 4.00 p.m – 8.00 p.m. Check-in outside this time may be subject to an extra cost. Please enquire for more details.
- **Departure time:** 10.00 a.m.
- **Energy costs included?:** Energy usage is included up to 250kWh, anything over this is charged at €0,40/kWh.
- **Linen & towels included?:** Yes.
- **Pets welcome?:** On request only and with prior agreement with the owner. If accepted, a pet supplement of €50 per pet will apply (payable locally).

- **Changeover day:** Flexible.
- **End of stay cleaning:** Not included. An extra €500, payable to Oliver's Travels at the time of balance payment. This is for a standard changeover clean and 2 hours daily cleaning. Guests are required to leave the accommodation clean, tidy and in the same condition as on their arrival. Any extra cleaning, laundry, maintenance and/or rubbish disposal required will be charged against the security deposit.
- **Smoking Allowed?:** Not allowed.
- **Minimum stay:** 3-nights in September to June, 4-nights in July to August.
- **Pool heating charge?:** Pool heating is available at the property. It is subject to 500€ for the first 5-days of your holiday, and then a further 80€ per day from the 6th day onwards.
