

Villa Asena

Overview

Villa Asena is a detached villa located within the Azure Heights development, positioned above Kalkan and Kalamar Bays. The property benefits from elevated views extending towards Mouse and Snake Islands, as well as a private infinity-edged swimming pool.

The ground floor features an open-plan kitchen, living and dining area with direct access to the pool terrace. The kitchen is well-equipped with a large fridge-freezer, oven, hob with an extractor fan, and microwave. It also includes Corian work surfaces and an island unit. A dining table seating six guests is provided.

The living area offers ample seating, a flat-screen satellite TV and a DVD player. This level also includes a guest cloakroom/WC and a utility area with a washing machine, iron and ironing board.

There are two bedrooms on this level. The first is a double bedroom with an en-suite shower room and access to a wrap-around balcony. The second is a twin bedroom, also with an en-suite shower room and access to the same wrap-around balcony.

The top floor features the master bedroom suite, which includes a double bed, an en-suite shower room, and access to a private roof terrace. The roof terrace features a Jacuzzi and offers extended views across the surrounding area.

The villa has a private infinity-edged swimming pool measuring approximately 5 metres by 10 metres, with a depth of around 1.80 metres. The pool terrace is spacious and furnished with a dining table, six sun loungers and a shaded seating area. From here, there are views across both Kalkan and Kalamar Bays, with Mouse and Snake Islands visible in the distance.

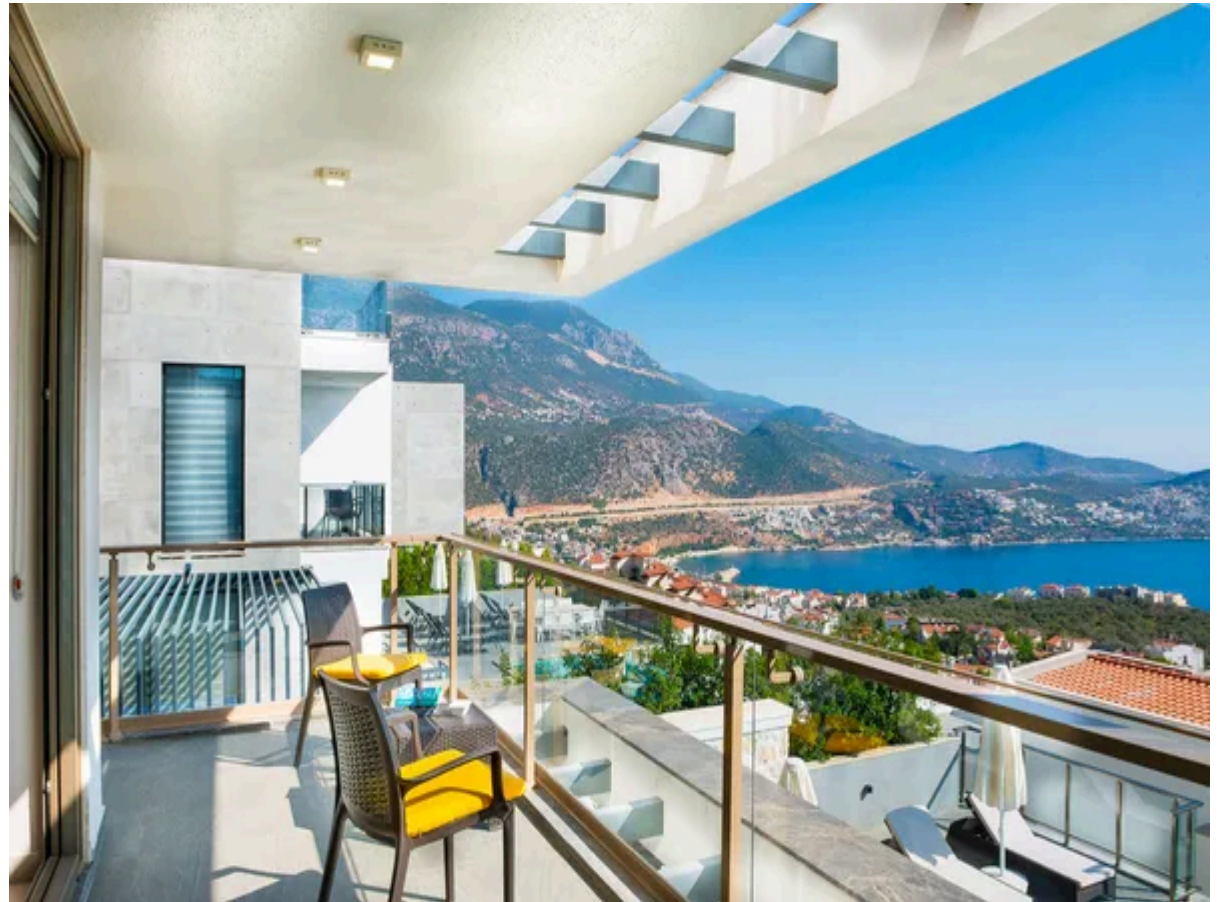

Location & Local Information

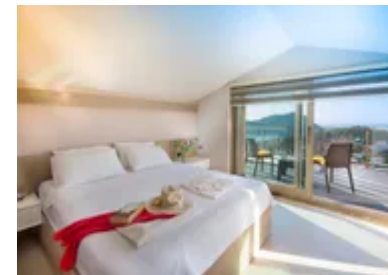
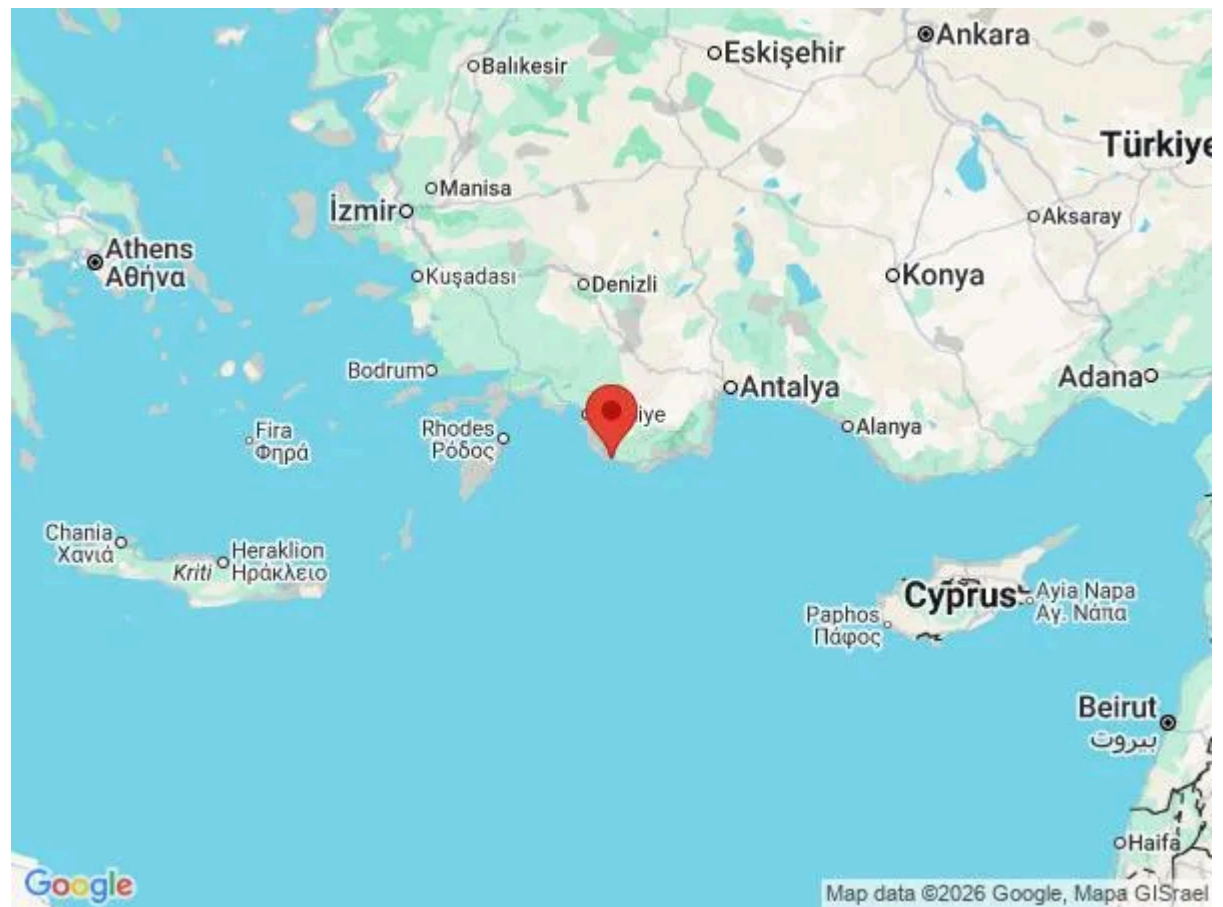
Kalkan is a picturesque harbour town on Turkey's southwest Mediterranean coast, set between the Taurus Mountains and the turquoise waters of the Lycian Sea. Once a quiet fishing village, it has evolved into an elegant yet relaxed destination known for its whitewashed houses, bougainvillea-draped balconies, and atmospheric old town streets. Despite its growth in popularity, Kalkan has retained a boutique feel, with low-rise buildings cascading down the hillside toward the sea and strict planning regulations preserving its charm.

The old town is the heart of Kalkan, a maze of narrow cobbled lanes filled with independent boutiques, artisan shops, and an impressive array of rooftop restaurants. Dining is a highlight here; many restaurants are family-run and serve freshly prepared Turkish meze, grilled seafood, and regional specialities under the stars. The small marina and harbour area provide a scenic focal point, where traditional gulets and day boats depart for leisurely cruises along the coast.

Kalkan is particularly celebrated for its beach clubs and access to some of Turkey's most beautiful beaches. While the town itself has a small pebble beach, the famous Kaputaş Beach, with its dramatic gorge setting and vivid blue waters, is just a short drive away. Patara Beach, one of the longest sandy beaches in the Mediterranean and part of a protected national park, offers a wild and unspoilt alternative. The surrounding region is rich in history, with ancient Lycian ruins, including Xanthos, Letoon, and Tlios, scattered throughout the landscape.

- The elevated position may not suit those with mobility difficulties.
- Although detached, the villa is located within a development rather than being completely standalone in a rural setting.

Travelling to Turkey

All British (and most other nationalities) citizens require a full 10 year passport with at least 6 months validity to enter Turkey. UK passport holders are exempt from visa for tourist visits of up to 90 days within 180 days starting from the first entry date. For all other passports please visit the Turkish Government Website or the Turkish Consulate for details of whether you require a visa or not.

Whilst in Turkey local regulations require you keep your passport and a printed copy of your e-visa with you at all times.
