

Komurluk Sea

Overview

Komurluk Sea is a contemporary four-bedroom villa in Kalkan's sought-after K m rl k district, just moments from the sea and within easy reach of the old town and beach clubs. Framed by panoramic bay and mountain views, the villa combines clean architectural lines with calm, minimalist interiors, creating a stylish base for families or friends.

The ground floor hosts a bright open-plan living, dining and kitchen space beneath a striking double-height ceiling. Floor-to-ceiling glass draws in natural light and showcases uninterrupted sea views, while a soft, neutral palette enhances the sense of space. The kitchen is fully equipped with modern appliances and a generous dining table for shared meals. Also on this level is a flexible twin bedroom with an en-suite shower room, which can be arranged as a double and overlooks the terrace.

The first floor is devoted to a spacious master suite of approximately forty square metres, complete with a king-size bed, en-suite shower room, dressing room and private balcony. A freestanding Jacuzzi bath is positioned to enjoy sweeping coastal views. The top floor offers two further en-suite bedrooms, both with dressing areas and access to a full-width roof terrace overlooking Kalkan's harbour.

Outdoors, a nine metre infinity pool is surrounded by wraparound terraces, alfresco dining, a built-in barbecue and ample space for relaxed days in the sun.

Location & Local Information

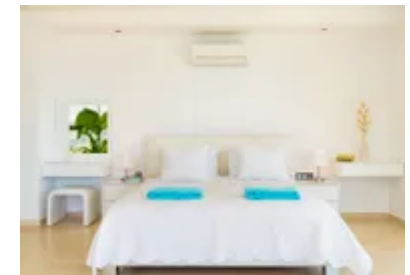
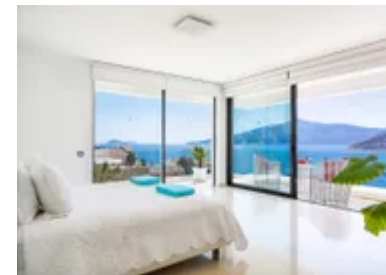
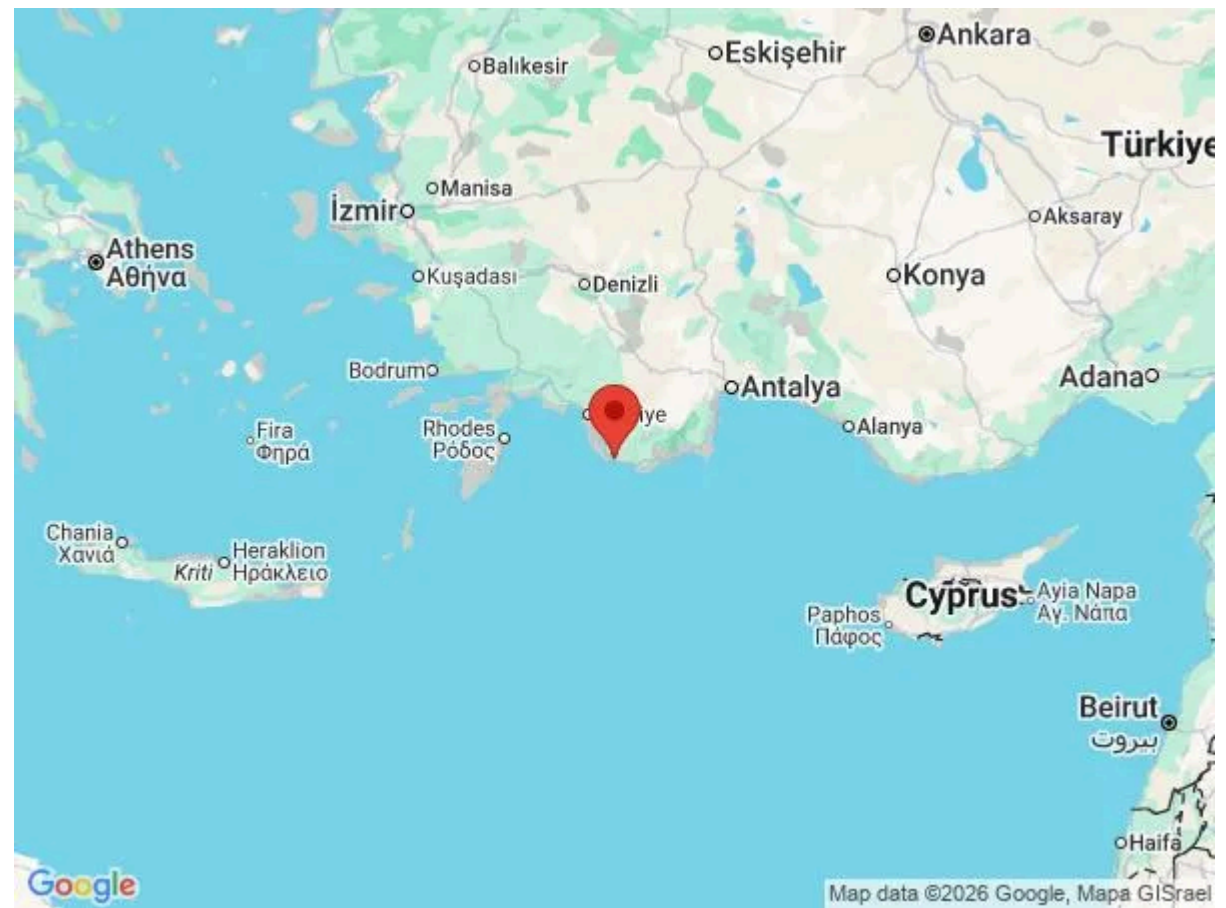
Kalkan is a picturesque harbour town on Turkey's southwest Mediterranean coast, set between the Taurus Mountains and the turquoise waters of the Lycian Sea. Once a quiet fishing village, it has evolved into an elegant yet relaxed destination known for its whitewashed houses, bougainvillea-draped balconies, and atmospheric old town streets. Despite its growth in popularity, Kalkan has retained a boutique feel, with low-rise buildings cascading down the hillside toward the sea and strict planning regulations preserving its charm.

The old town is the heart of Kalkan, a maze of narrow cobbled lanes filled with independent boutiques, artisan shops, and an impressive array of rooftop restaurants. Dining is a highlight here; many restaurants are family-run and serve freshly prepared Turkish meze, grilled seafood, and regional specialities under the stars. The small marina and harbour area provide a scenic focal point, where traditional gulets and day boats depart for leisurely cruises along the coast.

Kalkan is particularly celebrated for its beach clubs and access to some of Turkey's most beautiful beaches. While the town itself has a small pebble beach, the famous Kaputaş Beach, with its dramatic gorge setting and vivid blue waters, is just a short drive away. Patara Beach, one of the longest sandy beaches in the Mediterranean and part of a protected national park, offers a wild and unspoilt alternative. The surrounding region is rich in history, with ancient Lycian ruins, including Xanthos, Letoon, and Tlos, scattered throughout the landscape.

- The Palm Beach Club is located just below the villa, approximately a two-minute walk away, offering convenient access to waterfront dining, swimming and water sports.
- The centre of Kalkan can be reached via a scenic coastal path in around 10–12 minutes, combining a sense of seclusion with easy access to local amenities.

What you should know...

- Kömürlük is elevated and charming, however, like much of Kalkan, there may be hills/steps when walking to and from town or beach clubs.
- The swimming pool is unfenced so children should be supervised at all times

Terms & Conditions

- **Security deposit:** £250 charged to client's credit card by the owner before/upon arrival and refunded two weeks after departure, subject to full inspection.
- **Arrival time:** 16.00
- **Departure time:** 10.00
- **Energy costs included?:** Yes, included in rental price
- **Linen & towels included?:** Yes, included in rental price
- **Pets welcome?:** Not allowed
- **Other Ts and Cs:** Please note that on occasions, in Turkey, extremes in weather can cause water and/ or electric supply to be cut or reduced. Services are normally restored as soon as possible.

- **End of stay cleaning available?:** Yes. However, guests are required to leave the accommodation clean, tidy and in the same condition as on their arrival.
- **Smoking Allowed?:** Not permitted
- **Other 2:** In Turkey the plumbing system is not designed to have paper and sanitary items flushed down the lavatory. In these cases a bathroom bin is provided.
- **Minimum stay:** 7 nights
- **Pool heating charge?:** For those who require pool heating, there will be an additional charge of £270 (to be paid locally on arrival). Please note that like all heated pools, pool heating and water temperature are reliant on weather and outside temperatures.
- **Internet access?:** The property has complimentary Wifi connection. It is good to note that the speed is dependent on local provider and technical issues may cause reduced speed or cut of service.

Travelling to Turkey

All British (and most other nationalities) citizens require a full 10 year passport with at least 6 months validity to enter Turkey. UK passport holders are exempt from visa for tourist visits of up to 90 days within 180 days starting from the first entry date. For all other passports please visit the Turkish Government Website or the Turkish Consulate for details of whether you require a visa or not.

Whilst in Turkey local regulations require you keep your passport and a printed copy of your e-visa with you at all times.
