

Komurluk Blue

Region: Turkey Sleeps: 8

Overview

Located in Kalkan's sought-after Kömürlük district, Komurluk Blue is a contemporary four-bedroom villa with uninterrupted views across Kalkan Bay. Set over three floors and designed with clean architectural lines and expansive glazing, the property accommodates up to eight guests, offering a well-balanced layout ideal for families or friends travelling together.

The ground floor centres around an open-plan living, dining and kitchen area, enhanced by a striking double-height ceiling and floor-to-ceiling sliding doors opening onto the pool terrace. Neutral interiors create a calm, light-filled setting. The kitchen is fully equipped for self-catering, while the dining area and comfortable lounge both enjoy sea views. A twin bedroom with en-suite shower room (convertible to a double) is also located on this level, with easy access to the terrace.

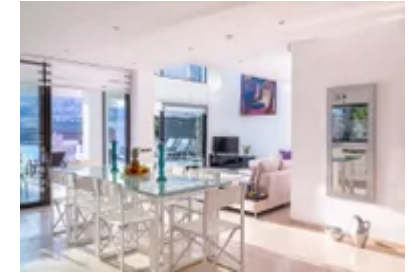
The first floor is dedicated to a spacious master suite of approximately forty square metres, complete with a king-size bed, freestanding Jacuzzi bath positioned for the views, en-suite shower room, dressing room and private balcony.

On the top floor, two further en-suite bedrooms, one king-size and one flexible double/twin, open onto a full-width roof terrace with elevated sea and mountain views.

The villa's private infinity pool (8.90m x 3.20m, depth 1.65m) is positioned to maximise the sea views and is surrounded by sun terraces on three sides. There are ample loungers for sunbathing, shaded seating areas and a pergola-covered dining space for al fresco meals. A built-in barbecue is also provided.

Location & Local Information

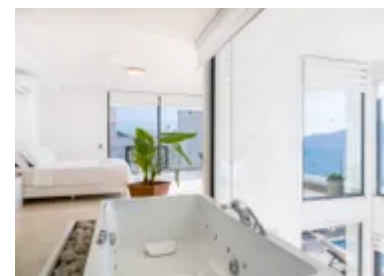
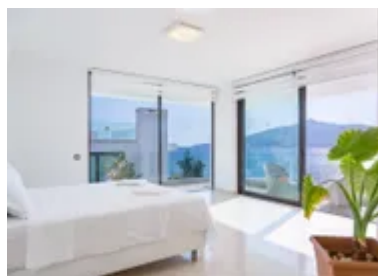
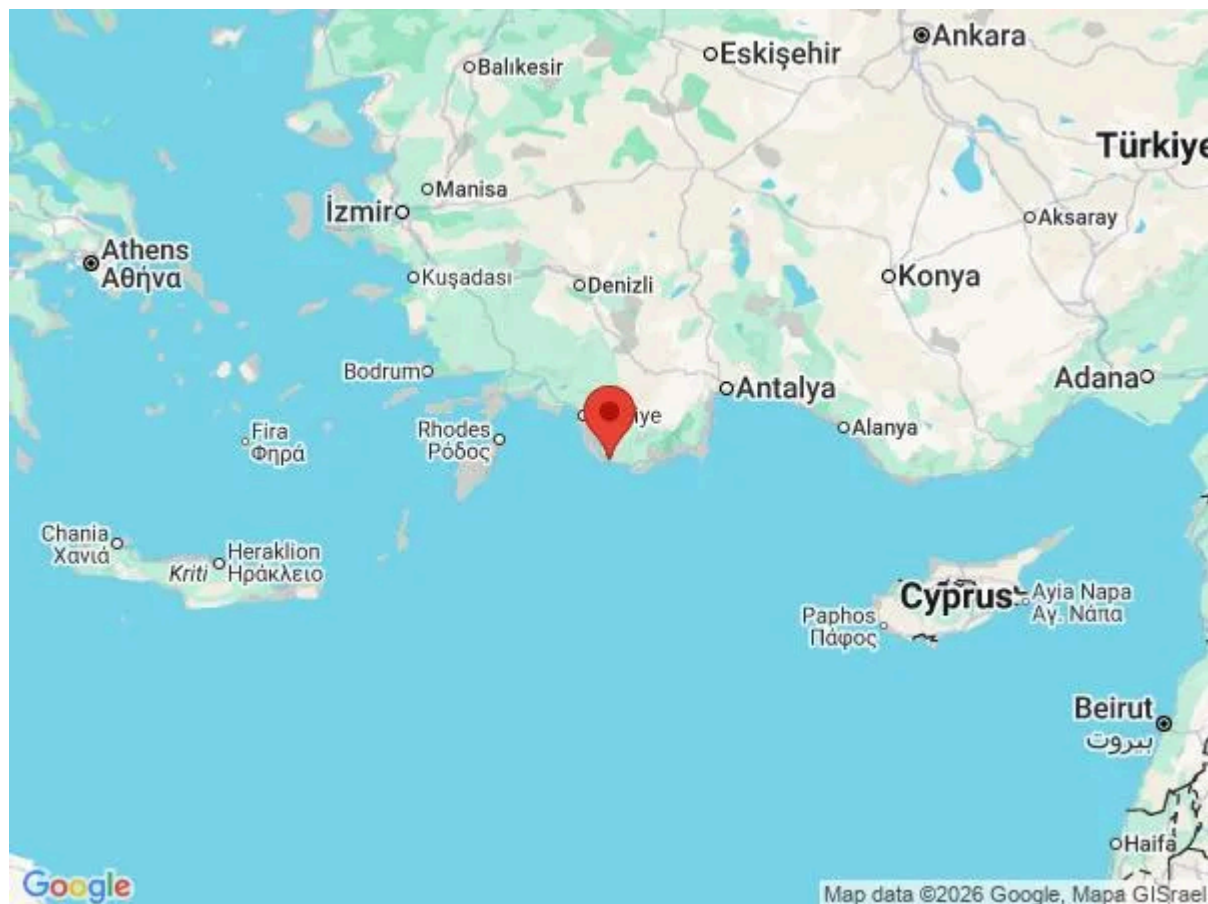
Kalkan is a picturesque harbour town on Turkey's southwest Mediterranean coast, set between the Taurus Mountains and the turquoise waters of the Lycian Sea. Once a quiet fishing village, it has evolved into an elegant yet relaxed destination known for its whitewashed houses, bougainvillea-draped balconies, and atmospheric old town streets. Despite its growth in popularity, Kalkan has retained a boutique feel, with low-rise buildings cascading down the hillside toward the sea and strict planning regulations preserving its charm.

The old town is the heart of Kalkan, a maze of narrow cobbled lanes filled with independent boutiques, artisan shops, and an impressive array of rooftop restaurants. Dining is a highlight here; many restaurants are family-run and serve freshly prepared Turkish meze, grilled seafood, and regional specialities under the stars. The small marina and harbour area provide a scenic focal point, where traditional gulets and day boats depart for leisurely cruises along the coast.

Kalkan is particularly celebrated for its beach clubs and access to some of Turkey's most beautiful beaches. While the town itself has a small pebble beach, the famous Kaputaş Beach, with its dramatic gorge setting and vivid blue waters, is just a short drive away. Patara Beach, one of the longest sandy beaches in the Mediterranean and part of a protected national park, offers a wild and unspoilt alternative. The surrounding region is rich in history, with ancient Lycian ruins, including Xanthos, Letoon, and Tlos, scattered throughout the landscape.

What we love

- The Palm Beach Club is located just below the villa, approximately a two-minute walk away, offering convenient access to waterfront dining, swimming and water sports.
- The centre of Kalkan can be reached via a scenic coastal path in around 10–12 minutes, combining a sense of seclusion with easy access to local amenities.
- The private Roof Terrace is perfect for sunset drinks and evening relaxation.

What you should know...

- Kömürlük is elevated and charming, however, like much of Kalkan, there may be hills/steps when walking to and from town or beach clubs.
- The swimming pool is unfenced so children should be supervised at all times
- For larger groups traveling together you can also book the sister villa Komurluk Sea located next door

Terms & Conditions

- **Security deposit:** £250 charged to client's credit card by the owner before/upon arrival and refunded two weeks after departure, subject to full inspection.

Travelling to Turkey

All British (and most other nationalities) citizens require a full 10 year passport with at least 6 months validity to enter Turkey. UK passport holders are exempt from visa for tourist visits of up to 90 days within 180 days starting from the first entry date. For all other passports please visit the Turkish Government Website or the Turkish Consulate for details of whether you require a visa or not.

Whilst in Turkey local regulations require you keep your passport and a printed copy of your e-visa with you at all times.
