

Villa Sidonia I

Overview

Villa Sidonia I is a contemporary beachfront villa on the southern coast of Heraklion, offering a comfortable and well-designed base for up to six guests. Set just steps from the shoreline, the villa enjoys uninterrupted sea views and direct access to the beach, creating an easy connection between indoor living and the coast.

Arranged across multiple levels, the villa features three en-suite bedrooms alongside open-plan living spaces designed to maximise natural light and views. Large openings lead out to the outdoor areas, where a private pool, dining space, and lounging areas provide plenty of room to relax throughout the day.

A standout feature is the rooftop level, where a private jacuzzi, lounge area, and adjustable pergola create a unique setting for unwinding, whether during the day or under the evening sky. Additional touches, including a private massage space available on request, add to the sense of comfort and flexibility during your stay.

For larger groups, Villa Sidonia I can also be booked alongside its neighbouring twin property, Villas Sidonia (<https://www.oliverstravels.com/greece/crete/south-crete/villas-sidonia/>), sleeping up to twelve it offers an ideal setup for families or friends travelling together while still maintaining some privacy.

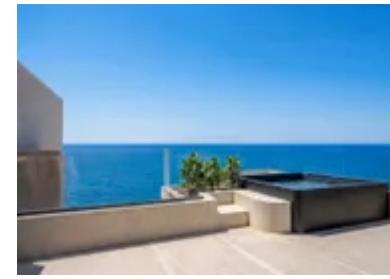

Location & Local Information

Villa Sidonia I is set in the coastal area of Sidonia on Crete's southern shoreline, offering a more laid-back alternative to the island's busier northern resorts. Positioned just 20 metres from Paralia Sidonia, the villa enjoys direct access to the beach, with open views across the Libyan Sea shaping the setting.

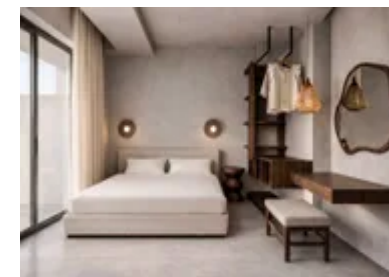
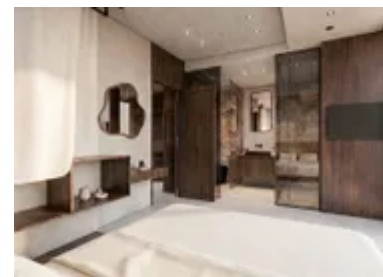
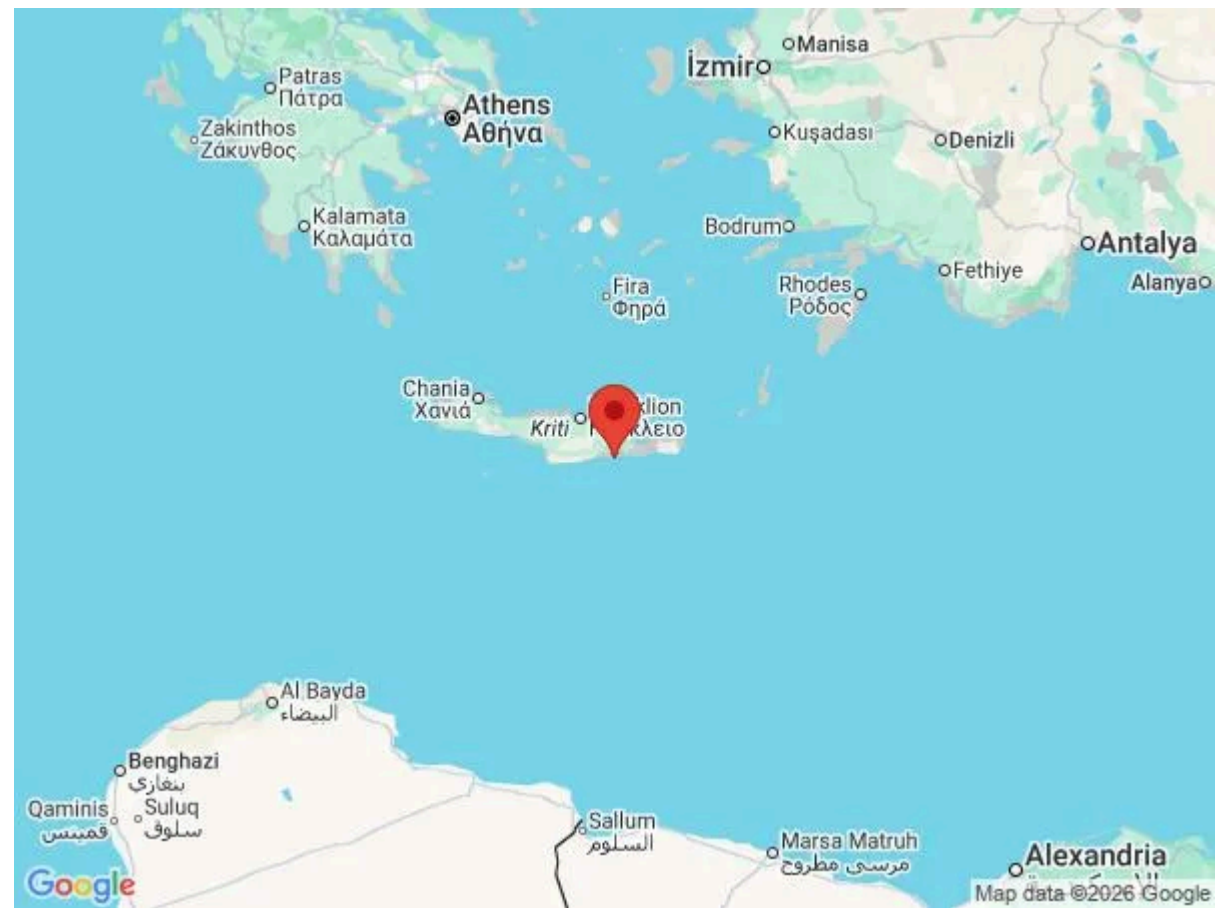
Within walking distance, you'll find a small selection of local tavernas, including traditional options around 400–450 metres away, as well as a beach bar café just moments from the villa. A mini market and small playground are also close by, making everyday essentials easy to access during your stay.

The surrounding area is well suited to those looking to explore southern Crete, with scenic drives, quieter beaches, and local villages all within reach. Heraklion city and airport are approximately 75–76 km away, making arrivals and departures straightforward, while a car is recommended for accessing wider amenities such as pharmacies, larger supermarkets, and cultural sites.

This location combines seafront living with a relaxed local atmosphere, offering a well-placed base for enjoying Crete's southern coast.

Terms & Conditions

- **Security deposit:** There is no security deposit, but should there be any damage or loss caused by you or your guests during your stay you will be liable for the cost.
- **Arrival time:** 4pm
- **Departure time:** 10am
- **Energy costs included?:** Yes, included in the rental price
- **Linen & towels included?:** Yes, included in the rental price
- **Pets welcome?:** No pets
- **Changeover day:** Flexible
- **Smoking Allowed?:** No smoking
- **Minimum stay:** Please note that there is a 3-night minimum stay, this may be increased across peak dates
- **Pool heating charge?:** For those travelling outside of the peak Summer months, pool heating is available and included in the rental price. Please note pool heating is only available between March till the end of May and mid September till the end of November. Please enquire if available for your specific dates at the time of booking. The pool is heated by Pool Heat Pump to about 26 – 27°C depending on weather conditions and needs to be requested at least 7 days prior to booking start date.
- **Internet access?:** The property has complimentary Wifi connection. It is good to note that the speed is dependent on local provider and technical issues may cause reduced speed or cut of service.
