

La Maison De Maître

Overview

In a traditional Hérault village, La Maison de Maître reveals itself as a handsome detached Languedoc holiday home where heritage features meet thoughtful modern comfort. Beautifully tiled floors run underfoot, while high ceilings and generous proportions create an immediate sense of space and calm. Every detail has been carefully restored, balancing character with contemporary style to offer an inviting home for relaxed, easy living.

Inside, the ground floor unfolds with a sociable rhythm. The traditional kitchen and dining area provides the heart of the home, ideal for preparing long, unhurried meals. The living room offers a comfortable place to unwind, while the light-filled conservatory draws the outdoors in, opening directly onto the rear terrace and swimming pool beyond. Upstairs, three air-conditioned bedrooms, arranged as king, queen and double, provide restful spaces after warm days in the southern French sunshine, complemented by a spacious family bathroom.

The rear garden extends across 1,500 square metres, offering both open and shaded areas to suit every moment of the day. A generous private swimming pool sits at its centre whilst a dining area provides the perfect setting for al fresco evenings, accompanied by local wines sourced from nearby domaines.

Life here unfolds at an easy pace. Mornings might begin with a short stroll into the village for fresh bread, followed by lunch in a winery and afternoons spent exploring the surrounding countryside. With vineyards at every turn and rivers, walking trails and markets within easy reach, there is always something new to discover.

Situated in the village of Magalas, everyday amenities are less than a 10-minute walk away, while a larger supermarket sits moments outside the village. Mediterranean beaches lie within a thirty-minute drive or spend time discovering the historic charm of Béziers and the world famous Canal du Midi.

For those seeking a characterful village stay with comfort and style, La Maison de Maître offers a setting where each day feels effortlessly well spent.

Location & Local Information

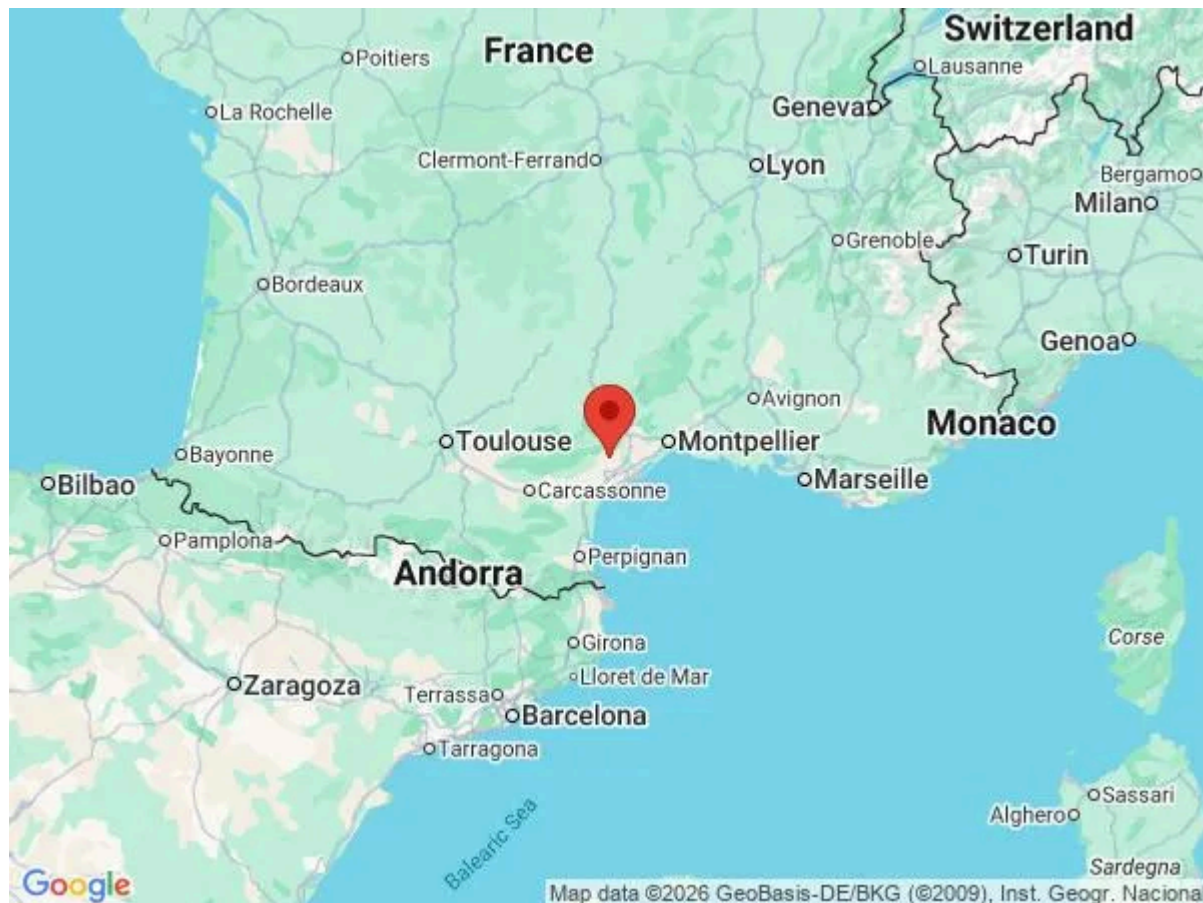
Set in the Languedoc village of Magalas, La Maison de Maître enjoys a well-connected location between Montpellier and Carcassonne. Around 750m on foot from the historic centre, guests can easily reach everyday essentials, with a grocery shop, bakery, post office, bank and a handful of bar-restaurants all within a 10-minute stroll. On the village outskirts, a larger supermarket, petrol station and local wine outlet add further convenience just a short drive away.

Magalas itself exudes traditional southern French character, while nearby Puissalicon (2km) offers an atmospheric setting for a leisurely meal and the chance to discover an excellent local wine seller. This part of the Languedoc is renowned for its wine domaines, where tastings and vineyard visits provide an authentic glimpse into the region's rich viticultural heritage.

For outdoor pursuits, the Orb River near Cessenon-sur-Orb (17km) is a highlight, offering canoeing and kayaking through scenic landscapes. Walkers and cyclists will also enjoy the famed Canal du Midi, ideal for long rides or strolls along its towpaths. Further afield, the Montagnes Noire and the wider Languedoc Regional Park invite exploration with walking and trekking routes through unspoilt countryside of southern France.

A day trip to Béziers (16.5km) promises excellent shopping, vibrant restaurants and a touch of history, while golfers can choose between courses at Lamalou and Béziers, both around 20 minutes away. For a change of scenery, Lake Salagou (38km) offers freshwater swimming and summer watersports.

The Mediterranean coast is also within easy reach, with sandy beaches stretching from Valras Plage to Cap d'Agde around 30 to 45 minutes by car. From vast shores to family-friendly attractions and water parks, this coastline creates the perfect contrast to village life, making Magalas an ideal base for both relaxation and adventure.
