Overview

Set in gently undulating countryside, Maison Lescourou offers an authentic Dordogne escape where time seems to slow. This traditional home invites guests to settle into a simpler pace, where long meals stretch into the evening and days unfold with ease by the private swimming pool.

Full of character, the house celebrates its heritage with exposed beams and welcoming spaces designed for gathering. The open plan kitchen and dining area forms the heart of the home, ideal for shared cooking and relaxed conversation, while the living room offers space to unwind. Six comfortable bedrooms, all air conditioned, are spread across two floors, including four with en suite bathrooms.

Outside, the garden opens onto the surrounding countryside, with a shaded dining table and barbecue for al fresco meals. The private heated pool sits just above, accompanied by sun loungers that invite slow afternoons under the Dordogne sun.

The setting places you in the heart of one of France's most captivating regions. Within a few minutes by car, you can reach a local restaurant and café-bar-épicerie, while Montignac Lascaux offers a wider choice of shops and restaurants by the banks of the Vézère River. The surrounding Vézère valley is rich in history and natural beauty, from the prehistoric caves of Les Eyzies to the remarkable Lascaux paintings.

Villages such as Saint Léon sur Vézère and Coly Saint Amand provide a glimpse into the region's heritage, while Sarlat la Canéda, just twenty minutes away, brings lively markets and beautifully preserved medieval streets.

For those seeking space, character and authentic charm, Maison Lescourou offers a relaxed and memorable Dordogne stay.

Location & Local Information

Maison Lescurou enjoys a wonderful rural setting within a 35-hectare estate (home to other holiday properties and the owners' residence) in the Vézère valley, the heart of the Dordogne. Surrounded by gently rolling landscapes, this is a place to truly unwind while remaining within easy reach of the region's most treasured villages and cultural sites.

A restaurant is just a 3-minute drive away, while a local grocery store and café bar can be reached in just under 5 minutes by car. For a wider choice, Montignac-Lascaux (11km) is a short drive away, offering supermarkets, shops, café bars and restaurants, and a picturesque riverside setting by the banks of the Vézère.

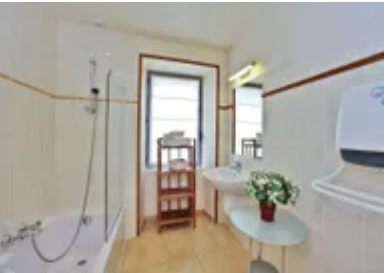
The surrounding area is rich in charm and heritage. Other beautiful villages such as Coly-Saint-Amand (8km) and Saint-Léon-sur-Vézère (13.5km) invite leisurely exploration, both classified as 'Plus Beaux Villages de France'. The Vézère valley is renowned for its striking natural beauty, with dramatic cliffs and peaceful waterways creating a truly memorable landscape.

History lovers will be captivated by the prehistoric treasures of the region. Les Eyzies (23km) is at the heart of this remarkable area, home to an extraordinary concentration of caves adorned with ancient formations and artwork. The nearby Lascaux caves, discovered in 1940 near Montignac, feature world-famous paintings dating back around 17,000 years, while the Vézère Valley itself is recognised as a UNESCO World Heritage site.

For a livelier atmosphere, Sarlat-la-Canéda is just 20 minutes away. This bustling medieval town, the capital of the Périgord Noir, is famed for its beautifully preserved 15th and 16th-century architecture and vibrant markets held on Wednesdays and Saturdays. A little further afield, the iconic villages of Domme and La Roque-Gageac, along with the Dordogne River, can be reached in just over half an hour, offering unforgettable scenery and timeless appeal.
