Region: The South West **Sleeps:** 14

Overview

In the historic fishing village of Beer, Stellar Haven offers a rare opportunity to gather, celebrate and unwind in one of Devon's most characterful coastal settings. Combining the beautifully restored manor and its private barn annexe, this exceptional and historic estate accommodates 12 to 14 guests, bringing together 16th century heritage, thoughtful design and modern comfort for unforgettable stays by the sea.

The main house welcomes up to ten guests across five beautifully appointed bedrooms, with generous living spaces designed for both relaxation and socialising. Original period features sit comfortably alongside refined contemporary touches, creating an atmosphere that feels both sophisticated and welcoming. Four inglenook fireplaces add warmth and character, while the spacious kitchen, complete with a large island, wine fridge and Falcon range cooker, provides the perfect setting for preparing leisurely breakfasts, celebratory dinners and everything in between. A living room with pool table, cosy reading snug and TV room ensure there is room for everyone to enjoy their own pace of holiday.

Adjacent to the manor, the historic barn offers a delightful retreat for two to four additional guests. Carefully restored with exposed beams, heritage details and gorgeous finishes, the barn combines intimacy and comfort with its own entrance and little courtyard. The striking cast iron bath in the bedroom creates a sense of indulgence, making it an ideal space for a couple seeking a little extra privacy while remaining connected to the wider group.

Outside, landscaped gardens, a croquet lawn and a spacious terrace invite long afternoons in the fresh air. Gather for al fresco dining, enjoy a glass of wine as the sun begins to set or simply savour the slower rhythm of coastal life. With parking for five cars and EV charging points, every detail has been considered for a seamless stay.

Located on Devon's UNESCO World Heritage Jurassic Coast, Stellar Haven enjoys an enviable position just 500 metres from Beer Beach. The village's winding lanes, independent cafés, welcoming pubs and local galleries are all within easy walking distance. Beyond Beer, guests can explore the dramatic coastal scenery of Branscombe, ride the heritage Seaton Tramway through the Axe Valley, discover the famous fossil beaches of Lyme Regis or enjoy the Regency charm of Sidmouth.

With the South West Coast Path nearby and some of the region's most spectacular walking routes on the doorstep, Stellar Haven is perfectly placed for creating lasting memories on one of England's most captivating coastlines.

Location & Local Information

Located in the charming fishing village of Beer on Devon's UNESCO World Heritage Jurassic Coast, Stellar Haven places you in the heart of one of the county's most picturesque seaside destinations.

With its pretty cottages, winding lanes and relaxed coastal atmosphere, Beer offers an authentic taste of Devon life. Independent cafés, welcoming pubs and local galleries are all within easy reach, making it a delightful base for a memorable seaside escape.

Just a short stroll from the property, Beer Beach (500m on foot) is a beautiful sheltered shingle bay framed by dramatic limestone cliffs. Here, colourful fishing boats are still hauled ashore each day, preserving a centuries-old maritime tradition. A visit to the fascinating Beer Quarry Caves (1.5km) is also highly recommended, where guided tours reveal the vast underground caverns that supplied stone for some of England's most famous historic buildings.

The surrounding coastline offers plenty to explore. Branscombe Beach (4km), one of Devon's most unspoilt coastal spots, is perfect for peaceful seaside walks and scenic views. A 5 to 10-minute drive in the other direction brings you to Seaton Beach, the town of Seaton and the popular Seaton Tramway, where heritage trams glide through the beautiful Axe Valley wetlands. These nearby attractions provide a wonderful mix of coastal scenery, wildlife and family-friendly experiences.

For those keen to discover more of East Devon, the elegant Regency town of Sidmouth (13km) offers attractive gardens, charming shops and a lovely seafront, while the historic market town of Honiton (16km) is renowned for its antique shops and lace-making heritage. The iconic seaside town of Lyme Regis (15km), famous for its fossil-rich beaches and charming harbour, is also within easy reach.

Beer is home to some of Devon's most spectacular coastal walks, with the South West Coast Path passing nearby. Routes from Seaton to Beer showcase breathtaking views across the Jurassic Coast, while coastal trails lead around the village and onwards to neighbouring Branscombe, offering unforgettable scenery at every turn.
