Set within 65 acres of private grounds, Ardleigh House combines grand architectural proportions with warm, welcoming interiors. Beautifully restored and thoughtfully updated, the house retains its original character while embracing touches of modern luxury. Light filled reception rooms, elegant period features and carefully curated design create an atmosphere that feels both sophisticated and deeply comfortable.

Each bedroom features its own individuality; some bedrooms are part of three self-contained wings with their own sleek modern kitchen facilities and cosy living-dining room. Highlights include the super king-size suite with original stone walls and beautifully refurbished floorboards, the pretty double with its Designers Guild mural and Egyptian cotton bedlinen, and one of the top-floor bedrooms with its decadent freestanding bath in the room.

Throughout the estate, ancient woodland, sweeping lawns and open pastureland provide a constantly changing backdrop, while resident Highland cows and ponies add an unmistakably Scottish charm to the landscape. Spend leisurely mornings exploring woodland trails, enjoy long lunches by the barbecue or gather inside with friends and family as the Scottish countryside unfolds beyond the windows.

Every stay at Ardleigh House can be tailored to suit the occasion. 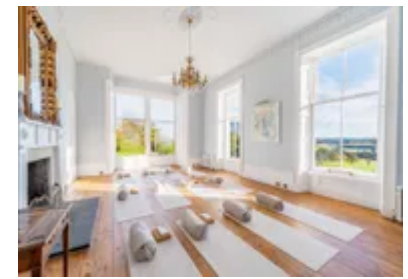

Set against the rolling hills of northeast Scotland, Ardleigh House enjoys a privileged setting in the Aberdeenshire countryside, set within a 65-acre private estate of manicured gardens, wild landscapes, ancient woodland and pastureland with grazing Highland cows and ponies.

Despite its rural atmosphere, this Grade B-listed Georgian house enjoys excellent access to local amenities and attractions. The thriving market town of Inverurie (5km) is just a short drive away, offering a selection of independent shops, cafés, restaurants and local services. Rich in Aberdeenshire heritage, Inverurie also provides an ideal base for exploring nearby castles, historic landmarks and picturesque villages that characterise this captivating corner of Scotland.

Golf enthusiasts will find themselves perfectly positioned to experience some of Scotland's most celebrated courses. Within easy reach are world-renowned venues including Royal Aberdeen (29km), Trump International Golf Links (31km), Cruden Bay, Murcar Links (46km), Carnoustie (121km) and Moray (88km). Whether planning a dedicated golfing itinerary or simply fitting in a round or two during a countryside getaway, Ardleigh House provides an elegant base from which to enjoy the region's outstanding golfing heritage.

For wider exploration, the vibrant city of Aberdeen (31km) offers cultural attractions, excellent dining, shopping and access to Scotland's spectacular northeast coastline.
