

Villa Chania View

Overview

Located in the village of Kokkino Chorio, this five-bedroom villa offers sea and mountain views with outdoor living spaces designed to make the most of the surrounding landscape.

The villa accommodates up to 10 guests across five bedrooms. Four bedrooms are located on the lower level, while the fifth is situated within the cinema area. Four bedrooms feature en-suite bathrooms, and all include fitted wardrobes, air conditioning, underfloor heating, and access to a private balcony or terrace.

The open-plan living area includes a fully equipped kitchen with a central island, espresso machine, dishwasher, and modern appliances, providing a practical space for both everyday use and entertaining.

Wellness and leisure facilities include an outdoor gym, sauna, cold plunge pool, jacuzzi, yoga deck, and a cinema room with a double bed. Additional entertainment options include a billiards table, table tennis, and a Sonos sound system.

Outside, guests can enjoy a private heated swimming pool, separate children's pool, sun loungers, shaded dining and lounge areas, barbecue facilities, landscaped gardens, and a boules (pétanque) court. The villa's elevated position provides panoramic views and sunsets over the surrounding Cretan coastline.

Location & Local Information

Kokkino Horio is a traditional village in the Apokoronas region of Chania, Crete, offering a peaceful setting with views across Souda Bay and the Aegean Sea. Characterised by its narrow streets, whitewashed homes, and relaxed pace of life, the village provides an opportunity to experience a more authentic side of the island away from the larger tourist resorts. Its elevated position makes it a popular spot for enjoying the surrounding countryside and coastal scenery.

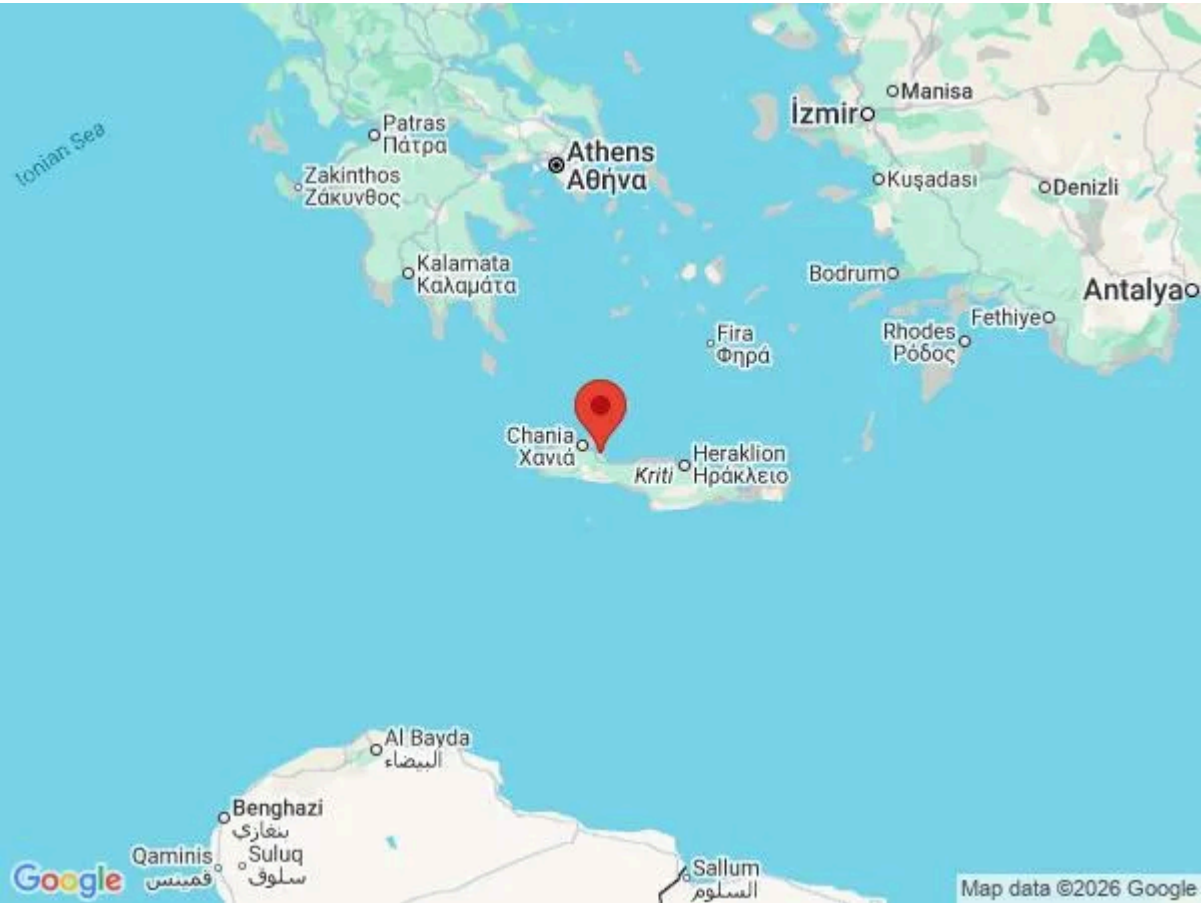
The village has a long history, with influences from both the Venetian and Ottoman periods still visible in the local architecture and nearby landmarks. One of the area's notable attractions is the historic Venetian fortress overlooking the region, while Kokkino Horio is also known for its traditional glassblowing workshop, where visitors can watch skilled artisans at work and purchase locally made pieces.

Kokkino Horio is well placed for exploring western Crete. Several walking and hiking routes pass through the surrounding hills, offering views of olive groves, rugged landscapes, and the coastline. Nearby beaches, including Almyrida and Koutalas, are within a short drive and provide opportunities for swimming, snorkelling, and relaxing by the sea.

The village is also home to a selection of family-run tavernas and cafés serving traditional Cretan dishes prepared with locally sourced ingredients. Combining a tranquil atmosphere, scenic surroundings, and easy access to both the coast and the countryside, Kokkino Horio is a convenient base for visitors looking to discover the natural beauty and cultural heritage of the Chania region.
