

Villa Viewpoint 1

Overview

Perched on the heights of Oia, Villa Viewpoint 1 enjoys panoramic views across the Aegean Sea and Santorini's renowned sunsets. This independent villa offers 257 sq.m of interior living space, complemented by 389 sq.m of landscaped gardens and 250 sq.m of private verandas, accommodating up to eight guests in a setting inspired by traditional Cycladic architecture.

Designed to make the most of both indoor and outdoor living, the villa features fully equipped indoor and outdoor kitchens, spacious dining and seating areas, a barbecue, fire pit, and outdoor Jacuzzis. The outdoor spaces provide ample room for relaxation while taking in the surrounding scenery.

The villa comprises four bedrooms, each with its own en-suite shower room, offering privacy and comfort for all guests. Additional facilities include a private gym with modern fitness equipment and a sauna.

A dedicated F&B butler's room supports the villa's service offering (available upon booking and availability), while a range of hospitality services are available to enhance guests' stays. These include direct villa check-in, daily housekeeping, concierge assistance, and the option to arrange services such as a private chef or personal trainer. Guests can also enjoy complimentary breakfast at the nearby Santo Pure resort, located within walking distance of the villa.

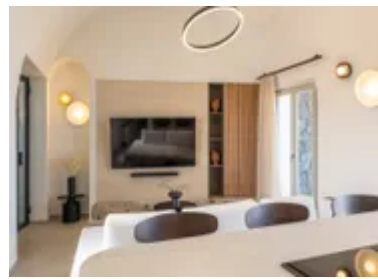

Location & Local Information

Villa Viewpoint 1 enjoys access to the sister resort Santo Pure featuring an award-winning spa, an all-day Greek-inspired restaurant & bar, and six outdoor swimming pools.. Perched on a rugged hillside overlooking Ammoudi Bay, the villa lies just north of Oia on the Cycladic island of Santorini, surrounded by the azure waters of the Aegean Sea. It is a scenic thirty-minute drive from Santorini International Airport and forty-five minutes from the port of Athinios. Ammoudi Bay is a fifteen-minute walk away, while the beaches of Baxedes and Coloumbo are within easy reach. The island’s renowned red and white beaches can be reached in around thirty minutes.

The historic town of Oia is a captivating fishing village with winding lanes, charming boutiques, and iconic Greek Orthodox churches. Stroll past windmills, explore the Naval Museum, or cliff-dive into Ammoudi Bay before dining on fresh seafood at a local taverna and witnessing one of Santorini’s unforgettable sunsets. Hike the nine-kilometre Caldera trail to Fira, where museums, including the Wine Museum and the Museum of Prehistoric Thera, await.

Visit Pyrgos village in the foothills of Mount Profitis Ilias, known for its medieval alleyways, family-run tavernas, and celebrated Assyrtiko vineyards. Explore ancient Akrotiri, the Arygyros Mansion, or take a boat trip to the volcanic islets of Nea and Palia Kameni. From sunset cruises to photography tours, Santorini offers an unforgettable blend of culture, history, and natural beauty.
