

Casa Delle Colline

Overview

Surrounded by undulating Tuscan hills and looking out across a sun-drenched landscape that seems to roll on forever, Casa Delle Colline is a welcoming farmhouse with rustic soul and modern comforts. Tucked into the countryside between the beaches of the Etruscan Coast and the ancient city of Volterra, this stone-built villa sleeps eight across four beautifully appointed bedrooms, each with its own bathroom.

Step inside and you're greeted by a warm, earthy interior where terracotta floors and beamed ceilings nod to the building's agricultural past. The living area, soft-lit and cosy, invites conversation, reading and perhaps the odd late-night board game. Adjacent sits a formal dining space, perfect for group meals, with doors that open straight onto the covered terrace. The kitchen is spacious and fully equipped for whipping up Tuscan feasts, there's even a traditional fireplace for chilly evenings. Downstairs, a double bedroom with en-suite ensures easy access for those less keen on stairs.

Upstairs, three further bedrooms, two doubles and a twin, each with their own shower room, offer peaceful places to rest after days exploring or lounging in the sun. Every bedroom has air conditioning and insect screens for comfort, while the downstairs living area has Wi-Fi access for those needing to stay somewhat connected.

Outside, life slows to a sun-kissed rhythm. The private pool is framed by a natural lawn and flanked with loungers, perfect for lazy days under the Tuscan sky. The shaded portico makes a fine spot for long lunches or evening barbecues, with views out across fields and forested hills. There's even an outdoor shower for rinsing off after a dip.

Set within a vast 650-hectare estate, Casa Delle Colline offers rare peace, rural beauty and plenty of space to unwind. Whether you're here to read, cook, explore or simply breathe deep, this is a villa that makes it easy to feel at home, and far away, all at once.

Location & Local Information

Casa Delle Colline is nestled deep in the Tuscan countryside, at the meeting point of vineyards, hills and coastal breezes. Located just 4km from the quaint village of Guardistallo, and a short drive from the glittering shores of the Etruscan Coast, this is a region rich in rural charm and historic intrigue. Here, olive groves line the ridges and wheat fields sway with the rhythm of the land, while hidden trattorias and wine estates are never far away.

Guardistallo offers everything you'll need for daily essentials, with local shops, a bakery, pharmacy and a couple of cafés to keep you stocked and caffeinated. For something a little livelier, Marina di Cecina is only 15km away, a laid-back coastal town with tennis courts, seaside restaurants and a sandy beach ideal for sunbathing or family-friendly fun.

The location offers easy access to some of Tuscany's most celebrated sights. Volterra, one of the most fascinating Etruscan cities, lies just 27km inland. Here, you'll find ancient city walls, alabaster workshops, and panoramic views that make the winding drive well worth it. For wine enthusiasts, a trip to Bolgheri is essential, the village is famed for producing some of the best wines in Italy, with scenic vineyards and prestigious cellars to explore.

A little further afield, the Gulf of Baratti is a stunning stretch of coast, complete with hidden coves, pine forests and the ancient acropolis of Populonia, an atmospheric site where archaeology meets the sea. For those drawn to Tuscany's cultural cities, Siena is 85km away and offers a full day of art, architecture and leisurely piazza dining.

Closer to home, the surrounding countryside offers a slower rhythm. Enjoy peaceful walks through fields and woodland trails, or hop on a bike and cycle along rural paths lined with cypress trees. Horse riding is available in nearby Riparbella, and there are plenty of local festivals and food markets during the warmer months.

This is a location where quiet exploration is part of the joy, and every winding road seems to lead to somewhere delicious, picturesque or quietly awe-inspiring.
