At the gateway to the Trossachs National Park, this beautiful house enjoys an exceptional setting in one of Scotland's most celebrated landscapes. Designated by the Scottish Government as an area of 'Outstanding National Importance', this remarkable region is where the Scottish Lowlands meet the Highlands, creating a breathtaking backdrop of ancient forests, shimmering lochs and dramatic mountain peaks. Rich in literary heritage, these inspiring landscapes influenced Sir Walter Scott's *The Lady of the Lake* and *Rob Roy*, while today they continue to captivate visitors with their timeless beauty.

The bustling town of Callander (2.5km) is the perfect base for discovering the area, offering a welcoming selection of independent cafés, restaurants, shops and local amenities. Surrounded by scenic countryside, the region is ideal for outdoor adventures, with excellent opportunities for cycling, walking and wildlife spotting right on your doorstep. Whether you're exploring peaceful woodland trails or taking in panoramic viewpoints, every route showcases the area's remarkable natural beauty.

Nature lovers will be spoilt for choice with Loch Venachar (6km) and Loch Lubnaig (8km) both within easy reach, each offering tranquil waters framed by rolling hills and native woodland. The Queen Elizabeth Forest Park and Glen Finglas Estate provide outstanding walking routes through diverse landscapes, from ancient woodlands to open moorland, with abundant wildlife and unforgettable scenery. With 21 Munros and countless lochs scattered throughout the Trossachs National Park, this is a paradise for those seeking Scotland's iconic Highland landscapes.

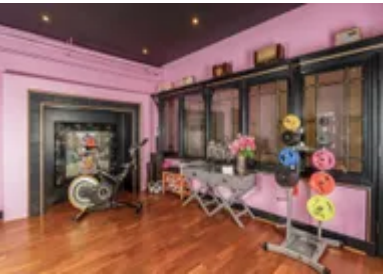
