Notably, the GR92 hiking path runs close to Le Logis Fleuri, offering an ideal opportunity for walkers to indulge in their passion.

However, Provence's allure extends beyond its idyllic countryside. Within a 2 hour drive, you can reach the sparkling coastline of France, particularly the renowned holiday destination of Marseille. Embrace the sun-drenched beaches, relish the fresh seafood, and immerse yourself in the vibrant nightlife this city has to offer. For a glimpse into the traditional fishing trade, rise early and visit the Old Port, where fishermen unload and sell their daily catch. Alternatively, venture into the city centre to savour delectable local cuisine. As the evening unfolds, indulge in the lively atmosphere that lingers into the early hours, with numerous summer beach clubs and bars providing nonstop music.
