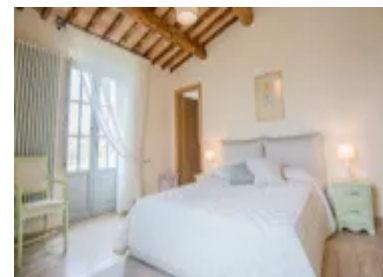

- **Security deposit:** €300 charged to client's credit card as a pre-authorisation at least 2 weeks prior to arrival and refunded two weeks after departure, subject to full inspection.
- **Arrival time:** 4.00 -7:00 p.m. Check-in outside this time is subject to an extra cost. If agreed €50 will be payable locally (remote check-in). Please enquire for more details.
- **Departure time:** 10.00 a.m.
- **Energy costs included?:** Yes. Extra €300 per week for A/C (on request), or pro rata for short stays, payable locally.

Guests are required to leave the accommodation clean, tidy and in the same condition as on their arrival. Any extra cleaning, laundry, maintenance and/or rubbish disposal required will be charged against the security deposit.
- **Smoking Allowed?:** Outside only.
- **Other 2:** A highchair and cot are available on request, subject to a fee of €50 per item (payable locally in cash).
- **Minimum stay:** A minimum stay of 7 nights applies in July, August, and September; 5 nights during all other periods, except on Christmas and New Year's, when a 4-night stay is allowed.
