

Chateau De La Porte

Overview

Château De La Porte is an 18th-century château equipped with 21st-century pleasures. Designed for entertainment as well as relaxation, the château is south facing with large windows giving each room a bright, warm and comfortable feel, overlooking the French gardens and swimming pool area.

Up to 14 adults and 3 children (under 12) can be accommodated here. With 1000m2 of living space with various reception rooms alongside seven attractive bedrooms (and three children's single bedrooms), this magnificent residence has been redecorated and furnished with period flair and taste. Highlights include the Napoleon-style music room, medieval library and dining hall with huge fireplace for winter months. We also love the Louis XVI salon and the bar, not to mention the newly renovated kitchen.

Château De La Porte is surrounded by over seven acres of manicured private gardens with a heated swimming pool, 7-seater Jacuzzi, sauna, magnificent French garden with fountains and marble statues, Japanese garden with pond, a 14th-century moat, kitchen garden, barbecue and outdoor dining in the conservatory. Families will also appreciate the playground with a zipline, tree house, swings and trampoline.

The château has atmospheric lighting both indoor and outdoor with a surround sound system that augments the romantic atmosphere across the ground floor and pool area. Enjoy champagne in the Jacuzzi after dinner or head to the billiard room for a glass of Cognac.

Château De La Porte is set in the heart of a Loire Valley village, making it the perfect base to explore the famous vineyards, grand châteaux and even the beaches of the



Atlantic coast. Don't miss the bustling Tuesday morning market by the gates of the château and there is also a village tennis court that guests can use within walking distance.

Meanwhile, make the most of the château's bikes as you cycle through local forests, look out for horse-riding opportunities, enjoy a day out in nearby Cholet or venture further afield to the likes of Saumur, Chinon, Angers and Nantes to truly soak up the historic beauty of this captivating region.

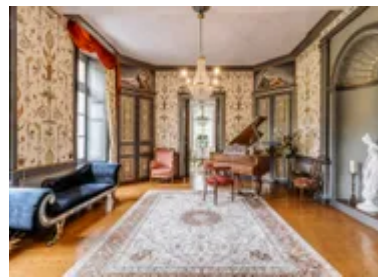

Location & Local Information

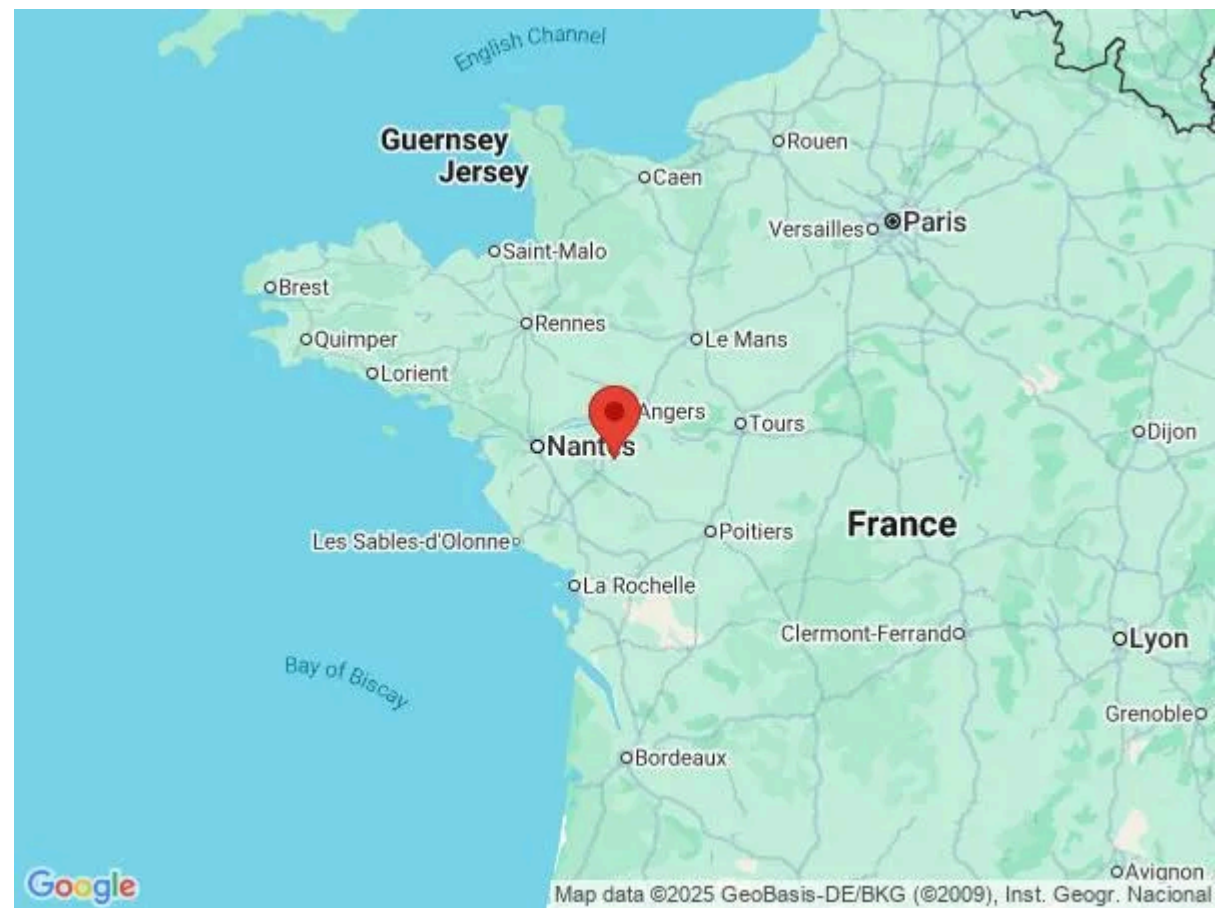
In the Maine-et-Loire region of central France, just over an hour from the city of Nantes, Château De La Porte is a great place to experience authentic French living in the heart of a small village. Step out of your private grounds and you will find yourself on the village square, home to a bustling Tuesday morning market. Amenities like a *boulangerie*, pharmacy, 24/7 grocery store, tennis court and a historic church are all within walking distance.

The village is surrounded by glorious landscapes and outdoor activities. Explore local cycling paths through nearby forests or enjoy horse-riding within a short distance. For culture and shopping, the vibrant town of Cholet (17km) is just a short drive away. Known for its rich textile heritage and bustling markets, Cholet is a hub of creativity and tradition. Wander its streets to discover unique shops, indulge in local gastronomy, stock-up at its twice-weekly market and delve into its fascinating museums. Be sure to visit the Musée du Textile et de la Mode to learn about the town's historical role in the French textile industry.

This location is also within reach of many highlights the Loire region from medieval villages surrounded by vineyards to grand châteaux, fortresses and palaces. From here, you can experience the cultural riches of Angers (55km) or explore the medieval towns of Saumur (56km) and Chinon (88km), ideal for canoeing/kayaking along the Loire or Vienne rivers as well as wine-tasting. Wine enthusiasts will also delight in visits to renowned vineyards like Savennieres and Domaine De Cloisel near Angers.

For a day out at the seaside, venture to the Atlantic coast and spend time at glorious beaches around Pornic (128km) and La Bernerie-en-Retz (124km) in the Loire-Atlantique region of western France.

- The château sleeps up to 17 guests: 14 adults + 3 children under 12.
- There's a fish-pond and a moat around the boundary of the château.
- Please note due to the expansive grounds, despite a full clean, there may be bugs.
- From April to October, a caretaker lives on site in the caretaker's cottage and is available for concierge services (charges/rates apply for concierge services).
- Please note maintenance staff work week days onsite to keep the grounds beautiful and functional.

Terms & Conditions

- **Security deposit:** €1500 paid via bank transfer to the owner one month before arrival and refunded two weeks after departure, subject to full inspection.
- **Arrival time:** 4.00 p.m.
- **Departure time:** 10.00 a.m.
- **Energy costs included?:** Included in the rental price, excluding heating.
- **Linen & towels included?:** All linen, bath and pool towels are included in the rental price.
- **Pets welcome?:** No.
- **Other Ts and Cs:** The chateau sleeps a maximum of 14 adults + 3 children under the age of 12. A cot and a high chair are available upon request. Please enquire at the time of booking. Weddings, hen/stag parties and any special events are on request only and subject to prior arrangement with the owner and additional charges. From April to October, a full-time caretaker lives on site and can provide concierge services during the season - hourly rates and charges apply for concierge services. Please note maintenance staff work week days onsite to keep the grounds beautiful and functional.
- **Changeover day:** Monday in peak season (May to end-September) or flexible during the week in low season.
- **End of stay cleaning available?:** Yes. However, guests are required to leave the accommodation clean, tidy and in the same condition as on their arrival. Any extra cleaning, laundry, maintenance and/or garbage disposal required will be charged against the security deposit.
- **Smoking Allowed?:** No smoking in the property.
- **Insurance:** It is recommended that all guests take out insurance to cover against potential cancellation and any accidental damage caused during your stay at the property.
- **Minimum stay:** 7 nights in peak season (May to end-September). 3 nights during all other periods.
- **Heating costs included?:** Approximately €1000/week, when required.
- **Pool heating charge?:** No. Please note that like all heated pools, pool heating and water temperature are reliant on weather and outside temperatures.
