Overview

The stunning countryside near Ostuni, hosts this 19th-century *trullo* which has the advantages of a modern holiday home while retaining its original beauty. Its private pool and a garden with sunbeds and olive trees allow you to enjoy the relaxed Puglian lifestyle right outside the door.

The characteristic arches and alcoves of this traditional house have been carefully preserved and the rugged white stone walls and tiled floors give it that real Italian ambience. Trullo Joel is well-equipped too, featuring two double bedrooms, each with en-suite shower. One of these can be set as a twin if required.

A cosy lounge and dining area complement a fully fitted kitchen with a dishwasher - all you need to get cooking each evening. Outside, you will find a barbecue too, as well as a covered patio with table and chairs. The views of the surrounding countryside will make dining outside all the more pleasurable, and the area is a treat to explore – full of fragrance and colour to delight the senses.

The famed 'white city' of Ostuni is just a few kilometres from Trullo Joel, and certainly worth an excursion or two. White-washed houses seem to tumble down the hillside looking out across the sea, and its medieval centre is still a muddle of charming little streets it's a joy to get lost in. A beautiful Gothic cathedral surveys it all from its position at the top of the hill.

Many more appealing towns and cities are within easy reach. Martina Franca, Locorotondo and Alberobello are all enchanting places to visit inland, while the stunning beaches of the Puglian coast are never far away either – Trullo Joel enjoys the best of both worlds.

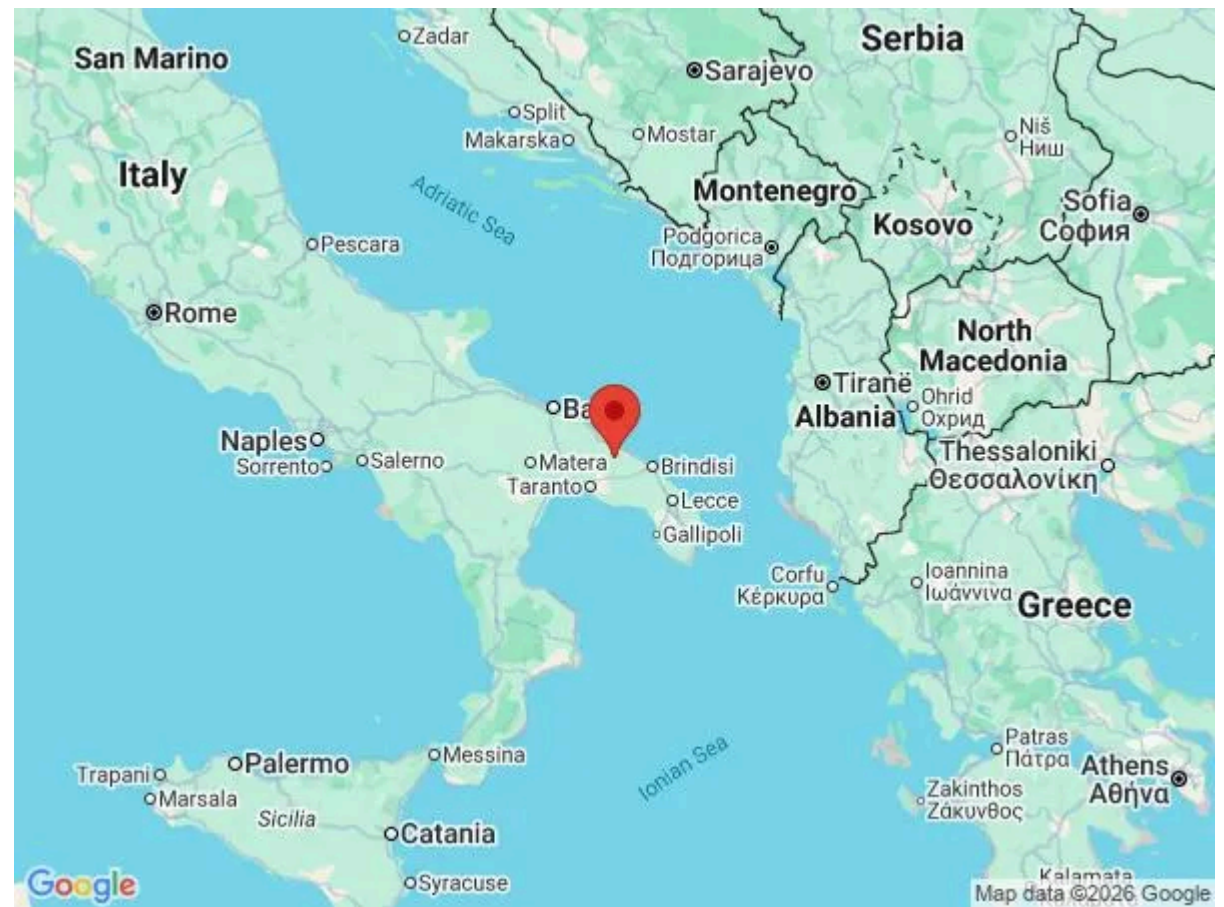
Location & Local Information

Known as the 'white city', Ostuni is an enchanting discovery on Italy's Puglian coast. The old town sits on a hilltop looking out to sea and has much to delight visitors, including a Gothic cathedral built in the 15th century. Views out across the Adriatic and some pretty beaches nearby also draw people to the area.

There is a lot of architecture to admire in Ostuni. Landmarks like the Palazzo Municipale and the Column of Sant'Oronzo are notable, yet it's not all about the past. These days, you're just as likely to visit the city for its excellent restaurants where you can get a genuine taste of what Puglian cuisine is all about. In a region packed with vineyards and olive groves, you know you are going to eat and drink well when you arrive in Ostuni.

- **Security deposit:** €300 paid in cash to the owner upon arrival and refunded after departure, subject to full inspection.
- **Arrival time:** 4.00 p.m. - 9.00 p.m. Late arrivals, if agreed, will be subject to an additional charge of €30 (paid locally).
- **Departure time:** 08.00 a.m. - 10.00 a.m. Late departures, if agreed, will be subject to an additional charge of €30 (paid locally).
- **Energy costs included?:** Included in the rental price
- **Linen & towels included?:** Linen & towels are included in the rental price
- **Pets welcome?:** On request only and with prior agreement with the owner. If accepted, a pet supplement of €30 per pet per day will apply (paid locally).
- **Other Ts and Cs:** Weddings, parties and any other special events are on request only and subject to prior arrangement with the owner and additional charges. If arranging a wedding, the whole estate (four properties) needs to be hired. Please see the 'Events' tab for further information. Please note that the use of any external caterers and/or contractors is not permitted.
- **Changeover day:** Saturday only in July & August. Flexible during all other periods.
- **End of stay cleaning:** Standard changeover clean and mid-stay cleaning are included in the price. Guests are required to leave the accommodation clean, tidy and in the same condition as on their arrival. Any extra cleaning, laundry, maintenance and/or rubbish disposal required will be charged against the security deposit.
- **Smoking Allowed?:** No smoking inside the villa
- **Other 2:** Please note home security devices may be installed at the villa, please enquire for further information.
- **Minimum stay:** 7 nights in July & August. 2 nights during all other periods.
- **Heating costs included?:** No. During the winter months (October to April) €6 per hour, payable locally.
- **Tax:** Italian Visitors Tax payable locally in cash (typically costs approximately between €1-€10 per adult per night- please enquire if exact amount is required).
- **Internet access?:** Wi-Fi connection included
- **Pool opening dates?:** The pool is open approximately May to September. Please note that pool opening dates are subject to local weather conditions and pool maintenance requirements and that cooler months may not be suitable for swimming.
